My winners were chosen, without exception, for their true Pointer type. All had balanced well chiselled heads, correct sloping pasterns, correct shoulder placement & the level topline which is a requirement of our Standard.

In fact, with none of the following which are changing the look of the "English" Pointer – hound head & bone, well placed shoulders which restrict front movement, sloping topline, low tailset, over angulated stifles hocks making it impossible to have a powerful driving action.

The exhibitors provided generous applause which greeted my winners & a cheery friendly atmosphere in & around my ring.

VETERAN DOG (1)

1st Wilson's Bonnygate Imperial Choice, what a picture this lovely dog presented, pleased me in all departments, quality & strength in abundance, moved smoothly with his handler. **BV**.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (7)

- 1st Theobald, Phillips & Westaway's Penwest Palla, upstanding youngster, well balanced throughout, moved soundly & steadily, in very good condition;
- 2nd Walkling's Aspyre Follow Your Dreams to Kiswahili, promising youngster, strong & compact, moved well with handler. As 1 one for the future;
- 3rd Feichtinger's Pawprint Eastern Revelation.

PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1st Tait's Moordale Manhatton, outstanding puppy, filled my eye with his quality & type, beautiful head, reachy neck into well laid shoulders, good spring of rib & depth, well angulated, moved soundly & with drive. **RCC**, **BPD**;
