MINOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1st Wilberg's Kanix Mario, 8 months o/w of nice size, good overall balance. Balanced head with kind eye, clean cheeks with chiselling. Good body proportions for age. Moved well, a nice baby;

2nd Watkins & Davies' Ansona Aladdin, the most beautiful of heads & expression. Not as forward as 1 in body. He was a little unsure of his surroundings & a touch uncoordinated on the move.

PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Siddle, Crocker & Gardner's Wilchrimane Up To Tricks, 11 months o/w. Smart typy youngster that catches the eye. Excellent head proportions with lovely expression, defined stop & good chiselling. Well shaped bone. Moved soundly with handler. Just needs to grow on leg to complete the picture. BP & PG1;

2nd Fleming's Glenariff Hendricks, 9 months b/w. Not as well developed as winner. In good hard condition & moved well coming & going covering the ground well;

3rd Sillince's Medogold Clown Prince for Tomlow.

JUNIOR DOG (4)

1st Luke's Fleurfield Jim Beam, l/w with well ribbed body. Well shaped bone, feet & correct pasterns. Moved well. Mature for age, in nice hard condition;

2nd Marsh's Ratchda's Rock Thrush, liked his overall shape, well made, nice lines. Balanced head, good neck leading into the best of shoulders. Ribs well back. Just lacked maturity of 1 today;

3rd Macara's Kanix Legend at Cromasaig.

YEARLING DOG (4)

1st Hinton & Luke's Fleurfield Jack Daniels, l/w. A young man who is symmetrical & well built all over with graceful curves. Head balanced with kind eye. Good neck leading to well placed shoulders. Good rib well back, correct shaped bone. He is a nice size. Liked his side gait, sound back & front & kept his outline. Well muscled hindquarters in first class order. Awarded him his first CC, I wish him luck;

2nd Harrison's Millpoint Formula One, upstanding o/w. Bigger mould than winner. He is balanced & sound. Could have done with a little less weight as just tended to roll;

3rd Hazeltine & Welch's Just Wilburt by Hookwood.

POST GRADUATE DOG (5,1a)

1st Siddle's Wilchrimane C'Mon Norbert, o/w. Maturing well. Possesses the most beautiful balanced head with expressive eye, nice turn of lip. He is well ribbed. Right amount of body weight. Hocks well let down. Muscled hindquarters. Moved with ease;

2nd Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky, 3 years o/w dog. Bigger mould than 1. Nice overall make & shape, just preferred head & forequarters of winner;

3rd Mackay's Fleurfield Steals The Dream.

LIMIT DOG (8)

1st Stilgoe's Teisgol I Am The One And Only, I put in my notes 'very honest dog'. Not a big dog. Not overdone but flows through. Well balanced head & expression. Nice front, good bone & pasterns. Well ribbed body. Well muscled hindquarters. Carrying right amount of weight. In the challenge could have done with a bit more verve;

2nd Abbott & Wilberg's Larchwold Star Chaser at Kanix, well grown masculine b/w, like his lines. Moved well back & front. Preferred head of winner. He covers plenty of ground on the move but just tends to roll a little;

3rd Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood By George.

OPEN DOG (6,1)

1st Cumming's Ir Sh Ch Kanix Kroner at Sevenhills, 2 years quality b/w, my notes say 'very stylish'. He has type & is full of Pointer character. Alert with strength & speed. Possesses the most beautiful head with kind expressive eye. Good shaped bone, good rib. He is masculine & was shown in first class order, well muscled. When it came to the challenge just preferred my CC winner in front construction. RCC;

2nd Harrison's Sh Ch Millpoint Heatwave, 5 years mature quality male. Balanced in outline. Typical head. Clean in neck & shoulder. Deep chest with well back rib. Well turned stifle, good width of second thigh. Moved soundly, just lacked a bit of drive today. A worthy Sh Ch;

3rd Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes.

