1st Jones' Dappleline Euphoria with Dottymix, pleasing head & eye, covered lots of ground on the move. Needs more weight to complete the picture;

2nd Yeo's Thorncross Cornish Crusade at Trexon, failed to 1 in couplings & sweep of stifle; 3rd Ward's Whipspan Paul Hogan.

LIMIT DOG (14,1)

1st Parsons' Pipeaway Sugar Raye, well balanced with lovely head with plenty of work & depth of stop, nice neck & shoulder placement, good topline, deep in chest, good turn of stifle, moved really well covering lots of ground, well shown. CC & BOB;

2nd Luke's Sniperay Solstice Son, very good headed dog, good shoulders, depth of body & well angulated quarters, moved with plenty of drive using his hocks. Not quite as finished as 1;

3rd Udale's Freddie Flintoff.

OPEN DOG (12,2)

1st Walkling's Kiswahili Catcher In The Rye, have seen this dog from the ringside & was pleasantly surprised on going over him, good head, nice neck & shoulders, good in topline & rearquarters, moved well, good action on the move. RCC;

2nd Rossiter & Fox's Am Ch Marsuz Alydar I Like It I Love It at Solivia, liked his head, good body shape, good bone, nice rearend. Did not move as well as 1; 3rd Gordon's Hawkfield Dapper In Black.
