I would like to thank the club for inviting me to judge. Also thanks to exhibitors for a pleasing entry. On the whole the bitches had more quality than the dogs. Quite a few dogs had a lack of oval bone. Some feet were quite open & not correct. Also a few upright shoulders.

On the plus side I found some impressive dogs to go over. Breed character & temperament shone through.

## VETERAN DOG (5,1a)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Floyd, lovely head, eye & expression, well balanced with good body proportions. Nice feet & legs. A very outgoing character. Covered the ground well;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Smith's Toberdoney Fergus at Fydal, good head with wide flared nostril. Strong hindquarters & good spring of rib. Purposeful mover;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Moulding & Marsh's Ch Bilsborough's Bright Moon.

## PUPPY DOG (2)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane C'mon Norbert, stylish young dog with beautiful head, eye & expression. Good depth & spring of rib. Low set hocks. Still needs time to grow into himself & mature which will come with age. Should have a bright future;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Scott & Legg's Narsad's Will Turner, well laid back ribs, excellent feet with arched toes. Well chiselled head & kind eye. Neat tail. Sound mover.

#### JUNIOR DOG (6)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Gerrard's Hookwood Showpiece at Carmandine, strong & athletic all through with good hindquarters, confident happy mover;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tibbs & Chisholm's Raigmore Cosmic Star, smart, well balanced dog with nice lines. Good feet & legs. Has presence & style. Moved well;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Hazeltine's Hookwood By George.

## YEARLING DOG (2)

1<sup>st</sup> Huxley's Aurichalcum Evan Knows Its Woodfleet, good head, neck & shoulders, strong loin & hindquarters. Nice width of thigh. Well turned stifles. A workmanlike dog but not overdone. Pleasing in all departments. RCC; 2<sup>nd</sup> Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky, heavier than 1. Strong all through. Good depth, nice type. Just lacked animation.

## **ND** (3)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Gerrard's Hookwood Showpiece at Carmandine;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Hazeltine's Hookwood By George, nice neck into sloping shoulders, good depth, angulation & width of thigh. Fluent mover;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane C'mon Norbert.

## **GRADUATE DOG** (4)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Nelis' Freebreeze Yankee Clipper, good substance. Strong over loin & nice width of thigh. Athletic with good muscletone. Well constructed all through;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Smith's Fydal Ace, elegant b/w with nice lines. Attractive head into good neck & shoulders. Good body proportions. Correct feet, legs & sloping pasterns;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Anderson Rowell's Daledancer Silver Fame.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Dom, compact, well balanced dog, shown in hard condition. Strong, well muscled hindquarters, good positive mover;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tibb's Raigmore Shine From Afar, nice head, kind eye, correct well set on ears, good topline, lovely bee sting tail used to advantage when on the move;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Batchelor's Groma Jesse James at Kielderpoint.

#### **LIMIT DOG** (11,4)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Dodd's Light Up The Sky for Lyncarda, smart, stylish dog. Appealing head with kind expression, neat ears well set on, lovely arched neck & lay of shoulder. Good width of second thigh. Nice topline;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Barker's Flinthill Chocolate Thyme, well balanced, good front, ribs carried well back. Strong in make & shape without being overdone. Nice expanse of second thigh. Good mover;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Bell's Crookrise The Medlar at Owlspoint.

## **OPEN DOG** (10)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Ch Pt Oliver Do Vale Carvoeiro, compact, agile & athletic, not big in stature but with powerful attributes & substance. Shown in good hard condition. Pleasing head, kind eye & expression. Plenty of character & panache. Fluent mover. Pleased to award him the CC;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Evan & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Diamond In The Rough, good head with nicely arched neck. Correct upper arm & good spring of rib. Strong well muscled hindquarters. Moved with drive;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Westron's Aurichalcum Lord Becket of Castlepoint.

