Many thanks for my invitation to judge at the Pointer Club 50th Anniversary Show - it was an honour. It was ten years ago since I judged the 40th Ruby show. So maybe the 60th?? It was a privilege to judge alongside my co judge, Mrs Dawn Ingham who I have known for many years.

The Pointer Standard asks for a series of graceful curves. I felt some are too square, with tails carried to high. The correct shape for bone, feet and pasterns needs watching.

VETERAN BITCH

- 1st Hinton's SH CH HOOKWOOD PRETTY WOMAN: 8 year old O/W bitch on top form awarded her first cc. Still has all the quality on top form. B.V.I.S
- 2nd O' Driscoll's FOWINGTON ALABAMER SLAMMER: B/W Bitch Beautiful head and eye, not moving as free as 1.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH

- 1st Dyer's SHARNPHILLY AUCKLAND: Beautiful B/W Bitch 7 months old correct shaped bone, balances head with the best of expressions, nice deep sprung rib down to elbows, good angulations front and rear moving with purpose. Overall a nice picture. B.P.B & then B.P.I.S.

Shown in first class order. BCC and B.I.S. I do not think it will be long before the others follow in this form.

Head carriage was poor, as were tails, some exhibits carrying them far too high and only a small number actually using them. Overall the one thing that comes to mind is mediocrity and that is one thing that pointer lovers and breeders should never settle for. For this breed is the aristocrat of the gundog world and at the moment they look anything but.

VETERAN DOG

- 1st WILSON SH CH BONNYGATE GUNNS A BLAZING: Lovely headed dog who I have admired, well muscled & so sound on the move, full of breed type
- 2nd NELIS LYNWATER JAVELIN OVER FREEBREEZE: Another sound moving dog full of type & shown in great condition, lovely carriage on the move
