Lengthy neck, good sweep of stifle & bone, just lacking the maturity of winner in body & movement;

PUPPY DOG (4)

1st Tait's Moordale Muskateer Impressive liver/w of quality. Lovely chiselled head with good stop & lip. Neat ears, reachy neck into good shoulder. Well-ribbed body of good depth. Moved well;

2nd Walkling's Aspyre Follow Your Dreams to Kiswahili;

3rd Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky.

JUNIOR DOG (3,1)

1st Sillence's Tomlow Déjà vu, quality b/w, lovely head, neat ears, lengthy neck, strong body, good hind angulation, Positive on the move;

2nd Booth's Kanix Garfunkel Strong, muscular b/w with good bone & depth, in hard condition, handled to advantage.

YEARLING DOG (6)

1st Pattie's Hurwyn Masterchef, o/w with lovely head & expression, well developed muscular body, balanced angulation. Moved soundly with reach & drive;

2nd Golding's Sharnphilly Louis Vuitton Quality, liver/w, super head, well put together with flowing lines & many appealing attributes. Preferred the movement of winner;

1st Kirby's Haramander Shabby Chic, gorgeous o/w, all Pointer all through. Lovely head, expression & eye, lengthy muscular neck into well laid & angulated shoulders flowing into correctly made body. Strong over croup, long sweeping muscular stifles all enabling him to move with reach & drive lashing his neat bee sting tail in true fashion. Good topline standing which he held when moving. Shown to advantage by his handler. Delighted to award him CC & BOB;

2nd Alcorn & Lynn's Sh Ch Afterglow Bare Face Lie at Kanix, imposing & strongly made liver/w with good lines, sweeping muscular stifles used to advantage, driving hind movement;

3rd McNab's Shanandi Dark Shadow of Querdon.

1st Anderson-Rowell's Daledancer Silver Fame, attractive o/w, lovely chiselled head, good lip & dark eye, lengthy neck, good spring of rib, hard muscular condition, Active, sound mover;

2nd Batchelor's Hookwood Its A Kind Of Magic, b/w, pretty head, nice lines, but at an immature stage in body, sound & happy on the move;

3rd Kelly's Fleurfield Faith Of Kelval.

YEARLING BITCH (5)

1st Dyer's Sharnphilly Juici Cuture, classy liver/w, built on flowing lines, lovely chiselled head, with good stop, lip & kind expression, neat ears, good reach of neck, rib & depth, well turned stifle, low hock, moved with reach & drive, good carriage, holding her topline & correctly carried tail. CC;

2nd Wilkinson's Hurwyn Black Caviar, quality b/w with good lines, balanced angulation, well muscled, sound mover;

3rd Grantham-Moss & Walkling's Walanpay Sun Dancer at Kingspoint.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (16,3)

1st Smith's Fydal Ava Typy, o/w with pretty chiselled head, kind expression, good neck, body & topline. Super bee sting tail, neat all through, sound happy & balanced mover holding her shape. RCC;

2nd Macmanus' Luneville Strawberry Moon, lemon/w, pleasing head & expression, good neck & rib, strong hindquarters, neat tail, moved well;

3rd Whitham's Penwest Pride Of Sedgekirk.

LIMIT BITCH (11,3)

1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Hazy Hazy Dream, o/w, lovely head & expression, super eyes & correct slight dish face appearance, lengthy muscular neck, good front assembly, strong body, neat tail, in hard condition, moved well;
