I was pleased with all my winners and thought my dog and bitch CC winners were typical examples of the breed.

PUPPY DOG (7)

- 1st Adams & Elrington's Ansona Albert Einstein. Nearly 8 months old B/W. Young dog with a lot of scope, good bone and balanced proportions throughout. Moved steadily using his tail. BPD
- 2nd Tait's Moordale Muskateer. 11 months old Liver/W. Nice head and expression, well angulated front and rear, not as confident on the move as my winner.
- 3rd Walkling's Aspyre Follow Your Dreams To Kiswahili (imp)

JUNIOR DOG (2, 1)

1st Welch's Hookwood only me. 16 months. B/W. Well presented, good reach of neck, correct depth of chest, neat hocks, uses his tail to advantage.

POST GRADUATE DOG (14, 1)

- 1st Macmanus' Luneville Harvey Moon. B/W. Clean outline, head with such a kind expression, good feet and pasterns, deep short coupled body, moved well on a good stride.
- 2nd Cardiff's Prosperity Va Va Voom JW. B/W. Very sound dog. Well built all over, he also moves on a good length of stride, preferred winners head but it was a close decision.
- 3rd Westron's Tenshiling Makin Whopee At Aurichalcum.

LIMIT DOG (14, 1) My class of the day, it was a pleasure to judge so many nice dogs.

- 1st Theobald's Tycarreg Strangely Familyr JW ShCM. B/W. A dog of good size and balance. Beautiful head with a dark eye and melting expression, well constructed all through with no exaggerations, which showed in his movement, he moved on a long easy stride extending well at the front and driving off his hindquarters using his tail. **DCC.**
- 2^{nd} Harrison's Millpoint Heat Wave JW. B/W. Nicely balanced young dog who has a gorgeous head eye and expression, Clean in outline from his long neck to his well set on tail. Sound mover. \int .
- 3rd Wood's Wilchrimane Let's Boogie At Penbro.

OPEN DOG (5)

- 1st Marsh's Sharnphilly Redshank For Ratchda. B/W. Well balanced, typical head and good body, moved well, shown in hard condition.
- 2nd O'Neill's Hurwyn Some Might Say JW. B/W. Elegant dog all through, preferred his head and expression to winner but could not match the winners hind movement.
- 3rd Gordon's Hawkfield Let's Go Crackers.

VETERAN BITCH (3)

- 1st Barker's Sh Ch Flinthill Wild Thyme JW. B/W. 7 years. Have always admired this bitch, lots of character and presence in a ring, balanced head with a soft expression, moved with drive and style in the class, did not go so well in the challenge which was a pity. **BV**.
- 2nd Cardiff's Prosperity My Fair Lady ShCM. Lemon/W. 9 and a half. This girl was really enjoying her day out, lovely reach of neck and a short tail, could not match the winner on movement.
- 3rd Macmanus' Crookrise Moondance at Luneville.

PUPPY BITCH (8)

- 1st Barker's Braithwaite Ever Thus At Flinthill. B/W. 10 months old. Clean outline, well boned, soft expression, moved round the ring covering her ground and holding her topline. **BPIB**
- 2nd Stilgoe's Teisgol Irinara. B/W. Just over 6 months. Giving away age here, sweet head with good bone and bend of stifle, short neat hocks, moved well.
- 3rd Roberts' Ansona Isadora Duncan At Byphar.

JUNIOR BITCH (5)

- 1st Droveborough Hosking's Hope For Bentham. Liver/W. Just over 12 months. Nothing overdone and everything correct, appealing head and kind eye, loved her neat little tail. Needs to settle in her movement, but she is only a baby.
- 2nd Gloyn's Thorncross Drive On By. B/W. 14 months old. Good proportions to head, clean neck and shoulders, balanced body with good depth.
- 3rd Rankine's Tenshilling Rumour Has It Fyldefair.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (19, 4)

- 1st Rankine's Tenshilling Rags To Riches At Fyldefair JW ShCM. O/W. Well made all through, liked her head and expression, clean in outline with correct confirmation which showed in her movement.
- 2nd Wilkinson's Hurwyn Black Caviar. B/W. Loved this very feminine bitch's head. She is well constructed and built on clean lines. Moves accurately.
- 3rd Kolbach's Wozopeg Paprika.

LIMIT BITCH (12)

- 1st Perkins' Luneville Honey Moon At Brent ShCM. O/W. Loved her head and expression, long neck, well balanced with flowing top line, good angulation in her quarters, carries herself so well on the move. **RBCC**.
- 2nd Welch's Hookwood Solar Star. B/W. Totally different to my winner, well made bitch, who is not exaggerated in any way, she moves truly and has a lovely stride.
- 3rd Dyer's Sharnphilly Juici Cuture JW.

OPEN BITCH (3)

- 1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Ice Maiden JW. O/W. This bitch was on top form, I liked her when I judged her 2 years ago but today she commanded attention. Balanced throughout, in gleaming coat and muscular condition, great movement in profile with extension and drive, also very true coming and going. **BCC, BOB & G4**
- 2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Let It Shine JW CW '10. O/W. Sound moving with lovely flowing lines, sweet head and fine ears, Balanced from head to toe, unfortunate to meet up with my winners today.
- 3rd Cardiff's Prosperity Sheer Elegance.
