#### **JUNIOR DOG (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> Coggins Droveborough Born to Bound at Gemrose. Lively young l/w who is nicely made. He has a super head and expression, good neck and shoulders and good depth of body. Moved out well using his tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> Golding's Sharnphilly Louis Vuitton. Another nice l/w, not quite as mature as 1 but has a lovely head and a kind eye. Well angulated fore and aft with good muscle tone. Not quite as steady on the move as 1 but a nice youngster.

3<sup>rd</sup> Dodds' Raigmore Light Up the Sky for Lyncarda.

#### **YEARLING DOG (7,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Fydal Ace. Smart b/w who has a lovely outline. Lovely head with kind expression. Good quarters and depth of body. Good feet. Moved well, but tail carriage a little high.

2<sup>nd</sup> Flint's Casilex Crescendo. Heavier type than 1 and well up to size but nicely made. Masculine head, good shoulders. Moved soundly.

3<sup>rd</sup> Goode's Handsway Perfect Storm.

#### **POST GRADUATE DOG (15, 0)**

1<sup>st</sup> Best's Shadesett Keep on Believin for Bestina. Have admired this dog from the ringside and liked him a lot on going over him. He is beautifully balanced, has a lovely head, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders. Good quarters and depth of body. Moved well using his tail. RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilcox's Scobec Man in the Mirror. Typy well balanced o/w. Beautiful head with kind eye, well angulated fore and aft, well sprung ribs, good topline and tailset. Moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Stokes' Hawkfield Mischief Maker for Guanabara JW ShCM

#### **LIMIT DOG (9,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Harrison's Millpoint Top Hat N Tails JW ShCM. Lovely well balanced b/w with masculine head and good stop, super neck leading into well laid shoulders, good topline and well muscled quarters. Neat tail which he used well on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Evans & Pavey's Joneva Diamond in the Rough JW. Very stylish o/w who has a lovely well balanced head and soft expression with a good length of neck. Good topline & tailset. Just preferred front angulation and movement of 1.

3<sup>rd</sup> Whistance's Esrews Serious Lord Jack ShCM.

### **OPEN DOG (8,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Hinton's Sh Ch Fleurfields Flambeau. Beautiful o/w who is so well made all through. He has a gorgeous head with a soft expression. Lovely neck and shoulders, good topline, tailset and well muscled quarters. Lovely, effortless free flowing movement. CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Kirby's Haramander Shabby Chic ShCM. Another quality o/w who is well made and stylish. He has a super head with a kind expression and is well angulated fore and aft. Just not as positive on the move as 1.

1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Hurwyn Black Caviar. Loved this quality youngster of 8 months who really stood out in this class. She is well balanced with a beautiful head and expression. Good length of neck into well laid shoulders. Lovely topline and good tailset. Moved well. Should have a bright future. BP.

### **POST GRADUATE BITCH (15,2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Elrington, Green & Cannon's Sh Ch Ansona Lucy Lockett. Quality b/w who is nicely made creating a balanced picture. Lovely feminine head, good neck, shoulders and depth of brisket. Level topline with well set tail. Good bone and neat feet. Sound free mover.
