PUPPY DOG (3,1 a)

1st Legg & Scott's Narsad's Will Turner, masculine puppy of good type & size. Pleasing head, balanced outline with plenty of bone & substance. Well-angulated hindquarters. Moved soundly;
2nd Tibbs & Chisholm's Raigmore Cosmic Star, not as mature as 1 & needing to develop in head. Good bone & substance, moved OK.

JUNIOR DOG (3)

1st Hinton & Iennox's Mursbrae Theodore by Fleurfield, nicely made youngster, still with lots of maturing to do, but of good overall construction & flowing lines. Lovely bone & substance, deep body with good rear angulation. Moved soundly;
2nd McGilp's Kanix Irving at Forthbourne, pleasing type with good head. Compact body with plenty of bone, just needs to drop in chest a little. Moved soundly;
3rd Gerrard's Hookwood Showpiece at Carmandine.

POST GRADUATE DOG (4)

1st Blackburn-Bennett & Wilberg's Coralwood Kanix Mr T, upstanding dog with pleasing outline, lovely depth of chest & front assembly. Presents a balanced outline with good rear angulation. Moved soundly;
2nd Adams' Ansona Albert Einstein, nicely made dog of better size to one, just not as mature & settled on the move. Balanced outline with good angulation both ends;
3rd Osman's Wilchrimane Ace Ventura at Marissolo.

LIMIT DOG (7,1)

1st Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes, quality dog of lovely type & construction, just needs a little more maturity to complete a balanced picture. Good head, flowing outline with well-muscled hindquarters, moved soundly with drive;
2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble, another nicely constructed dog with good head, pleasing balanced outline, just needs a little more maturity. Moved soundly;
3rd Bell's Crookrise The Medlar at Owlspoint.

OPEN DOG (6,1) Quality class.

1st Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Diamond In The Rough, quality dog of lovely type, balanced outline of flowing curves. Lovely front assembly, deep well ribbed body into sweeping strong powerful hindquarters which he really uses on the move, covering the ground soundly with ease & style. DCC;
2nd Alcorn & Lynn's Sh Ch Afterglow Bare Face Lie at Kanix, another top class dog of excellent type & construction & again a series of flowing curves. When viewed in side profile he excels in outline with a super ground covering stride. Just preferred the head & rear movement of 1 but splitting hairs between these two top quality dogs. RDCC;
3rd Hinton's Sh Ch Fleurfields Flambeau.

PUPPY BITCH (2)

1st Layton's Millpoint love Is In The Air at Layways, nicely made bitch of pleasing overall construction, presenting a good outline. Just needs to develop in head with maturity, moved soundly. BP;

2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Andromeda, pretty bitch of pleasing type & outline just needs time to grow on & develop. A little erratic on the move but I'm sure will settle with time.

JUNIOR BITCH (4)

1st Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Diamond Lil, pleasing outline & type, feminine head with dark eye. Balanced body with plenty angulation both ends. Moved soundly when settled;

2nd Wilkinson's Stocksfell Remember Me, young bitch just 12 months & still needs time, however has pleasing overall construction with lovely bone & substance. Moved soundly with a good outline;

3rd Ward & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Just A Rumour by Jakobstown.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (6,1)

1st McGillp's Ridanfijht Rhosyn at Forthbourne, balanced bitch with feminine head, deep well ribbed & constructed body with well-muscled hindquarters. Moved soundly;

2nd Hall's Gartarry New Moon, lovely headed bitch with good eye & expression. Balanced body with pleasing outline. Moved OK;

3rd Klein-Woolthuis' Tenshilling Take It All to Haxalgate.

LIMIT BITCH (7,3)

1st Jones & Hinton's Pippalee Georgia by Fleurfield, pleasing overall in type & construction, she presented a flowing outline with plenty of bone & substance. Moving soundly with drive holding a good topline;

2nd Tibbs' Somerled Classic Romance at Raigmore, another nicely made bitch with pleasing head, balanced outline & strong powerful hindquarters. Just not as finished in body as 1. Moved well;

3rd Martin's Shadesett Serendipity at Sunhouse.

OPEN BITCH (4) Lovely class the first three all top class bitches who will change places on many occasions.

1st Dyer's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Juici Cuture, the star of the day, I have admired her from the ringside & on handling her was not disappointed. She flows from her super head with loads of work in it, through excellent neck & shoulders, deep well ribbed body to hindquarters with plenty of angulation & muscle. Presenting an outline of balance both standing & on the move, which she does soundly with style & ease & a great side gait. BCC & BOB & a worthy Group 1 & delighted to hear she went RBIS;

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kanix Chillli, another top quality bitch of super type & construction, lovely head & eye, flowing neck into good shoulders in a balanced body. Moved soundly, close decision, a very worthy champion & RBCC;

3rd Siddle's Sh Ch Wilchrime Ice Maiden.
