JUNIOR DOG (4)

- 1st Harrison's Millpoint Formula One, 14 months, very promising youngster, good head & expression, clean neck, shoulders well laid, nice oval bone, good feet, nice body, ribs well sprung, good quarters & set-on, moved soundly with reach & drive;
- 2nd Hazeltine & Welch's Just Wilburt, another nice one, pleasing head, leathers well set, clean neck & shoulders, good chest, nice quarters, went well;

POST GRADUATE DOG (5,3a)

- 1st Harrison's Sh Ch Millpoint Heat Wave, 4½ years male, lovely type, great outline with lovely curves. Excellent head & expression, long muscular neck, good shoulders, nice bone, legs & feet, good body & balance, moved well both ways & in profile holding his topline. BD;
- 2nd Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Diamond In The Rough, 5½ years male, another nice one, good head proportions, elegant neck, good shoulders, nice body well ribbed, good quarters, moved soundly both ways & in profile;

Full of quality, lovely head & expression, kind eye, clean muscular neck, shoulders well laid, good oval bone, strong pasterns, lovely body & balance, excellent quarters & set-on.
