### Pointers

**Minor Puppy Dog** (6) 1 Flint's Casilex Chinook, only a baby of six months, has class & style, very promising. BP;  
2 Wilberg & Blackburn-Bennett's Kiswahili Martin at Kanix, overall was longer cast, very eye catching, also a nice puppy;  
3 Drake's Clamerkin Crystal Mountain.

**Puppy Dog** (3) 1 Carson's Moorpoint Only The Lonely, overall goodish sort. Feet not his fortune but has a nice masculine head;  
2 Squires's Bentham Carpe Diem, not in top nick on the day. Had better feet than 1;  
3 Graham & Denwood's Lyndfil Krakatau.

**Junior Dog** (11,2a) 1 Cherry's Shanandi Masterpiece, nice headed dog with a good dish, went well & kept his topline;  
2 Siddle's Wilchrimane Obe Gold, 1 scored in head & eye, has a good forehand;  
3 Rose's Ridanflight Rockhampton.

**Post Graduate Dog** (13) 1 Parson's Pipeaway Billy Bling, at an in between stage but is all Pointer. Covered his ground with drive, has a good head & eye;  
2 Beesley's Birchleith Barbican Beau, just right for size & overall very pleasing;  
3 Curran's Hurwyn Jack Snipe.

**Limit Dog** (5,1) 1 Wilcox's Pipeaway Zonic Tonic for Merynjen, general good balance & type, looked at you right & moved with drive from good angulation behind;  
2 Swift's Hampsbeck Chaos, did not have the backend of 1. Overall pleasing;  
3 Wilson's Joneva Shooting Star at Djankay.

**Open Dog** (9,1) 1 Masters & Pavey's Sh Ch Manchela Innuendo, this b/w has taken time but the wait was worth it, now coming to his best, true Pointer head with good dish, has good forehand & rear angulation, helped him to flow back & front, well padded feet. CC;  
2 Howes' Medogold Funtime Frankie, not quite the foreface of 1, 1 had better length of stride, although this dog is very sound. RCC;  
3 Wilberg, O'Neill & Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch/NZ/Gr Aus Ch Chesterhope Lets Be Serious at Kanix.

**Minor Puppy Bitch** (13,5) 1 Drake's Clamerkin Crystal Lace, classy baby, feminine head & outline, went well for her age, tight well padded feet;  
2 Berkeley's Casilex Black Ice, pushed 1 hard as this is a good baby, one to watch;  
3 Hambling's Chaseover Shamrock.

**Puppy Bitch** (8) 1 McGrath's Sanmarlitch Cairns Opal, I was impressed by the forehand of this one, she moved positive & true;  
2 Masters & Pavey's Truly Scrumptious at Manchela, this youngster is well angulated & pressed 1 hard, close decision;  
3 Carson's Moorpoint Mabye Baby.

**Junior Bitch** (10,4) 1 Wilkinson's Hurwyn Sissor Sister, lovely young Pointer, ideal size, excellent feminine outlook, moved with drive & covered her ground with ease;  
2 Williams & Wilberg's Ridanflight Ruahine at Kanix, a bigger sort but in proportion, nice lay of shoulder, went well;  
3 Welch's Ponte Extra Special with Hookwood.

**Post Graduate Bitch** (19,7) McGrath's Esrews Sonnet, good type who moved well & kept her topline;  
2 Coggins' Medogold Bewitched to Gemrose, nice headed bitch with a good feminine outlook, moved sound & true;  
3 Dyer's Sharnphilly Complimentary.

**Limit Bitch** (13) 1 Wilkinson's Hurwyn Eau De Cologne, full of true Pointer type, excellent head & eye, moved well on good feet & legs, feet well padded as they should be, nice bitch of class;  
2 Huxley's Woodfleet Siennarain, a finer sort & got her place on her forehead & shoulders, overall nice;  
3 Guy & Walker's Teisgol Phoenix at Carofel.

**Open Bitch** (11,1) 1 Parsons' Pipeaway Polly Garters, b/w, classy head with dish & looked all feminine, covered her ground with ease on a long stride, was also sound fore & aft. CC & BOB;  
2 Howes' Medogold Sunny Daze, second in a strong class, 1 scored in front, nonetheless a top class bitch. RCC;  
3 Upton's Hurwyn Lillie Savage of Tragus.
