### **VETERAN DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Floyd, medium sized dog who presented a balanced picture stacked & on the move, very pleasing head & soft melting expression;

2<sup>nd</sup> Desmond's Medgold Daramoon over Kajesola, handsome dog who moved well & pressed hard for top honours. Carrying a little extra weight for my preference;

3<sup>rd</sup> Hoffman's Texas Ebony at Camairo.

### **MINOR PUPPY DOG (5,1a)**

1<sup>st</sup> Dyer, Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Secretariat, typy young dog with flowing lines. Very calm mature attitude. Classic head with soft dark eye. Moved freely with style;

2<sup>nd</sup> Gordon, Petherick & Taylor's Hawkfield Strider, super young dog, balanced throughout with good depth of brisket, well laid shoulders with well turned stifles. Moved well;

3<sup>rd</sup> Watkins & Davies' Ansona Aladdin.

### **PUPPY DOG (6,2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Dyer, Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Secretariat;

2<sup>nd</sup> Sillince's Medogold Clown Prince for Tomlow, promising puppy. Totally in balance. Pleasing head & melting expression. Pressed hard for first place, just needs to tighten up behind. His day will come;

3<sup>rd</sup> Coggins, Coggins & Adams' Droveorough's DCI Lewis at Gemrose.

### **JUNIOR DOG**

1<sup>st</sup> Edmondson & Robertshaw's Crookrise Blackthorn, beautiful headed dog with soft expression, kind eye & well set ears. A series of graceful curves, moved soundly. One to watch for the future;

2<sup>nd</sup> Luke's Fleurfield Jack Daniels, upstanding masculine dog with great style & presence. Flowing outline & correct tailset. Handled immaculately with good driving action. His day will come;

3<sup>rd</sup> Kirby's Pipeaway Master Design.

### **YEARLING DOG (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Lidgley's Meadowpoint Spirit Of Life, larger dog with balanced pleasing head. Presents a very correct picture when stood. A little erratic on the move;

2<sup>nd</sup> Barnes' Zeta Orionis, lost out as carrying too much weight for me. Pleasing head & expression. Moved soundly.

### **NOVICE DOG (2,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Coggins, Coggins & Adams' Droveorough's DCI Lewis at Gemrose, smart young dog who is going through the adolescence stage. Moved well with drive, as always by this handler showed to perfection.

### **POST GRADUATE DOG (3)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tregaskis' Moenfair Spicewood Summer, well grown elegant dog b/w, a lovely series of curves when stacked. Excellent overall shape with good lay of shoulders & well let down hocks. Tight feet;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Bull's Kanix Hamlet of Stonedragon, streamlined dog who moved & showed in total harmony with his capable handler;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Barnes' Fisherbloom Fools Gold.

### **LIMIT DOG (5,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Abbott & Wilberg's Larchwold Star Chaser at Kanix, up to height dog with good lay of shoulder, deep brisket, good rear angulation, strong loin & powerful hindquarters. Masculine head with kind eye. Moved with drive;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol I Am The One And Only, smaller cast dog. A close decision between the two. Just needed a little more sparkle on the day;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Huxley's Aurichalcum Evan Knows its Woodfleet.

### **OPEN DOG (5,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Siddle, Crocker, Medieros & O'Neill's Am Can S-Ch Chesterhope Bingo, very stylish dog. Upstanding, masculine with great presence. Took the rinb by storm & didn't put a paw wrong. Moved with drive by this accomplished handler. CC;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Coggins, Coggins & Adams' Sh Ch Droveborough Born To Bound at Gemrose, pressed hard to win RCC. Handsome dog who lost out for me today by carrying weight over his shoulders which made his neck look shorter. Easily remedied. A beautiful dog;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Watkins & Davies' Sh Ch Hurwyn Law N Order.

### **GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME DOG (2)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tannahill's Wynbury Walter Jack, balanced dog with clean lines, shown in hard muscletone. Appealing eye with soft expression. Moved effortlessly with ground covering action;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tregaskis' Moenfair Spicewood Summer.

