### VETERAN DOG (1) A.

#### MINOR PUPPY DOG (5,1)

1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Sniperay Valencia at Tzaziki, very mature in body & head for age, pleasing shape & balance. Deep well ribbed body with good feet. Moved soundly just hope he doesn't grow on much more;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Radcliffe's Sniperay Jhambiri, litter brother & very similar in type & qualities just not as forward as 1;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Gordon & Petherick's Hawkfield Strider.

### PUPPY DOG (2) A.

#### JUNIOR DOG (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Macara, Jamieson & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Legend at Cromasaig, mature orange dog of good size & proportions. Masculine head, deep well ribbed body with good bone & substance. Strong well angulated & muscled hindquarters. Presented a pleasing outline. Moved with great drive from behind covering the ground well. RCC;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Radcliffe's Sniperay Jhambiri;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Batchelor's Wilchrimane Clickety Click to Kielderpoint.

### NOVICE DOG (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Sniperay Valencia at Tzaziki.

### POST GRADUATE DOG (6,1a)

1<sup>st</sup> Rose's Ridanflight Roller Blade, pleasing headed dog with dark eye, balanced body with plenty bone & substance. Presented a good outline standing & on the move covering the ground with reach & drive. Needs to drop & fill out in front but is a good size & very typical in outline;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Tregaskis's Moenfair Spicewood Summer, pleasing overall type & construction, a little up to size but scored in movement covering the ground soundly with drive;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Scholes' Pipeaway Antonio Mancini.

### LIMIT DOG (12,2)

1<sup>st</sup> Abbott & Wilberg's Larchwold Star Chaser at Kanix, balanced well made dog excelling in construction & movement, presenting a good outline he has great presence especially on the move which he does soundly with great reach & drive. Would just prefer a shade less of him all over;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood By George, masculine headed dog with good bone & substance, pleasing for size & balance, just preferred the movement on 1;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Walkling, Grantham & Moss' Aspyre Follow Your Dreams to Kiswahili.

### OPEN DOG (6) Difficult class very varied in type.

1<sup>st</sup> Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes, on first impressions this dog didn't stand out, however on handling I found him typical unexaggerated & moderate in all departments. He is well constructed & refined, with a balanced body & sound positive movement covering the ground with ease. Shown & presented in lovely condition. CC;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Welch's Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood, pleasing overall for type & balance, well proportioned body with plenty bone & substance. Moved well;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Siddle, Crocker, Medieros & O'Neill's Am/Can Sh Ch Seasyde Chesterhope Bingo.

### **VETERAN BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Cooper's Keepersfield Mama Mia, nice headed bitch with good eye & expression, balanced outline with good angulation both ends. Sound mover & in good condition for age;

2<sup>nd</sup> Stangroom's Lappakia Dune Song, pleasing type & construction good outline just preferred size & head of 1, good condition moved well.

### **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Rankine's Gempoint Catch A Dream for Fyldefair, pretty headed bitch with dark eye, balanced well made body with plenty bone & substance. Good quarters & rear angulation. Moved soundly;

2<sup>nd</sup> Disley's Ridanflight Rum Truffle, good overall outline & construction just needing to mature & develop with age, moved well;

3<sup>rd</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Saunter.

### **PUPPY BITCH (3,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane Allure, mature bitch with many of her famous mothers qualities, pleasing head, deep body with lovely legs & feet. Well angulated quarters which she uses on the move covering the ground soundly with style, shown in lovely condition. BP & pleased to hear BPIS;

2<sup>nd</sup> Onions' Wilchrimane Tapestry, litter sister & similar in type & construction, head needs to develop & preferred shoulders on 1, moved well.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (5,2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges, quality young bitch with a lovely head with plenty work in it & a dark eye. Good front assembly scoring in for chest which so many lacked. Balanced well made body with good outline. Moved soundly with style just needs a little more maturity;

2<sup>nd</sup> Hinton & Knowles' Fleurfield Finlandia, another quality bitch just needing to develop in head a little more. Balanced body with flowing lines & sound positive mover;

3<sup>rd</sup> Burke's Alcazar Amorous Liaison.

### **NOVICE BITCH (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges;

2<sup>nd</sup> Hinton & Knowles' Fleurfield Finlandia.

### **POST GRADUATE BITCH (14,3)**

1<sup>st</sup> MacKay's Federica Fanfare at Woodglade, mature well made bitch with a pleasing head, balanced well proportioned body with super rib, bone & substance. Presented a good outline with well muscled hindquarters. Moved with good side gait covering the ground well, shown in lovely condition. RCC;

2<sup>nd</sup> Hinton's Fleurfield Dances On A Dream, another nicely made bitch of good type & construction. Presented a flowing outline with plenty substance. Moved well;

3<sup>rd</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Kestrel.

### **LIMIT BITCH (5,1)**

1<sup>st</sup> McGilp's Ridanflight Ruby Tuesday at Forthbourne, quality young bitch who stands out for type & balance, flowing from head to tail. Well constructed & balanced throughout & really scores in hind movement. She pushed hard for top honours just needing a little more maturity;

2<sup>nd</sup> Vaughn's Teisgol I Am What I Am, nicely made bitch with a flowing outline, well made throughout. She presents a picture of balance with good angles both ends, & moved well with good reach & drive;

3<sup>rd</sup> Simmons' Freebreeze Acadia with Galema.

**OPEN BITCH (5,2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kanix Chilli, top quality bitch I have given a RCC to before & was pleased to go on & award her a CC, she is well made, with lovely construction, & a balanced flowing clean outline. When asked to move she uses her good construction covering the ground with soundness, style, & an easy positive stride. Presented in first class condition. CC & BOB & delighted to see her go G3;

2<sup>nd</sup> Rose's Ridanflight Rhonwen, another quality bitch with lots to like about her. She has a pleasing head, balanced well made body with good hindquarters. Presenting a flowing outline typical of this kennel. She covered the ground soundly with style;

3<sup>rd</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Giddy Kipper.