#### **VETERAN BITCH (5,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tibbs' Sh Ch/Ir Ch Raigmore Let It Shine, pretty o/w, very feminine with lovely lines. Attractive head & soft eye. Nice feet & pasterns. Oozes class & style. Moved with enthusiasm. BV;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Stangroom's Medogold Wanna Be Posh for Lappakia, looking good at 8 years of age. Nicely constructed, good positive movement;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> MacManus' Crookrise Moondance at Luneville.

#### **FIELD TRIAL BITCH (3,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Huxley's Ch Woodfleet Siennarain, a sound, honest I/w with good body proportions. Nothing exaggerated about her. 9 years old & still spritely on the move;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Blower's Bonnygate Karriage Queen of Deadaway, shown in excellent condition. Not so positive in movement as 1.

#### PUPPY BITCH (3,1)

- 1<sup>st</sup> MacManus' Crookrise Diva by Luneville, smart b/w, sweet head, soft expression, well balanced. Has ring presence & personality. Moved well. BP;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Pride N Prejudice, very feminine, of finer type than 1. Neat ears, kind eye, good muscletone. An attractive puppy with lots to like.

#### **JUNIOR BITCH (7,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Barker's Flinthill Sunshine Suzy, stylish youngster. Lovely head, good reach of neck, nice flowing lines, well ribbed body, good feet & pasterns. I liked her outgoing attitude. Alert & fluent on the move;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Welch's Oxfordacres Trinity by Hookwood, graceful appearance combined with strength. Lovely arched neck. Good shoulders & upper arm. Nice topline. Strong over loin with good width of thigh; 3<sup>rd</sup> Dodd's Raigmore Starshine for Lyncarra.

1<sup>st</sup> Rossiter, Aitken & Lenaert's Weimpoint Lochness, pleasant head, good shoulders, nice feet & legs, well balanced dog who covered the ground well;

2<sup>nd</sup> Smith's Lypal Once Upon A Time, good head, expression, neck & shoulders. Nice topline. Strong over loin. Not so fluent on the move as 1.

## **GRADUATE BITCH** (9)

1<sup>st</sup> Ward's Adventures Of Isabel to Jakobstown, kind head & expression, good length of neck, adequate mover; 2<sup>nd</sup> Klein-Woolthuis' Tenshilling Take It All to Haxalgate, heavier type than 1. Very sound. Strong all through. Nice width of thigh. Really covered the ground well with plenty of drive;

3<sup>rd</sup> Huxley's Woodfleet Shoot The Sun.

#### **POST GRADUATE BITCH (11,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Kelly's Fleurfield Faith of Keval, nice lines, very feminine. Best of feet, legs, pasterns & good bone. Strong hindquarters, moved with drive & used her tail;

2<sup>nd</sup> Backler's Kanix Find The Dream, pleasing head, nice neck, front, good ribcage. Correct feet & legs. Neat tail; 3<sup>rd</sup> Roberts' Woodfleet Lasoo The Moon.

#### **LIMIT BITCH (13,3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Fairbairn & Madigan's Misperros Jumanji of Carmelfair, attractive head with good length of neck, well laid back shoulder, good front & ribcage. Strong hindquarters. An excellent mover;

2<sup>nd</sup> Tibb's Somerled Classic Romance of Raigmore, pretty head with kind expression, lovely flowing lines, nice feet, legs & pasterns, good muscletone;

3<sup>rd</sup> Edmonson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Trinity.

## **OPEN BITCH** (12,4)

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Hazy Hazy Dream, she held my attention with her ring presence & verve. Quite strongly built but always retaining her femininity. Very soft in expression with great reach of neck into well laid back shoulders. Excellent body proportions all through. She moved with drive & enthusiasm. Pleased to award her CC & BIS;

2<sup>nd</sup> Siddle's Sh Ch Wilchrimane Ice Maiden, stylish in all departments. Graceful flowing lines. Super head, kind eye, correct earset. Well balanced throughout. RCC & RBIS;

3<sup>rd</sup> Udale's Crookrise Old Lace.

**BRACE** (4) A very nice class to judge of well matched dogs that moved in unison. Not always easy handling two dogs at once but they all put up a good performance.
