### VETERAN DOG OR BITCH (3)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Cardiff's Prosperity My Fair Lady, 10 years old lemon/w looking very well, moving on a long lead like a youngster;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Naden's Wychwood Midsomer Dream, o/w in tip-top condition, holds a good front & topline;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Drake's Sh Ch Clamerkin Crystal Mountain.

### MINOR PUPPY DOG (3)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold, b/w, lovely head, good stop & occiput, lovely forehand width of thigh, set of tail, full of substance. Hope he doesn't grow on too much;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Wilcox's Wilchrimane Bold Move for Merynjen, o/w, built on finer lines. Lovely head, neck & shoulder, not the backend of 1 but right for age;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Simmons' Millpoint For The Love Of It at Honeywood.

### PUPPY DOG (5,1a)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Hazeltine's Hookwood By George, o/w, real good looker, full of quality, tended to over reach on the move but looked well;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Baker & Baker-Roullier's Desfrisa Old Etonian.

### JUNIOR DOG (4,2)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Lypal Hanky Panky, o/w, moved over ground with ease, has depth, reach of neck, holds a good topline, a real eye catcher;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe's Teisgol I Am The One And Only, b/w, another good looking youngster, needs to tidy himself up in front on the move, will come with time.

### YEARLING DOG (1)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Isherwood's Symitry Red Rascal, o/w, stood alone. Has a clean cut head & flared nostrils, nice forehand, moved well at times, needs to settle.

### POST GRADUATE DOG (8,2)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tregaskis' Moenfair Choirboy, moved superbly, strong over loin, balanced, good reach of neck, good forehand, lengthy resilient pasterns;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Oddie's Wilchrimane Igoyougo at Riowood, beaten today on forehand, has nice sweep over stifle, moves well over his ground;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Smith's Lypal Deeply Dippy.

### LIMIT DOG (10,1)

- 1<sup>st</sup> Watkins & Davies' Hurwyn Law N Order, balanced dog, not overdone, good head, keen eye with length of foreface, resilient in pasterns, good coupling, ribs with spring & depth, good width of thigh with first & second muscling, moved well on a good length; DCC  
2<sup>nd</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigoor Rough And Tumble, another well balanced dog, lovely head & neck, super condition. Real credit to his owner;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Coggins & Coggins' Droveborough Born To Bound at Gemrose.

### **OPEN DOG (5)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn's Kanix Fredrik, b/w, great type, clean head, kind eye with expression, liked his forehand, shoulder, depth & spring to ribs, this dog has substance & moves sound on tight feet; RDCC  
2<sup>nd</sup> Welch's Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood, b/w, great type, clean head, kind eye with expression, liked his forehand, shoulder depth & spring to ribs, this dog has substance & moves sound on tight feet;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Kirby's Sh Ch Haramander Shabby Chic.

### **GOOD CITIZEN DOG SCHEME DOG (4)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tregaskis' Moenfair Choirboy;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Brooksmith's Nightgold Blackavar, balanced, loved her type, just needs time, will make a lovely dog;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Stangroom's Pipeaway Laura Louisa at Lappakia.

### **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (5,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Stuckey's Medogold Coralie of Pendan, liver/w, loved her head, shoulder, topline, couplings & depth to brisket, strong back end, has all the essentials to go all the way, one I would like to own - BPIB;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Archer & Booth's Teddyhawks Eva May, has strength all thorough, quality with bone & substance, but needs to steady down;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Brooksmith's Medogold Kiss N'Tell.

### **PUPPY BITCH (10)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Baker, Baker-Roullier's Desfrisa Diva La Viva, b/w, well balanced & bodied, best of forehands, sweep over stifle, moved well on tight feet;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Ward & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Just A Rumour by Jakobstown, lots of work in head, resilient pasterns, liked her balance, strong quarters, moved on a good length;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Parsons' Pipeaway Dolly Rocker.

### **JUNIOR BITCH (9,2)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Wilberg's Kanix Irene, o/w, super head, eye & lay of shoulder, short couplings with ribs reaching well back, strength of quarters, sweep over stifle, driving hocks;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Dyer & Dyer's Sharnphilly Legally Blonde, super bitch, similar remarks apply. How can I separate them? She is so balanced, made a lovely pair;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Green's Kanix Hyacinth.

### **YEARLING BITCH (5)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Howes' Medogold Here Comes The Girl, b/w, good on the leg, well off for bone, driving hocks, moved well on a good length;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Isherwood's Symitry Tickled Pink, good head & ear, length of shoulder & topline. Close up to winner;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Smith's Lypal Once Upon A Time.

### **POST GRADUATE BITCH (10,1)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Hamilton's Ridanflight Raewyn, o/w built on class lines, clean head, flowing topline, lengthy pasterns, depth through ribs, moved well;  
2<sup>nd</sup> Ward's Adventures Of Isabel by Jakobstown, b/w, moved so sound, much to like, head & eye, tight feet, strong quarters;  
3<sup>rd</sup> Parsons' Pipeaway Ginger Glory.

**LIMIT BITCH (7,3)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Cooper's Keepersfield Mama Mia, b/w, good head, eye & ear, good length of upper arm, topline & tailset, well angulated quarters, moved out her ground well;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Tiara, clean lines, has quality. Could have lifted her tail a little more on the move, lots to like;
- 3 Brooksmith's Nightgold Blackavar.

**OPEN BITCH (4)**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Dyer & Dyer's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Juici Cuture, l/w, super quality bitch, best of lines, balanced all through, not overdone, moved over her ground well on a good length, keeping her topline – BCC & BOB;
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Howes' Sh Ch Medogold Double Dizzy, b/w, loved her type. Best of shoulder, upper arm, topline & tailset, spring & depth of rib, not short in foreface like some, so sound - RBCC;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Rankine's Tenshilling Rags To Riches at Fyldefair.
