PUPPY DOG

1st Anderson-Rowell's Daledancer Silver Fame, o/w, well proportioned head with deep muzzle, strong neck, good depth of body, strong well muscled quarters used to advantage on the move;

2nd Nuttall's Peakdale Silver Frost, nice type with all the essentials but needs time to settle. Good topline held on the move. Preferred front assembly of 1.

JUNIOR DOG

1st Dodds' Raigmore Light Up The Sky for Lyncarda, o/w, upstanding young dog, appealing head & expression, good reach of neck, well placed shoulders, mature body, good quarters & hocks, lovely to watch on the move in profile but needs to tighten up in front movement;

2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Shine From Afar, o/w, balanced head, good muzzle, compact body with depth. Preferred the front of 1.

YEARLING DOG

1st Mitchell's Gartarry Moonshine over Staxyll, o/w, first of two lovely dogs to go over, balanced head with good eye, strong reachy neck into well placed shoulders, straight front well boned, strong quarters & hocks used to advantage on the move;

2nd O'Driscoll's Gartarry Moonlight Flit to Fowington, litter brother to 1, pleasing head & expression & very similar. Preferred the front of 1;

3rd Mason's Freebreeze Figaro.

MAIDEN DOG

1st Anderson-Rowell's Daledancer Silver Fame.

NOVICE DOG

1st Tibbs' Raigmore Shine From Afar.

GRADUATE DOG

1st Mason's Freebreeze Figaro, o/w, upstanding dog but did not always make the most of himself standing. Good reach of neck, well muscled throughout with proportioned body & strong quarters;

2nd Smith's Fydal Ace, b/w, liked this dog on the move, keeping his outline but again would not show himself to advantage when standing;

3rd Wilson's Prosperity Lookin Good.

POST GRADUATE DOG

1st Stangroom's Lappakia Oasis Dream, o/w, upstanding dog, balanced head, well set ears, strong neck into flowing neck & shoulders, elbows tucked in, straight front, oval bone, proportioned body with depth, flowing movement;

2nd McNab's Shanandi Dark Shadow of Querdon, b/w. Needs to settle on the move. Clean neck & shoulders, good depth of body, hindquarters & hocks well angulated;

3rd Batchelor's Groma Jesse James.

LIMIT DOG

1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Diamond In The Rough, o/w, lovely young dog & full of quality, appealing head & eye, strong neck with good reach, flowing into well angled shoulders & upper arm, excellent front, well boned with good feet, well proportioned body with depth, strong muscular quarters with good hocks well let down & used on the move with bee-sting tail & lashing action on the move, correct topline held on the move. CC, understand gives him his title;

2nd Huxley's Saregres Fame Of Gold at Woodfleet, upstanding dog, good body with depth, flowing topline held on the move, another lovely dog to go over. Preferred the front assembly of 1;

3rd Westron's Aurichalcum Lord Beckett of Castlepoint.

OPEN DOG

1st Rose & Robinson's Sh Ch/Aus/NZ Ch Robwyndreams Are Free at Ridanflight, o/w, headed a trio of lovely dogs to go over & see on the move, each pushed each other hard, well defined head, strong neck flowing into well placed shoulders, good front, balanced body, well muscled quarters allowing him to cover the ground, a graceful series of curves throughout. RCC;

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kiswahili Martin at Kanix, o/w, upstanding dog with all the essentials, symmetrical with strength, well proportioned body, flowing topline. Not so settled on the move as 1;

3rd Kirby's Haramander Shabby Chic.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG

1st Nuttall's Peakdale Silver Frost.

VETERAN BITCH

1st Stangroom's Janeryl's Desert Flower at Lappakia, feminine head & expression, good reach of neck, balanced body with good quarters, moved well;

2nd Fairbairn's Carmelfair Evian, nice type, clean neck & shoulders deep body. Not so settled on the move as 1;

3rd Huxley's Ch Woodfleet Siennarain.

