1st Siddle's Wilchrimane C'mon Norbert o/w 9 month puppy, well balanced and constructed, pleasant head with a good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, excellent spring of rib and well down, good angulation and bone, covered the ground well, a promising puppy

2nd Tannahills Wynbury Walter Jack b/w 8 months another well constructed puppy not quite as mature as previous but never the less a promising puppy, moved well

3rd Wilcox's Wilchrimane Bold Move for Merynjen.

PUPPY DOG (4)

1st Howes' Millpoint Babe Magnet at Medogold a puppy out of the top drawer, a pleasure to handle with excellent head, reach of neck, fine leathers, well laid shoulders, correct top line, into a well set bee sting tail, moved well, another to watch for.

2nd Simmons' Millpoint For The Love of It at Honeywood I/w well constructed but a little raw needs to mature and tighten up,

3rd Radcliffe's Sniperay Atlantis.

JUNIOR DOG (5)

1st Hinton & Lennox's Mursbrae Theodore by Fleurfield o/w a sound junior pleasing head, good reach of neck with well laid shoulders, good spring of rib well down, good bone and angulation, tight feet, sound top line into a nice tail set, I'm sure he will mature into a fine adult.

2nd Hazeltine's Hookwood by George o/w very similar to previous not quite as mature but has all the same attributes.

3rd Weaver's Anniezu Lovely Day.

NOVICE DOG (3)

1st Tannahill's Wynbury Walter Jack

2nd Hazeltine's Hookwood By George

3rd Saunders' Teisgol Massalm.

POST GRADUATE DOG (7)

1st Smith & Radcliffe's Sniperay Rip Van Winkle from Tzaziki b/w an agreeable head with dark eyes, fine leathers, good reach of neck flowing into an excellent top line through to the tail, good angulation and sound bone, sound movement driving hide action.

2nd Isherwood's Symitry Red Rascal o/w a sound head for type, again a well constructed dog, good bone now more settled on the move but still needs to mature.

3rd Pattie's Hurwyn Masterchef.

LIMIT DOG (11)

1st Harrison's Millpoint Heat Wave JW ShCM a very sound dog the quality you expect from this kennel, solid, well angulated with all the right proportions, well muscled, tight feet moved well with drive.

2nd Watkins & Davies' Hurwyn Law N Order JW again has most of the attributes as previous, moved well with drive but still needs to mature.

3rd Bradley's Teisgol King Alfred at Dappledown.

OPEN DOG (4)

1st Harrison's Millpoint Top Hat N'tails JW ShCM a dog out of the top drawer, ticks all the boxes, a very sound dog all round a picture to watch, fits the standard well DCC & BOB

2nd Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Diamond in the Rough JW another top dog, different type but a very sound dog again ticks all the boxes, consistently performs well, a pleasant head and reach of neck, good spring of rib well let down, flowing top line through to the tail, sound movement. 3rd Theobald's Sh Ch Tycarreg JW ShCM.

PUPPY BITCH (7)

1st Stuckey's Medogold Coralie of Pendan

2nd Brooksmith's Medogold Kiss N'tell, Litter sisters, very similar to each other, difficult to split, and the result could be reversed on another occasion both had admirable heads ,reach of neck in to well laid shoulders, good spring of rib, sound bone and well angulated, correct feet, both moved well, the difference on the day I felt the 1st was covered better which made a better profile 3rd Dykes' Raigmore Starlet at Briartor.

JUNIOR BITCH (5)

1st Welch's Oxfordacres Trinity, Short coupled well developed bitch, pleasing head, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, excellent spring of rib well down with sound movement. 2nd Tobin& Moss Davigder Diamond Lil a promising young bitch, attractive head, good stop and leathers, clean reach of neck with a good profile of smooth curves but not quite as mature as previous 3rd Ward's Kanix Just a Rumour by Jakobstown.

NOVICE BITCH (5,2)

1st Stuckey's Medogold Coralie of Pendan

2nd Brooksmith's Medogold Kiss N'tell

3rd Salt's Pennine Passion.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (12,1)

1st Hewitt's Sunhouse As You Like It, a very confident bitch took my eye on the move, driving well with a thrashing tail, pleasing profile, well sprung ribs carried well back sound bone and angulation. 2nd Pimblett's Pennine Pastichi a short coupled bitch pleasing to the eye, good angulation and bone, attractive head, thin leathers well set, with deep flews a little unsettled on the move. 3rd Wilkinsons' Hurwyn Black Caviar.

LIMIT BITCH (11,3)

1st Howes' Medogold Here Comes The Girl a cracking head. With dark eyes, good ear set, well developed flews, excellent profile, well knit feet, nicely constructed.

2nd Rankine's Tenshilling Rags To Riches at Fyldefair an excellent example of her type, also well constructed, sound head and reach of neck with a nice flowing top line not as settled as she is normally on the move.

3rd Lathwell's Teisgol It's Your Chance for Tinchitamba,
