Temperament was excellent on the whole but we must never forget the standard states 'kind, even temperament'.

## **MINOR PUPPY DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Wilcox's Wilchrimane Bold Move for Merynjen, o/w 8 month puppy of lovely type & balance. Excels in head with dark eye & fine leathers. Good length of neck with excellent lay of shoulder. Good depth for age, short coupled with lovely strong quarters & width of thigh. Good mover who used tail well. Promising puppy;

2<sup>nd</sup> Webb's Wilchrimane Rough Crystal, I see he is litter brother to 1 but not so forward & looking more raw today. Pleasing head & good angulation, needs to tighten on the move; 3<sup>rd</sup> Tannahill's Wynbury Walter Jack.

# **PUPPY DOG** (4,1a)

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane C'Mon Norbert, another well balanced litter brother of 8 months. Same attributes apply & could easily change places with winner of previous class. Lovely head with excellent expression. Straight front with good bone & feet. Nice spring of rib. Lovely outline when stacked. Held topline on the move covering the ground well. Mature puppy for age. BPD;

2<sup>nd</sup> Tibbs' Raigmore Astronomer Royal, lovely type but lost out on maturity to 1 today. Excellent well proportioned head. Reachy neck with well laid shoulder. Strong quarters. Just needs more time. Excellent mover;

3<sup>rd</sup> Phelps' Millpoint Rock A Bye Baby.

# JUNIOR DOG (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol I Am The One & Only, compact dog of lovely type. Not overdone & very well balanced. Classic head. Excellent angulation fore & aft. Good spring of rib & depth. Strong quarters with well let down hocks. Excels in bone & feet. Moved well;

2<sup>nd</sup> Warford's Lakespar Sweet Sensation, larger framed, longer bodied dog who still need to mature. Pleasing head. Good feet & pasterns. Well bent stifles. Moved OK; 3<sup>rd</sup> Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky.

# YEARLING DOG (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Adams' Ansona Albert Einstein, very smart beautifully balanced dog with great outline & type. Excels in head, neck & shoulder. Tight feet with sloping pasterns. Compact well ribbed body with strong quarters. Showy positive mover. Well handled;

2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol I Am The One & Only;

3<sup>rd</sup> Reed's Digbyvalley Horacio Nelson.

## **NOVICE DOG** (2)

1<sup>st</sup> Wynbury Walter Jack, raw baby who just needs more time. Nice head. Long flowing neck with good shoulder. Excellent bone & feet. Well angulated front & back. Would benefit from a little more ringcraft; 2<sup>nd</sup> England's Dalens Live & Let Die, stronger in head. Good depth. Bit unsettled on the move.

# **UNDER GRADUATE DOG** (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Isherwood's Symitry Red Rascal, lovely dog with flowing lines & excellent pointer type. Well balanced throughout. Classic head. Excels in angulation bone & pasterns & feet. Good mover but would prefer better tail carriage which spoilt an otherwise lovely dog.

# **POST GRADUATE DOG (8)**

1<sup>st</sup> Oddie's Wilchrimane Igoyougo at Riowood, compact dog which exudes Pointer type & character. In tiptop condtion. Chiselled head with good eye & kind expression. Well muscled throughout with a good deep well sprung rib. Correct pasterns & feet. Excellent angulation. Excitable today but when settled was an excellent powerful mover with correct lashing tail. An animated dog who looked as though he could do a day's work. CC;

2<sup>nd</sup> Petherick's Hawkfield All At Sea, another nice dog but of longer type. Lovely head & good shoulder. Good depth with well muscled angulated rear. Moved well holding topline & tail well; 3<sup>rd</sup> Smith's Blueyonda Flashy Rendition.

### MID LIMIT DOG (9)

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Calderside If Only at Wilchrimane, another quality well constructed dog with beautiful head, eye & expression. Good lengthy well arched neck flowing into excellent shoulder. Short coupled with strong loin & powerful quarters. Good bone with tight feet. Another with excellent movement & pointer character:

2<sup>nd</sup> Watkins' Hurwyn Law N' Order, splitting hairs with placings in this class but preferred shorter couplings of 1 otherwise very similar merits apply. Another beautifully balanced dog with excellent angulation & correct movement & tail;

3<sup>rd</sup> Dodds' Light Up The Sky for Lyncarda.

