## **MINOR PUPPY DOG (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Adams & Elrington's Ansona Albert Einstein, lovely outline, excels in bone, forechest & depth of chest, lovely neat feet, long upper & lower thigh, lovely masculine head, not overdone, nice topline, moved OK; 2<sup>nd</sup> Warford's Lakespar Sweet Sensation, not as mature in forechest & depth of chest as 1 but has all the essentials. Nice length & return of upper arm, good length of upper & lower thigh. Movement a little loose but only a baby.

# PUPPY DOG (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn-Bennett & Wilberg's Coralwood Kanix Mr T, lovely outline, super head, eye & expression, good length of neck, nice forechest, well muscled throughout, excellent depth of chest & well ribbed back, nice topline, good length of upper & lower thigh, neat feet, moved better behind than in front. **BP** 

# JUNIOR DOG (2)

1<sup>st</sup> Booth's Kanix Garfunkel, nice eye & expression, excellent lay of shoulder, nice length of upper arm, good depth of chest & well ribbed back to short loin, nice croup & topline, moved well fore & aft.

## YEARLING DOG (5)

1<sup>st</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble, nice outline & well muscled throughout, full of curves, nice head with good length of muzzle, nice length of upper & lower thigh, good depth of chest, well rounded loin, nice front & good feet. Movement a little high in front;

2<sup>nd</sup> Pattie's Hurwyn Masterchef, similar qualities as 1, just not quite so mature, expressive head with large open nose, well rounded ribs, similar in movement to 1;

3<sup>rd</sup> Booth's Kanix Garfunkel.

# **POST GRADUATE DOG** (5)

1<sup>st</sup> Batchelor's Groma Jesse James, overall best made in the class with good forechest, excellent depth of chest, nice masculine head & expression with large open nose, good width of upper & lower thigh, oval bone, moved well fore & aft;

2<sup>nd</sup> Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Tenshilling Its Now Or Never at Spinray, not quite as mature as 1 but nice outline, good length of neck & nice depth of chest, good head with muzzle being sufficiently concave, nice length of upper & lower thigh, moved better behind than in front; 3<sup>rd</sup> Hoyland's Panoply Perfect Choice.

### LIMIT DOG (5)

1<sup>st</sup> Perkins' Kanix Fate Of Brent, b/w, stood out in this class in outline & movement, lovely head with nice length of muzzle & skull, nice eye & expression & large open nose, strong neck of sufficient length, nice lay of shoulder & return of upper arm, excellent depth of chest, well ribbed back to strong loin, nice croup, good width & length of upper & lower thigh, moved stylishly with correct movement & lashing tail; 2<sup>nd</sup> Whistance's Escrows Serious Lord Jack, nice dog with a lovely head, just not quite the front movement of 1, well muscled throughout, good depth of chest & nice length of upper & lower thigh, neat well padded feet, excellent lay of shoulder & return of upper arm; 3rd Batchelor's Groma Jesse James.

## **OPEN DOG** (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Diamond In The Rough, most mature in the class with beautiful outline full of curves & well muscled throughout, beautiful head, eye & expression, best of fronts, lovely bone, nice topline & excellent depth of chest, well ribbed back leading to strong loin, moved very well really covering the ground on neat feet with good tail action; **DCC** 

2<sup>nd</sup> Blackburn's Kanix Fredrik, lovely dog with very refined head, well made throughout with excellent length of neck, lay of shoulder & return of upper & lower arm, well ribbed back & nice forechest. Just not quite as mature as my CC winner but should have a good future. Moved very well on neat feet. **RDCC**; 3<sup>rd</sup> Rossiter, Fox & Mosedale's Am Sh Ch Marsuz Alydar I Like It I Love It at Solivia.

## **VETERAN DOG** (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Wilcox's Sh Ch Pipeaway Zonic Tonic for Merynjen, nice outline with good length of neck, depth of chest & nice bone, little long in loin, good length & width of upper & lower thigh, nice forechest, good ratio of muzzle to skull, nice tail length & action, moved better in front than behind.

# **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Hurwyn Rock On Ruby, lovely elegant outline, excellent feminine head with dark eye & nice expression, excellent length of neck & lay of shoulder, good oval bone, well ribbed back to short loin, nice tailset, excellent length of upper & lower thigh for age, well muscled throughout, still a bit unsteady on the move, but sound;

2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol Irinara, lovely type with very nice outline, excellent lay of shoulder & return of upper & lower arm, nice forechest & excellent depth of chest for age, well ribbed back to short loin, moved well on neat feet. Just preferred head of 1;

3<sup>rd</sup> Ruell's Kanix Herlia at Stonewardine.

