Puppy Dog (14,3a)

1 Anthony's Jilony Just Amazin, well balanced b/w puppy combining quality & substance, clean well chiselled head, dark well shaped eye, well developed flews, excellent head carriage, deep brisket, firm body, strong quarters with good width of thigh, moved freely covering the ground well, headed a class of top quality puppies. BP;

2 Hamilton's Hawkfield Lets Get Rowdy, quality b/w youngster, excelled in shape & overall type, lovely head carried on long arched neck, well laid shoulders, good body shape, well angulated quarters, animated & stylish with free movement;

3 Gordon's Hawkfield Sunkissed Sea.

Junior Dog (7,1)

1 Flint's Casilex Chinook, elegant black boy, streamlined with a shapely profile, clean well proportioned head, dark expressive eye, neck long & arched & set into long well laid shoulders, firm deep body with strong loin & quarters, good length of stride, holding topline;

2 O'Driscoll's Fowington Five Bob Note, quality b/w youngster with all the necessary attributes, well proportioned head, correct depth & of muzzle, clean neck flowing into well laid shoulders, strong well ribbed body, short muscular loin, quality bone, free active mover using tail;

3 Wilberg & Blackburn-Bennett's Kiswahili Martin at Kanix.

Yearling Dog (5,3)

1 Casilex Chinook;

2 Tuite's Porschet So Nice, classy dog, masculine head with plenty of work in it, dark expressive eyes, deep in brisket, strong quarters, sound mover. Preferred front angulation of 1.

Novice Dog (4)

1 Wilkinson & O'Neill's Hurwyn Some Might Say, a top flight youngster, lovely head & expression, balanced throughout with good head carriage & flowing lines, ground covering movement. Just needs time;

2 Jones' Dappleline Euphoria with Dottymix, quality o/w baby, tpy boy with classical head, shapely body, good shoulder & rear angulation. Still a raw baby. Movement sound & free;

3 Matthews' Dappleline Endeavour.

Graduate Dog (5)

1 Wilcox & Preece's Harvestglade Rolar Rhapsody for Merynjen, very tpy o/w youngster, neat & streamlined, loved his head & kind expression, elegant neck into long well laid shoulders, deep brisket, well ribbed back, firm loin, good width of thigh, stylish mover;

2 Goode's Gempoint Dark N Sharp at Handsway, young b/w dog combining quality with substance, balanced head with good stop & dark eye, very clean in neck & shoulders, strong well ribbed body, well angulated, sound mover, in lovely body & coat condition;

3 Stilgoe's Teisgol Tanzanite.

Post Graduate Dog (11)

1 Rose & Williams' Ridanflight Rockhampton, very glamorous masculine o/w boy, impressive profile, good head with lots of work in it, arched neck, firm deep & well ribbed body, strong quarters, moved well;

2 Naden's Wychwood Love Over Gold, o/w, very tpy with lovely outline, long clean neck, good layback of shoulder, well bent stifle, balanced throughout & very fluent movement covering plenty of ground. Lacked maturity of 1, just needs time;

3 Walklings' Kiswahili Catcher In The Rye.

Limit Dog (13)

- 1 Isherwood's Symitry Russian Roulette, o/w, headed a hotly contested class, filled me eye as he entered the ring with elegance & free effortless movement, top quality body combining elegance & substance, balanced head, long neck into long well laid shoulder, well angulated, strong body, had stacks of ring presence, lashing tail on the move. CC & BOB;
- 2 Gordon's Hawkfield Dapper In Black, top quality b/w boy, different in type to 1. Totally balanced, attractive head, arched neck, good shoulders & rear angulation, very fit & muscled, strong deep body, muscular loin, free ground covering movement, has time his favour;
- 3 Buchanan-Robertson's Painted Black of Querdon.

Open Dog (7,1) Class of quality boys difficult to separate, I hadn't enough cards.

- 1 Martin's Jilony Believe in Sunhouse, has matured into a lovely Pointer, an elegant boy with substance, clean well balanced head with good stop, correct depth of muzzle, dark soft eyes, arched neck, good lay of shoulders, deep body, well ribbed back, good bend of stifle, strong limbs, moved freely holding his shape. RCC;
- 2 Moulding & Marsh's Bilsborough's Bright Moon, top quality dog, loved his head & kind expression, excellent body proportions with good quality bone, strong deep body & well angulated rear, good width of thigh, Moved well but preferred front movement of 1;
- 3 Masters & Pavey's Sh Ch Manchela Innuendo.