#### **LIMIT DOG** (13,2)

1<sup>st</sup> Coggins' Droveborough Born To Bound at Gemrose, this dog caught my eye whenever he entered the ring, masculine, upstanding & full of presence. My immediate thought was he might be worthy of top honours today. L/w of old fashioned type & lots to like about him. Excellent masculine head, neck & shoulder. Great spring of rib with correct short couplings, good bone & feet. Well angulated quarters which allowed him to move with great reach in front, drive behind & correct tail action. Unfortunately, because of an incident after the prize cards had been given out, & to my great disappointment, I could not let him go any further;

2<sup>nd</sup> Harrison's Millpoint Heat Wave, different type but stills excels in balance & outline Exquisite head & front. Slightly longer in coupling than 1 but good angulation front & rear. Strong quarters. Good mover but would prefer a bit more animation. Very elegant dog;

3<sup>rd</sup> Newberry's Pipeaway Forte Fortuna for Giulia.

### **OPEN DOG** (31)

1<sup>st</sup> Kirby's Sh Ch Haramander Shabby Chic, lovely head with mild appealing expression. Good balance & angulation. I have judged him before & have never seen him moving so well as today. This dog can show some of the younger ones how to move with great extension in front while using his tail correctly. Pressed the winner of Veteran very hard today;

2<sup>nd</sup> Adams' Sh Ch Ansona Simple Simon, another I have judged before & has everything in the right place. Just lost out today by lack of reach in front, but still of classic shape & balance 3<sup>rd</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol I Am The One And Only

# **VETERAN DOG** (5,1)

1<sup>st</sup> Drake's Sh Ch Clamerkin Crystal Mountain, beautifully balanced dog with lovely flowing lines, still looking good a 7 years old. Classic elegant head & neck with great depth & spring of rib. Short coupled with strong loin. Still has lovely flowing movement round the ring. In excellent condition for age. Well handled. RCC:

2<sup>nd</sup> Gordon's Dapper In Black, still looking good today & enjoying his day out. Well proportioned head with lovely dark eye. Good bone & tight feet. Well put together. Energetic mover; 3<sup>rd</sup> Naden's Wychwood Love Over Gold.

1<sup>st</sup> Reed's Millpoint Must Be Love, well bodied b/w bitch who was nearly 9 months. Mature puppy with a balanced outline which she held as she moved;

2<sup>nd</sup> Flint's Wynbury Golden Chalice at Fleurfield, chunky baby who gave away a lot due to age. Preferred the head of 1. However there was a lot to like about this youngster.

# **PUPPY BITCH (9)**

1<sup>st</sup> Brooksmith's Medogold Kiss N'Tell, very difficult class to judge as there was a great divergence of type. Chose 1 because of her overall balance & soundness. Nothing overdone & moved as sound as a bell; 2<sup>nd</sup> Tibbs' Raigmore Andromeda, quality bitch built on finer lines who pressed hard to win. Just a little less steady on the move. Her day will come;

3<sup>rd</sup> Stuckey's Medogold Coralie of Pendan.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol Irinara, as always from this kennel a well balanced, free moving youngster with well let down hocks, attractive head & soft expression. Handled sensitively to show off her full potential; 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Just A Rumour by Jacobstown, lighter cast b/w bitch. Pretty head on

well muscled body. Moved stylishly round the ring;

3<sup>rd</sup> Green's Kanix Hyacinth.

# **YEARLING BITCH (5)**

1<sup>st</sup> Guy's Carmadine Cookie Crumble by Fleurfield, compact bitch when stacked presented a pleasing picture. Beautifully conformed & moved stylishly. One for the future;

2<sup>nd</sup> Tibbs' Somerled Classic Romance at Raigmore, another impressive bitch, slightly longer cast than 1. Looks like she could do a day's work as well muscled & free moving. Very feminine attractive head; 3<sup>rd</sup> Harrison's Millpoint Hopes n Dreams.

Would like to see her move on a bit in the challenge; 2<sup>nd</sup> Reynolds' Pipeway Cara Mia at Sanselmo, smaller bitch who looks as though she could work all day. Well laid shoulders & totally balanced. Moved energetically with grace around the ring; 3<sup>rd</sup> Tannahill's Wynbury Ailsa.

### MID LIMIT BITCH (8)

St Rose's Ridanflight Rhonwen, excellent balance & conformation. Flowing lines. Super head & expression. Moved well;
