1 Williams \& Rose's Kanix Ace at Ridanflight, 8 months b/w, hope he grows on. Lovely head \& eye, soft expression, good reach of neck which flowed into well laid shoulder \& topline, good quarters \& tailset, moved well;
2 Grundy's Hawkfield Seaspray,11 months I/w, head balanced, straight in front, good bone. Not moving as well as 1 ;
3 Perren \& Welch's Droveborough Tasty Geezer at Hookwood.
