Puppy Dog $(5,1) 1$ Whiting's Rodale Ringleader, 10 months b/w, upstanding dog, masculine head, good outline, in good condition, moved well;
2 Wilberg's Jilony Freedom with Kanix, 11 months b/w, strong head, already well up to size.

3 Fox \& Matthews' Dappleline Endeavour.
Junior Dog (10) 1 Wilberg \& Blackburn-Bennett's Kiswahili Martin at Kanix, o/w, looks good, strong head, well off for bone, real showman, moves with purpose \& drive. Hope he doesn't grow any more. Won a good class;
2 Drake's Clamerkin Crystal Mountain, b/w, very close up, lovely body shape, good neck into well laid shoulders, good spring of rib, very nice youngster. Preferred ring presence of 1 ;

2 Andrews \& Ledger's Ledgands Magic N Mayhem, o/w, super head, neck \& shoulders, good depth, enough bone, nice body shape, he needs to be handled to be appreciated;
3 Siddle's Wilchrimane Obe Gold.
Post Graduate Dog (10) 1 Rose \& Williams' Ridanflight Rockhampton, medium size o/w, good head, neck \& shoulder, short coupled, looked very good standing. Have admired him as a puppy \& did not disappoint;
2 Naden's Wychwood Love Over Gold, o/w, rangier than 1 but same remarks apply. Just needs time. A very nice youngster;

Limit Dog (2) 1 Swift's Hampsbeck Chaos, 5 years b/w, good type, very sound on the move, no exaggerations;

Open Dog $(6,1) 1$ Simmons' Sh Ch Crookrise Macawley at Galema, b/w, completely fills the eye with his magnificent head \& wonderful eye \& expression, strong neck into well laid shoulders, good legs \& feet, nice depth of body, strong hindquarters used well. Has really improved with age \& has the true Pointer character, handler really gets the best out of him. CC; 2 Kenney-Taylor's Rodale Reflection at Highshann, I/w, very sound, lovely outline \& masculine head, admired him for his sound movement \& honesty, pushed hard;

Minor Puppy Bitch $(3,1)$ Two nice o/w pups. 1 Gordon's Hawkfield Sea Siren, pretty bitch, grand body shape, lovely flowing lines, moved soundly. Needs to tighten in front. BPB;
2 Barrs-Gordon's Panoply Golden Vision, couldn't match head of 1. Nice body proportions, moved well.

Puppy Bitch $(8,2) 1$ Smith's Hawkfield Lets Cause Trouble, b/w, super head, neck \& shoulders, good body shape \& moved very well for one so young, built on heavier lines. Couldn't match elegance of the MPB winner;
2 Tibbs' Raigmore Let It Shine, o/w, very sweet feminine head, nice outline, moved well for her age, very nice puppy. Time is on her side;
3 Welch's Hookwood Blonde Bombshell.
Junior Bitch $(12,2) 1$ O'Driscoll's Fowington Six In The City, this bitch epitomises the Standard, fabulous in all departments, would not change a thing from her classical head, through her beautiful body lines to her lovely tail, movement was a joy to behold, as you could expect from this breeder, especially loved her width of thigh \& superior muscletone. Bitches of this quality are unfortunately a rarity. $\mathrm{CC}, \mathrm{BOB}$;
2 Ainsworth's Soxette Regal Mantissa Mae, o/w, sweet head, lovely neck \& shoulder, enough bone, good depth of brisket, lovely flowing lines, very feminine, super tail \& shape, one of the best here, well muscled quarters, in super condition, moved very well. Pushed hard for RCC, just feel she needs more time. Two quality exhibits;
3 Drake's Clamerkin Crystal Lace.
Graduate Bitch $(7,1) 1$ C Crystal Lace, o/w, not quite as elegant as $1 \& 2$ in junior but won this class well on movement;
2 Williams \& Rose's Ridanflight Rupara at Kanix, nice o/w, good outline, handled very well.
Have seen her move better;
3 Jones' Tafakis For My Love.
Post Graduate Bitch $(7,1) 1$ Wilkinson \& O'Neill's Hurwyn I Heard A Rumour, have judged her before \& liked her then, very typical of this kennel, lovely head, good outline, moved well. Carrying too much weight due to a phantom pregnancy but nonetheless a nice bitch; 2 Naden's Wychwood Midsomer Dream, built on finer lines, very feminine head, good neck \& shoulder, nice tail shape. Needs time to really fulfil her potential;
3 Simmons' Galema Bodacia.
Limit Bitch $(15,2) 1$ Williams \& Rose's Ridanflight Ruahine at Kanix, upstanding o/w of quality, lovely head, body is a series of graceful curves, good legs \& feet, moved very well;
2 Wilkinson's Hurwyn Eau De Cologne, quality o/w, fabulous outline, very sound on the move.
Lacked lustre hence my decision;
3 Edmondson's Crookrise White Lace.
Open Bitch $(15,5) 1$ Blackburn-Bennett's Chesterhope North N Breeze at Kanix, looks so good standing \& is a series of graceful curves with the best of necks \& shoulders, strong bone, good feet, lovely tail, moved very well, liked her a lot. RCC as she lacked the head \& style of the CC winner;
2 Graham \& Denwood's Sh Ch Lyndfil Bed Of Roses, b/w, built on heavier lines, different type to 1 . Lovely head, stood out well, quality bitch who moved very well. Preferred elegance of 1 ; 3 Westaway's Sh Ch Penwest Paza.