VETERN DOG (1)

1st Gordon's Hawkfield Sunkissed Sea, 9 years o/w in fabulous condition denying his age. He is a smart & stylish dog & is balanced throughout. Love his head & expression. Good quality bone. Moved soundly with precision using his tail. In fit hard condition. BV & I believe placed in the Gundog Veteran Group.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (5)

1st Sillince's Tomlow That'll Do, 7 months o/w. I loved her head & expression, plenty of work already there. Good shoulders, correct amount of bone, good ribs well back. Let down on her muscled hindquarters. True & sound on the move. A little bum high at the moment but shows lots of promise;

2nd Elrington's Ansona Cinderella, b/w, lighter framed than 1 but nice flowing lines. Stylish on the move holding her topline. Well handled & in good hard condition. Just preferred head of winner. Two nice puppies;

3rd Wilkinson's Stocksfell Total Eclipse.

PUPPY BITCH (9,1)

1st Metcalf's Darkridge Busy Bein Fab'u Lus, what a name! 10 months o/w. Well grown, I liked her overall balance & flowing lines & substance. Well worked, feminine head & kind expression. Good well let down hocks. Excellent ribs. She was a bit naughty & gave her handler a hard time but when she settled moved well. Sure she will mature well & make a nice bitch;

2nd Norbury's Medogold Milk Shake, 11 months b/w built on nice lines. Quality puppy that flows. Very sound in first class order;

3rd Fleming's Glenariff Quintessential.

JUNIOR BITCH (5)

- 1st Liens' Kanix Lotus, upstanding o/w, 15 months of good size. Appealing youngster of nice type. Lovely shaped head with the kindest of eye. Good shaped bone, good body shape. Moved well when she settled;
2nd Norbury's Medogold Milk Shake;
3rd Cobden's Hawkfield Bronze for Alozia.

YEARLING BITCH (4,1)

- 1st McGilp's Ridanflight Ruby Tuesday at Forthbourne, 20 months o/w, very eye-catching, feminine young lady. Presented a good outline on the stack. She is in fit hard condition. Moves true both ways. When it came to the challenge not quite as free in profile action as I would like;
2nd Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Of Love, b/w with a nice head & expression. Deep chest, good neck & shoulder. In nice order, body & muscle. Moved well when settled;
3rd Goode's Medogold Bonny Ivy.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (9,2)

- 1st Hinton's Fleurfield Dances On A Dream, b/w bitch of excellent make & shape, flowed through. Lovely head & expression with kind bright eye. Loved her bone, pasterns & feet. She had accurate footfall on the move with reach & drive. Maturing well;
2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Kestrel, another quality b/w. Maturing nicely. Loved her balanced head & expression. Carrying correct weight, well muscled hindquarters which she drove off. Just flew her tail a little today. 2 nice girls;
3rd Isherwood's Symitry Tickled Pink.

LIMIT DOG (11,1) A nice class.

- 1st Bell's Ridanflight Runedd with Balintyne, 4 years feminine bitch topped this nice class. She has quality & breed type. Balanced head with kind expression. Good bone shape, feet & pasterns. Like her size & substance. Moved true back & front. When it came to the challenge would have liked a little more 'go';
2nd Reynolds' Pipeaway Cara Mia at Sananselmo, another quality b/w who is full of breed type & balanced throughout. Love her balanced head. Not a big girl but would have liked a little more bodyweight today;
3rd Smith's Lypal Once Upon A Time.

OPEN BITCH (4)

- 1st Stuckey's Sh Ch Medogold Coralie of Pendan, at nearly 3 years this l/w bitch is what I was looking for. She simply screams quality & breed type & cannot be ignored. To me her outline & flowing lines are so right. Balanced head, arched neck into best of front construction, ribs deep & well back. Just the right amount of correctly shaped bone. Correct hindquarters letting down well. In first class order she moves with a smooth, effortless stride covering plenty of ground with excellent side gait. CC & BOB;
2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kanix Chilli, 6 years o/w. Like her, good shaped bone, feet & pasterns. Excellent spring of rib well back. The best of hindquarters which she uses on the move driving off her hocks. Today just felt the winner held her topline better. RCC. A very worthy Sh Ch;
3rd Gordon's Hawkfield Giddy Kipper.

VETERAN BITCH (2,1)

- 1st Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Dancer, nearly 8 years b/w who is very sound throughout. She displays the qualities of the breed. Balanced head kind expression. Good construction.
