If we don't have correct forequarters it leads to short necks, incorrect topline, no extension in front movement and is a distraction to a general outline of graceful curves.

VETERAN DOG (2)

1st Naden's Wychwood Love Over Gold. Possessing a balanced head with kind eye and expression. Has the best of feet and correct pasterns. In first class order moved with ease and soundness.

2nd Gordon's Hawkfield Dapper In Black JW. Well put together gentleman, kind expression. Just a little erratic in front movement today.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Freebreeze Over The Top At Spinray. 6 mths liver/white. Everything right for age. Balanced head and kind expression. Excellent bone. Good size, found him balanced throughout. Stylish on the move making a nice shape and covering the ground with ease.

2nd Newberry's Pipeaway Pietro Of Giulia. Gave his handler a hard time but only 6 mths so has time. Loved his balanced head. Good bone, well muscled hindquarters, moved well when settled.