FIELD TRIAL BITCH

1st Huxley's Ch Woodfleet Siennarain, l/w, good head, straight front, deep body, strong well muscled quarters, typy throughout moving soundly from well let down hocks.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH

1st Rose's Ridanflight Rhianna, o/w, the first of litter sisters, both a lovely type to judge, well defined feminine head, strong neck & shoulders, good straight front, well matured body for her age, moved soundly with style;

2nd McGilp's Ridanflight Rhosyn, o/w. Not as mature as her sister, finer throughout. Lovely head & expression, good front well boned. Needs to settle on the move to make advantage of herself;

3rd Batchelor's Hookwood Its A Kind Of Magic.

PUPPY BITCH

1st McDougall's Daledancer Cool Dawn at Wynhead, well defined feminine head, straight front, balanced body with good angulation throughout. Would like more to have seen more animation on the move.

JUNIOR BITCH

1st Huxley's Woodfleet Shoot The Sun, l/w, balanced feminine head, good eye, clean neck & shoulders, good stifles & hocks, moved soundly;
2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Reach For The Stars, o/w, young bitch full of quality from head to toe. However did not do herself justice on the move, with the breed typical graceful outline;
3rd Nelis' Freebreeze Providence.

YEARLING BITCH

1st Andrews & Ledger's Sunny Side Up at Ledgands, o/w, well proportioned head, good eye & expression, flowing symmetrical outline held on move, straight front oval bone, deep brisket from well placed shoulders, well balanced body, strong quarters used to advantage on the move, from strong hocks. RCC;
2nd Hall's Gartarry New Moon, feminine head, good neck, straight front well boned, good feet, strong quarters used on the move;
3rd Smith's Fydal Ava.

MAIDEN BITCH

1st Rose's Ridanflight Rhonwen, still a puppy, litter sister to 2 above pups, appealing feminine head, clean neck & shoulders, good front, well proportioned throughout, lovely on the move. Still needs time to settle to the show ring, joy to go over, should have a bright future. BP.

GRADUATE BITCH

1st Blackburn Bennett's Kanix Cara Anne, o/w, full of quality, good balanced head, straight front oval bone, good feet, proportioned body, strong quarters used on the move, litter sister to my BOB winner, very breed typical;
2nd Burnett's Caithpoint Spice Girl, o/w, appealing head & expression, straight front, balanced body with graceful outline & depth of brisket. Not showing the animation of 1 on the move;
3rd Boyd & Hinton's Keepersfield Starshine over Glowmist.

POST GRADUATE BITCH

1st Stangroom's Lappakia Dune Song, o/w, very typy, well defined head, flowing neck & shoulders into correct topline, deep body, good quarters & hocks allowing her to move freely;
2nd Jones & Hinton's Pippalee Georgia by Fleurfields, o/w. Not so mature as 1. Another pleasing type, feminine head & good eye. Preferred front assembly of 1;
3rd O'Neil's Tenshilling Viva Las Vegas.

LIMIT BITCH

1st O'Neil's Tenshilling Di It Again, two lovely bitches to go over, well defined head, good reachy neck into well placed shoulders, correct front, proportioned deep body, feminine throughout & breed typical graceful series of curves;
2nd Evans & Pavey's Joneva Hazy Dazy Dream, good head & eye, strong neck, good front angulation deep body, strong stifles. Preferred overall flow of outline of 1;
3rd Hall's Gartarry Chiff Chaff.

OPEN BITCH

1st Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Chilli, o/w, best mover of the day both going & coming back, well defined head, good expression, strong muscular neck flowing into well placed shoulders with well angled upper arm, straight front with oval bone, good depth of body, series of graceful curves both standing & on the move. CC, the all important third, & BOB;

2nd Rose's Sh Ch Ridanflight Riangiora, o/w, lovely head & expression, good muzzle, reachy neck, good front angulation, deep mature body & strong quarters from let down hocks. However preferred front movement of 1;

3rd Andrews & Ledger's Multi Ch Aurichalcum Miss Tified Legands.
