- 1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky, nice o/w, just a baby so initially had problem with entirety but all found in the end! Level topline & tailset, straight front, moved well;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Reed's Digbyvalley Horacio Nelson, b/w, nice dog but thought this one slightly overweight, even for minor puppy. Moved OK for age;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Feichtinger's Pawprint Estrn Revelation.

## **PUPPY DOG**

1<sup>st</sup> Sillince's Tomlow Déjà Vu, good head with lovely defined stop, arched neck, correct shoulders & good depth, moved with drive. **BPD**;

2<sup>nd</sup> Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky.

1<sup>st</sup> Crawte's Leascliffe Luis, handsome dog with lovely expressive eye, excellent temperament, good coat, level topline, tail set on well. Would prefer more bone;
