At just 8 months old this o/w is of good breed type, I liked his overall make and shape, lovely head and soft gentle eye, excellent pigment, clean neck and shoulders, straight forelegs, good bone and feet, still very immature but nicely bodied for his age, strong quarters, went very well both coming and going and in profile.

2nd Dunn's Meadowpoint Look To The Star. At just 6 months this b/w puppy is not as well developed as winner but has a lovely head, eye and expression, nicely placed shoulder, good topline and quarters moved ok.

1st Saunders' Phlynnies Prince Of Thieves. 10 month b/w, has a balanced outline, good body proportions, masculine head with a bright and kindly eye, good bone and feet, correct lay of shoulder, strong topline and tailset, muscled hindquarters with developed second thigh, he was very impressive on the move for one so young. JUNIOR DOG (5)

1st Adams' Millpoint Simply Smashing JW. 15 month old b/w, balanced in outline, classic head, eye and expression, straight forelegs, good feet, good depth to brisket, well angulated fore and aft, in fabulous muscle tone and condition, moved well covering the ground with ease.

2nd Astbury's Millpoint Simply In Step with Dorbury. Litter brother to winner and similar attributes applied, just preferred the maturity and movement of winner.

YEARLING DOG (3)

1st O'Neill & O'Neill's Chesterhope Thrill Of T Chase (Imp). I have admired this young dog from the ringside and he certainly did not disappoint me today. He has the typical flowing outline with a series of curves, masculine head with the most expressive eyes, correct ear set, excellent reach of neck flowing into well laid shoulders. Straight forelegs, strong pasterns and tight feet, good depth of brisket, well ribbed and firm in loin, well muscled and angulated hindquarters. He moves effortlessly and accurate with excellent reach and drive and using his tail to advantage. I had absolutely no hesitation in awarding him the CC and BOB.

POST GRADUATE DOG (4)

1st Luke & Hinton's Fleurfield Jim Beam ShCM. Medium sized liver dog of good breed type, masculine chiselled head, kind dark eye, correct amount of bone and tight feet, neck flowing into correctly placed shoulders, deep chest, well sprung ribs, well muscled hindquarters, correct tail set, moved well.

2nd Scholes' Pipeaway Antonio Mancini At Rossgilde. O/w with a clean balanced outline, lovely chiselled head, darkest of eyes, so clean in neck and shoulder, deep chest, flowing topline, well angulated hindquarters with good width of second thigh, giving handler a hard time on the move, but once settled he did it with style and a lashing tail.

3rd Saunders' Teisgol Double Trigger.

1st Luke & Hinton's Fleurfield Jack Daniels. L/w dog of super quality, in excellent muscletone and condition, good head of correct proportions, good angulation fore and aft, good bone and feet, correct topline, excellent body proportions, moved with style and precision.

2nd Marsh's Ratchda Rock Thrush Another quality l/w dog of good breed type who has style and presence, he was in fit hard condition, well developed chest and good spring of rib, correct topline and tail set which he used on the move.

OPEN DOG (6, 1)

1st Cummings' Ir Sh Ch Kanix Kroner At Sevenhills Ir J Ch AnCh15. Mature b/w male of excellent breed type, he has the best of heads with expressive eyes, he is in fabulous muscle tone and condition, flowing topline, extremely muscled hindquarters with defined second thigh, short strong hocks which he uses to power around the ring.

2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Rough And Tumble JW. O/w dog, he has a lovely head, eye and expression, excellent reach of neck, well laid shoulders, flowing lines, deep chest, good legs and feet, well angulated hindquarters, just needs to settle on the move.

Lovely feminine head and gentle expression, correct body proportions for her age, she is in super condition, moved very well.

2nd Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Gartarry All That Jazz At Spinray. B/w baby, still very raw but she has plenty of time, she is very outgoing and has a good outline, she was sympathetically handled and was really enjoying her day.

PUPPY BITCH (5, 1)

1st Hinton's Keepersfield Christelle With Fleurfield. This is the first time I have noticed this young lady and I fell for her stunning outline, loved her head, her elegant clean reach of neck flowing into well laid shoulders, she is quite mature in outlook, and has excellent body proportions for her age, shown in hard condition, covered the ground and moved soundly with lashing tail, I was happy to award her the CC & BPIB.

2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Bee Wyched. L/w, just not quite as together as winner today, head of correct proportions, good bone and feet, still needs to develop in front, good neck, topline and tailset, well angulated hindquarters, just a little loose in front on the move.

3rd Fairbairn & Hinton's Davigdor Blackwych By Fleurfield.

JUNIOR BITCH (4, 2)

1st Fewster, Rossiter & Mitchell's Sonstraal Only An Illusion. O/w, quality young bitch of excellent breed type, feminine head with super eye and expression, lovely balanced forequarters, good oval bone, tight feet, brisket well let down and well sprung ribs, strong muscular loin, sound and stylish on the move.

2nd Matthews' Millpoint Simply Bootifull With Sonham. B/w bitch who is very sound throughout, good head proportions, gentle expression, clean neck and shoulders, good body proportions, in super condition, moved well and true both ways.

YEARLING BITCH (3, 2)

1st Huxley's Woodfleet Wild Is The Wind. B/w, stood alone in this class, balanced in outline, feminine head, good eye and expression, good bone and feet, nicely angulated fore and aft, good body proportions, shown in excellent condition, moved very sound both coming and going.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (10, 3)

1st Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee JW. O/w who has a kind feminine head and expressive eye, balanced angulation fore and aft, well sprung ribs, strong muscular loin, in fit condition, moved out well with positive reach and drive.

2nd Dunn's Meadowpoint Spirit Of Love JW ShCM. B/w feminine bitch who has a balanced head with kind eye, clean neck and shoulders, good body proportions, in super condition, moved well and true both ways.

3rd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Diamond Lil.

1st Vaughn's Teisgol I Am What I Am. B/w bitch, well balanced head with dark eyes, balanced in outline, correct front angulation and good depth of chest, well angulated rear quarters and sound in movement, shown in fit excellent condition.

2nd Hinton's Fleurfield Dances On A Dream JW. B/w bitch, lovely feminine head with super eye and expression, good angulation fore and aft, good bone and feet, correct topline, excellent body proportions, moved with style and precision.

1st Rose's Ridanflight Rhianna. RCC. O/w, mature bitch of good breed type, balanced in outline, pleasing feminine head, eye and expression, good oval bone, excellent body proportions, in excellent condition, and well muscled throughout.