Puppy Bitch (15,3)

- 1 Smith's Hawkfield Lets Cause Truble, very outgoing balanced young lady with ground covering movement & good outline, feminine head, neat front, deep well ribbed body, strong rear, excellent legs, pasterns & tight feet;
- 2 Westron's Aurichalcum Oh Mon Dieu, very well constructed puppy with classical head, deep in stop, good turn of lip, dark well shaped eye, balanced body, deep strong & well ribbed, strong rear, quality exhibit who moved soundly;
- 3 Turton's Tanglebrook Jigsaw Puzzle.

Junior Bitch (11,2)

- 1 Williams & Rose's Chaseover Shamrock of Ridanflight, o/w, heading a class of quality bitches, classic head with the darkest of eyes, deep stop, good turn of lip, very balanced & well put together, quarters muscular with good width of thigh, well bent stifle, moved with drive;
- 2 Masters & Pavey's Truly Scrumptious of Manchela, elegant young b/w, very shapely & free moving, clean well shaped head with dark eye, excellent body, ribs well sprung & firm muscular rear, moved with style using tail;
- 3 Crawte's Bestina Black Opal of Leasecliffe.

Yearling Bitch (3,1)

- 1 Barker's Flinthill Jenny Wren, a lovely girl with classical head, well shaped with the softest expression, good layback of shoulder, deep firm body, well ribbed back, strong in loin & quarters, quality bone, moved freely covering plenty of ground;
- 2 Shaw's Satsivus All About Eve, attractive, free moving b/w, well balanced throughout, moved freely, pleasant head but overshadowed by 1. Needs more time.

Novice Bitch (3)

- 1 Truly Scrumptious of Manchela;
- 2 Critchley's Whipspan Bondi Peach, stunning young o/w, oozing type, super head & expression carried on long arched neck, long well laid shoulder, good body shape & plenty of rear angulation. Needs to develop in ribcage & body. No doubt has a bright future.

Graduate Bitch (6,2)

- 1 Naden's Wychwood Midsomer Dream, feminine o/w, very elegant, pretty well chiselled head, dark expressive eyes, well placed shoulders, good body, well bent stifle, happy bitch, moving freely with excellent carriage & drive;
- 2 Williams & Rose's Ridanflight Rupara, top quality girl with attractive head & expression, striking outline combined with firm well ribbed body, strong quarters, good width of thigh & hocks well let down, free sound movement;
- 3 Huxley's Woodfleet Lookin For Truble.

Post Graduate Bitch (10,3)

1 Wilkinson & O'Neill's Hurwyn I Heard A Rumour, loved this o/w bitch who was difficult to fault, considered her for top honours, classical head with well defined head, good occiput & turn of lip, very clean in neck & shoulder, deep body well ribbed back, strong loin, powerful rear assembly, moved well;

2 Barker's Flinthill Wild Thyme, b/w girl of exceptional quality, lovely head with plenty of work in it, had substance & style, clean well laid shoulders, deep brisket, good ribcage, strong loin & quarters, very fluent movement covering plenty of ground;

3 Rigby's Pentworth Peaches And Cream.

Limit Bitch (14,1)

1 Edmondson's Crookrise White Lace, this typy little bitch headed a class of top quality girls, typified Pointer type from the tip of her nose to the tip of her tail, loved her feminine head & excellent head carriage, reachy neck, good front & strong quarters with let down hocks, loved her attitude & style as she moved freely round the ring using tail. Worthy CC winner, believe her second;

2 Wilkinson's Hurwyn Eau De Cologne, o/w oozing quality, feminine head with deep stop, good turn of lip & soft expression, good shoulder angulation, firm body & quarters, balanced throughout, moved soundly but lacked sparkle;

3 Williams & Rose's Ridanflight Rushine at Kanix.

Open Bitch

1 Knowles' Sh Ch Dovehayes Facsimile, lemon bitch who I have admired from the ring side, on close scrutiny I was not disappointed, clean feminine head with lovely expression, fine well laid shoulder, deep brisket, well ribbed body, free sound movement. RCC;

2 Anthony's Jilony Aqua, b/w with super profile & of good type, very clean well chiselled head, long arched neck set into long well laid shoulders, good width of thigh, very sound free mover. Pressed 1 hard, her day should come;

3 Grimes' Ansona Fool Britannia at Enryb.
