# **MINOR PUPPY DOG (3)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn-Bennett & Wilberg's Coralwood Kanix, a very mature puppy very much the finished article. Balanced & symmetrical. Lovely true mover for a baby puppy with driving rear action & correct front. BP;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tait's Moordale Manhatton, very typical puppy with correct outline. Didn't enjoy the conditions & was very unsettled;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Huxley's Aurichalcum Evan Knows its Woodfleet.

# **PUPPY DOG** (5,1a)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Sillence's Tomlow Deja Vu, well balanced. Good head & eye. Well sprung ribs. Strong loin with well turned stifles. Moved well;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tait's Moordale Muskateer, good head & eye. Correct front, ribs & quarters. Not happy in the conditions; 3<sup>rd</sup> Siddle's Calderside If Only at Wilcharime.

#### JUNIOR DOG (8,2)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Watkins & Davies' Hurwyn Law N Order, very promising. Well made all through. Well shaped head & good eye. Good shoulder & front. Deep chest with enough width. Well spring rib, muscular loin & hindquarters. Free mover with correct front action & good rear drive;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Westron's Tenshilling Makin Whoopee at Aurichalcum, another promising youngster. Good balance. Sound mover. Not quite the rear drive of winner;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Pattie's Hurwyn Masterchef.

#### **GRADUATE DOG (3)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes, made the best use of the ring & moved so well. Correct head & expression. Good front & bone. Muscular hindquarters. Correct tail action when moving;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Adams' Ansona Petr Pan, close up to winner. Well balanced. Good head & eye. Correct layback of shoulder. Good width of chest. Well ribbed back. Muscular hindquarters. Sound mover;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Nelis' Freebreeze Yankee Clipper.

# **POST GRADUATE DOG (7)**

1<sup>st</sup> Bell's Crookrise The Medlar at Owlspoint, well balanced all through. Well shaped head & correct eye. Good spring of rib. Strong hindquarters. Movement excellent fore & aft. Displayed really good outline in profile movement; 2<sup>nd</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble, close up to winner. Very typical. Presents well balanced outline. Good head & eye. Strong loin & hindquarters. Not quite movement of winner; 3<sup>rd</sup> Guy's Carofel Just A Minute.

# LIMIT DOG (9)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Hall's Gartarry Peregrine, very correct all through. Movement is spot on & just what the standard asks for. Good head shape with correct eye & true expression. Shoulders well laid back. Correct ribcage. Strong hindquarters. Pushed very hard for top honours. RCC;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Martin's Sunhouse Believe It Or Not, good outline. Pleasing head & expression. Correct shoulders. Good spring of rib. Not quite the movement of winner;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Schwarzkachel-Jackson, Jackson & Blackburn-Benn's Kanix Clifford.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Diamond In The Rough, a dog who really commands the ring. He has such great presence. Well balanced. Excellent head & expression. Construction excellent throughout. Moved well when settled.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Oliveira & Silva's Pt Ch Oliver Do Vale Carvoeiro, very pleasing well balanced dog who is well constructed throughout & moved soundly;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Rossiter, Fox & Mosedale's Am Sh Ch Marsuz Alydar I Like It, I Love It at Solivia.

# **VETERAN DOG** (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Thornton's Westerns Vicarage, although alone he was a worthy winner. In such good condition & moving so well.

#### **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Barker's Braithwaite Ever Thus at Flinthill, just right for age with correct balance & moving so well even at this age with correct covering of the ground;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Rossiter, Aitken & Lenaerts-Pilatus' Weimpoint Lochness, another promising puppy. Not quite the finish of winner. Moved soundly;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Westron's Aurichalcum Elle Fyre.

#### **PUPPY BITCH (9)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Guy & Hinton's Carmandine Cookie Crumble by Fleurfield, quality puppy. Not overdone. Lovely outline. Good head & expression. Deep brisket. Good spring of rib. Strong quarters. Good oval bone. Moved smoothly with good rear drive. BPB;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' Medogold Here Comes The Girl, another lovely puppy who moved with drive but not quite the assurance or head carriage of winner. Well balanced with good flowing lines. Well chiselled head. Good forequarters & ribcage. Well turned stifles;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Harrison's Millpoint Hopes N'Dreams.

# JUNIOR BITCH (9)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Hurwyn Black Caviar, this bitch reminded me of the past Hurwyns & Ernfords title holders. Symmetrical & well balanced all over. Lovely chiselled head. Strong topline & loin. Well ribbed back. Strong quarters with lovely tail action. Will trouble the best once she matures;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> McGilp's Ridanflight Rhosyn, another sound true youngster. Close up to winner. Moved well but not drive of winner;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Udale's Dowbiggins Olympic Gold.

#### **GRADUATE BITCH (4,2)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Barford & Booth's Kiswahili You Live In Me for Protanto, well balanced. Good head & forequarters. Correct tail action. Moved well;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Nelis' Freebreeze Providence, good overall type. Well balanced. Not movement of winner.

# **POST GRADUATE BITCH (11,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Udale's Dowbiggins Coco Pop, lovely bitch with chiselled head & good eye. Correct layback of shoulder. Well ribbed back. Strong hindquarters. Moved correctly demonstrating good ground covering action;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Viva Las Vegas, loved her type. Good head & expression. Just carrying a little excess weight which took away from her outline. Moved very soundly;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Hewitt's Sunhouse As You Like It.

#### LIMIT BITCH (9,1)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Sadler's Crookrise Free And Easy, excellent bitch. True head & expression. Super outline. Good bone. Close up in challenge. RCC;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Bedson & Earl's Caithpoint Sugar Babe, close up to winner. Good overall balance. Sound true mover;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Rayner & Spinks' Spinray Miss Saigon.

2<sup>nd</sup> Harris & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Clover at Zarcrest, another true to type bitch with correct outline & sound free movement;

3<sup>rd</sup> Freebreeze As You Like It.
