2<sup>nd</sup> Drake & Toogood's Clamerkin Mountain King. This 8 month boy was giving his handler a really hard time and was very difficult to assess. Head needs to break but he has plenty of time, good topline and tailset when he eventually stood. Could probably do with a bit more ringcraft to build his confidence.

## PUPPY DOG (2, 1abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Hazeltine & Welch's Just Wilburt. Nice youngster of 10 months. Well bodied with a masculine head, good neck into well laid shoulders, good topline and tailset and well bent stifles. Moved really well. BP.

#### JUNIOR DOG (6,2 abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Lidgley's Meadowpoint Spirit of Life. This youngster is a lovely shape standing. Nicely chiselled head, good depth of chest, nice neck into well placed shoulders, nice depth of brisket, good bend of stifle and tailset. Good free movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Freebreeze Over theTop at Spinray. Well made I/w who moved well holding his topline and using his tail. He has a good head, neck and shoulders. When stacked he seemed to lose his shape which was a shame.

3<sup>rd</sup> Watkins & Davies' Caithpoint Heaven Sent.

## YEARLING DOG (4, 1abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Tannahill's Wynbury Walter Jack. Really smart b/w who is a lovely shape. He has an attractive head and expression, good front and depth of brisket with good angles fore and aft. Moved really well using his tail. 2<sup>nd</sup> Lidgley's Meadowpoint Spirit of Life.

3<sup>rd</sup> Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Freebreeze Over the Top at Spinray.

## **NOVICE DOG** (4)

2<sup>nd</sup> Petherick's Hawkfield All At Sea. Smart b/w boy who was feeling the heat today. Nicely made with a lovely head and expression, good neck into well laid shoulders, good quarters and tailset. Moved ok, have seen him go better.

## MID LIMIT DOG (4,1)

1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold JW. Beautifully balanced boy with flowing lines, he has a masculine but well proportioned head, good neck flowing into well laid back shoulders, good topline and quarters, well off for bone. Moved out really well using his tail. RCC

2<sup>nd</sup> Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood by George JW ShCM. Another quality, eye-catching o/w who has a lovely head and expression, good neck leading to a level topline, deep brisket and good angulation fore and aft. Another good mover.

1<sup>st</sup> Golding's Sharnphilly Louis Vuitton. Smart, well balanced I/w who is a lovely shape with good angles fore and aft. He has a good head and neck leading to well laid back shoulders. Well muscled quarters which gave him his free driving movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> Moss' Davigdor Rough and Tumble JW. Smart o/w with a beautiful head and dark eye. Good depth of brisket and topline, neat tail which he used well on the move.

1<sup>st</sup> Kirby's Sh Ch Haramander Shabby Chic ShCM. 7yr old o/w who is well angulated fore and aft and creates a lovely shape when stacked. He has a beautiful head with a soft expression. Lovely free flowing movement. 2<sup>nd</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Dapper in Black JW. Smart 9 yr old b/w boy. Has a lovely head with a kind eye. Well balance with good depth of brisket. Moved round the ring well using his tail. 3<sup>rd</sup> O'Neill's Hurwyn Some Might Say JW.

1<sup>st</sup> Stuckley's Medogold Coralie of Pendan JW ShCM. A beautifully made quality bitch who I have admired from the ringside. Lovely flowing lines, she has a pretty head and good angulation fore and aft and good depth of body. Moved really well. I think she should have a bright future. RCC.
