# **VETERAN DOG** (3,1)

1<sup>st</sup> O'Neill's - Hurwyn Some Might Say JW - Lots to like about both these dogs and a close decision. Looks well for his age and retains his beautiful head and expression, well balanced all through with excellent neck and shoulders. Strode out well. Best Veteran.

2<sup>nd</sup> Whistance's - Esrews Serious Lord Jack ShCM - Similar comments to above unlucky to meet 1.

## **MINOR PUPPY DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Harrison's - Millpoint Formula One - Upstanding 8 month orange, he is well balanced and stands on good legs and feet, excellent neck and shoulders, lovely head and expression, moved well. Well balanced all through, in profile un-exaggerated movement with smooth ground covering gait, true fore and aft. Pushed hard for the CC but I could not resist him for the RCC, his time will come.
