#### MINOR PUPPY DOG (4)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Sillence's Tomlow Déjà Vu. 7 mths, shapely baby, lovely head with dark eyes. Excellent bone and angulation. Moved steadily.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Bowmar's Millpoint Field of Dreams at Stoneygun, 9 mths. Well grown youngster. Nicely shaped head with a kind expression. Well angulated and moved well.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Abbott's Millpoint Dare to Dream For Mirasol

#### PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Calderside If Only at Wilchrimane 10 mths Good head and earset. Well boned, good angulation and nice outline. Excellent muscle tone which showed in his positive movement.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Booth's Kanix Garfunkel, 11 mths. Very masculine with a good head and expression. Deep chest and well ribbed. Held his tail well on the move.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Welch's Hookwood Only Me JW ShCM.

# **JUNIOR DOG** (10)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough and Tumble, 16 mths. Elegant boy with a good head, neck, shoulders and outline. Good bone and angulation. Moved with drive but a tad too fast which made him a little erratic, but a lovely type.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Watkins & Davies' Hurwyn Law N' Order, 14 mths. Another good youngster, same remarks apply but not as mature in body at present. Moved steadily holding his topline.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Golding's Sharnphilly Louis Vuitton. Liked his head and body shape and is well made all through with good bone. Fidgety when standing but really moved with reach and drive holding his topline.

1<sup>st</sup> Bedson & Earl's Caithpoint Hot Chocolate. Did his best to throw this class away but he has a good body shape with a good head, depth, angulation and muscle tone, moved out well driving from his hocks when settled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Schwarzachel-Jackson, Jackson & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Clifford. Nice type who is longer cast than 1, he has a good head with dark eyes, kind expression and thin ear leathers. Well muscled hindquarters, moved steadily.

#### LIMIT DOG (9,abs2)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Theobald's Tycarreg Strangely Familiar JW ShCM. Handsome boy with everything as it should be, looked good from all angles, level topline and straight front with good depth of brisket. Driving, true movement covering the ground with ease. Well Handled. CC.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Wilcox's Scobec Man in the Mirror. Gentle, soft expression and nice head shape with neat ears. Clean lines and not overdone in any way. Moved soundly and correctly.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Sillince's SH CH Tomlow Night and Day. Quality bitch who has maintained her outline and moves well. Good head with kind expression. Correct bone and substance. Shown in excellent condition.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Cardiff's Prosperity My Fair Lady ShCM. Not the head of 1. Well presented and in excellent muscular condition. Neat tail. Moved well with plenty of drive.

# MINOR PUPPY BITCH (7, 1abs) 3 very nice puppies.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Guy and Hinton's Carmandine Cookie Crumble Very promising young lady who is coming on nicely. Pretty head & sweet expression. Level topline, good front and angulation. Moved well. Very promising. BPIB.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Lowes' Lowsmoor Little Karoo Another very nice puppy with a good outline, lovely neck and shoulders. Unlucky to meet 1 but not as forward at this stage. Moved steadily.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Best's Bestina Betty Boop. Pleasing type. Appealing head and expression. Good front and angulation. Neat tail which she used well. Nicely grown for age and moved freely and confidently.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Rose's Ridanflight Rhianna. Stylish youngster who has a pleasing feminine head. Good body proportions with a reachy neck and deep chest. Moved out well in profile but just needs to settle in front.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Wilkinson's Hurwyn Black Caviar. Pretty headed, shapely young lady with good angulation and bone. Steady on the move although just lacking a little animation today. Not as mature as 1.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Dyer's Sharnphilly Juici Cuture JW. Good head, flowing outline and correct topline. Nicely proportioned throughout with good angulation and bone, moved out really well.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Lathwell's Teisgol Its Your Chance for Tintchitamba. Built on heavier lines than 1. Pleasing head and nicely put together. Good body shape and well carried tail. Nice all round.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Craik's Scobec Ice Maiden. Lovely type who presents a good balanced picture, prettiest of heads with a kind expression, good length of neck and depth of chest, neat tail. Lovely outline and moved true coming and going but just lost her enthusiasm in the challenge.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> O'Neill's Tenshilling Viva Las Vegas JW. Elegant, pretty bitch with plenty of depth. Good overall make and shape. Well muscled. Moved with drive.

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's SH CH Wilchrimane Ice Maiden JW. Top quality, feminine young lady, good head with expressive eyes and neat ears. Beautifully balanced and moves with a lovely head carriage. Well muscled which showed as she powered round the ring, keeping her shape and using her neat tail. Such ring presence and could not be denied CC & BOB and went on to a well deserved Group 2.

2<sup>nd</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's SH CH Kanix Chilli. Larger type than 1. Balanced outline, strong body with good depth and well ribbed, moved effortlessly with plenty of drive.

3<sup>rd</sup> Naden's Wychwood Midsomer Dream

#### **GOOD CITIZEN SCHEME BITCH (5)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's SH CH Wilchrimane Ice Crystal. Another quality bitch of lovely type, built on smaller lines than her sister and many of the same comments apply, she is shapely but unfortunately today suffering from a slightly loose underline. Moved well using her tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stangroom's Janeryl's Desert Flower at Lappakia ShCM. This bitch certainly doesn't show her age. Sweet head, larger mould all round than 1 with a deep chest and good muscle tone. Steady accurate mover fore and aft. Well handled

3<sup>rd</sup> Brooksmith's Nightgold Blackavar