### **VETERAN BITCH (6,3)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Lowe's Lowsmoor Storms River, stylish b/w bitch, long muscular arched neck. Well let down hocks & deep brisket. Plenty of spring of rib. Neat tail. Moved well;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Brooksmith's Smartbay Vintage Gold, larger cast bitch than 1, she showed with enthusiasm. Attractive head, elegant neck & good depth of brisket. Honest mover;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Stangroom's Medogold Wannabeposh for Lappakia.

### **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (6)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Dyer, Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Makybe Diva, beautifully balanced puppy who made the ring her own. Covers plenty of ground. Super head & correct expression. A star in the making;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Baker & Baker-Roullier's Desfrisa Flirtini, pleasing head on a larger mould. Unlucky to meet the first but equally balanced. Preferred the reach of movement of 1st;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Elrington's Ansona Cinderella.

### **PUPPY BITCH (8,2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Dyer, Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Makybe Diva, smashing bitch who looked a picture when stood;

2<sup>nd</sup> Norbury's Medogold Milk Shake, smashing bitch who looked a complete balanced picture when stood. Attractive head on well set shoulders, well let down hocks. Lost out to 1 on length & drive of movement;

3<sup>rd</sup> Siddle & Siddle's Wilchrimane Florencino.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (8)**

1<sup>st</sup> Hinton & Knowles' Fleurfield Finlandia, lightly marked bitch who was feeling the cold today. Attractive head with well laid shoulder. Nice ear & soft expression. Moved soundly with drive;

2<sup>nd</sup> Bond's Joneva Asterea, balanced, strongly made bitch. Attractive head with soft expression. Stylish mover;

3<sup>rd</sup> Norbury's Medogold Milk Shake.

### **YEARLING BITCH (7)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle, Siddle & Kruger's White Squall Seasyde Iced Team, extremely pretty bitch with lovely head & melting expression. Balanced & stylish. Moved extremely well;

2<sup>nd</sup> Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee, another pretty headed bitch with dark appealing eye & classic head. Well put together, sound mover;

3<sup>rd</sup> Drake & Preece's Clamerkin Bohemian Queen.

### **NOVICE BITCH (7)**

1<sup>st</sup> Hinton & Knowles' Fleurfield Finlandia;

2<sup>nd</sup> Norbury's Medogold Milk Shake;

3<sup>rd</sup> Tregaskis' Moenfair Tinpenny Tod Tails.

### **POST GRADUATE BITCH (14,3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Hinton's Fleurfield Dances On A Dream, lovely headed bitch of longer cast. A series of graceful curves. Long sloping shoulders, deep brisket with plenty of heartroom. Well let down hocks. Balanced mover;

2<sup>nd</sup> Westaway's Penwest Pica Pica, smart liver/w bitch. Balanced throughout. Nothing exaggerated. Moved freely with drive;

3<sup>rd</sup> Flint's Wynbury Golden Chalice at Fleurfield.

### **LIMIT BITCH (10,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Guy & Hinton's Carmandinen Cookie Crumble by Fleurfield, ultra feminine bitch who oozes quality & style. Pressed hard for top honours in the bitch challenge. Ground covering action;

2<sup>nd</sup> Bell's Ridanflight Ruradd with Balintyne, very attractive bitch who caught my eye as she entered the ring. Pleasing head & expression. Smart honest mover;

3<sup>rd</sup> Brooksmith's Medogold Kiss N'Tell.

**OPEN BITCH (5,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Dyer's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Juici Cuture, this multiple CC winner is a hard act to follow. Doesn't seem to lose her enthusiasm & drive, balanced, stylish & carries herself with total confidence & drive. A true credit to her breed. CC, BOB & G2;

2<sup>nd</sup> Rose's Ridanflight Rhonwen, this bitch should be a worthy champion in our breed, unlucky to meet 1st regularly. RCC which she won with style;