### **PUPPY BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Fleetwood's Tyremy Southseaspice, very nice with good angulation throughout, excellent length of neck & lay of shoulder, nicely muscled with good bone & good depth of chest, well ribbed back to short loin, feminine head with lovely eye & expression & nice skull shape, moved well fore & aft on good feet; 2<sup>nd</sup> Rossiter, Aitken & Pilatus-Lenaert's Weimpoint Lochness, lovely outline & quite mature for age, lovely length & width of upper & lower thigh & excellent depth of chest, very pretty head with nice dark eye, good length of neck, just needs more confidence both standing & on the move.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Rankine's Tenshilling Rumour Has It Fyldefair, beautiful bitch with excellent outline, lovely head with muzzle of sufficient concave shape, nice length of skull to muzzle ratio, excellent strength & length of neck, good lay of shoulder & excellent return of upper arm, good depth of chest & well rounded ribs to short loin, lovely width of upper & lower thigh; good bone, moved covering the ground well with a nice lashing tail action.

#### **YEARLING BITCH (4)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Rose's Ridanflight Rhianna, beautiful, typical outline, in excellent muscular condition, feminine head with dark expressive eye, excellent length of neck to well laid shoulder, good forechest with sufficient width in front, excellent depth of chest & well ribbed back to strong short loin, excellent hindquarters & good oval bone, moved well really covering the ground with each stride. **RBCC**;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol Foxy Lady, nice bitch with all the essentials, just preferred length of upper arm of 1, nice bone, good depth of chest & excellent forechest, good length of neck, well let down hocks of sufficient length, moved well;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Batchelor's Hookwood It's A Kind Of Magic.

## **POST GRADUATE BITCH (5)**

1<sup>st</sup> Rankine's Tenshilling Rags To Riches at Fyldefair, stood out in this class for outline, head & condition, beautiful feminine head with nice skull shape, good muzzle length & shape, nice expressive eye, good length & strength of neck, excellent front assembly, good spring of rib to short strong loin, nicely developed hindquarters, moved well with good tail action;

2<sup>nd</sup> Cooper's Trosnant Contessa Medici, lovely type, just not quite the confidence of 1. Well made throughout with excellent forechest & length of neck, nice head with good skull to muzzle ratio & large open nose, in excellent muscular condition, moved well on neat feet;

3<sup>rd</sup> Paton's Peakdale Silver Ribbon with Bunnahabhain.

## **LIMIT BITCH (10)**

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Joneva Hazy Dream, o/w, really stood out & so nice to go over, strength with elegance & lots of curves, beautiful head with nice eye & expression, good length of muzzle & skull, excellent length of neck to well laid shoulder & good length of upper arm, good depth of chest of sufficient width & nicely ribbed back, excellent length & width of upper & lower thigh, good topline, moved very well on neat feet, excellent bone;

2<sup>nd</sup> Ward's Kiswahili Timely Nu Edition to Jakobstown, similar comments apply, well made throughout with lovely feminine head, excellent oval bone & excellent length of upper & lower thigh, in muscular condition, moved soundly covering the ground well;

3<sup>rd</sup> Cooper's Kanix Buttons of Trosnant.

### **OPEN BITCH (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Sh Ch Wilchrimane Ice Maiden, very muscular & well built & in excellent hard condition, well proportioned head with nice eye & expression, sufficient width in front with good forechest, nice length of neck & good length of shoulder, excellent depth of chest with well rounded ribcage to short loin, excellent width of upper & lower thigh, moved well really covering the ground on neat feet, particularly impressive movement when viewed in profile. **BCC**, **BOB** & **Grp3**;

2<sup>nd</sup> Cooper's Kanix Buttons of Trosnant, nice bitch, well made throughout, sweet head with nice eye & good open nose, excellent forechest, neck & shoulders, good depth of chest & nice topline, moved soundly on neat feet with good tail action;

3<sup>rd</sup> Grime & Byrne's Ansona Jenny Wren at Enryb.

1<sup>st</sup> Ward's Kiswahili Timely Nu Edition to Jakobstown;
