He has good bone, feet & also has flowing lines, was presented in good condition. 2nd Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Diamond Lil, another feminine girl with similar qualities to the winner, good bone, body & also has lovely feminine head with good expression, another with graceful curves & pushed winner close but not as together when covering the ground & therefore does not quite show herself off to the full advantage she could;

POST GRADUATE BITCH (18,3)

1st Fleetwood's Tyremy Southseaspice, good head proportions & good eye, well set ears, good length neck into well built front. She had good depth & a strong loin, well angled rear & good tail. Holds a balanced picture when covering ground with good front action;

2nd Brooksmith's Nightgold Blackavar, another lovely feminine exhibit with good head, eye & ears, good neck, bone & feet. Also holds a quality picture going round & also presented in very good coat & condition, to 'nit-pick' & separate them today, ever so slightly longer in loin than 1, but still so much to like;

Good depth, ribs well back, has strong loin, muscular well angled rear, well set & good length tail which she used. She covered the ground smoothly holding good outline & with good head carriage. Presented in very good coat & condition, good front reach & if you were to be really 'picky' could have a tiny more width in her rear action, but by no ways weak, she has plenty of drive & holds a lovely profile picture. CC & BOB, good to see her go on to G2;

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Sh Ch Kanix Chilli, this bitch has the most beautiful quality head & expression, a lovely type who is more than worthy title holder, quality bone & body & stands on very good feet, first class presentation & unfortunate to meet winner on such good form; 3rd Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Hazy Hazy Dream.

VETERAN BITCH (5,1)

1st Mason's Freebreeze As You Like It, feminine, very good breed type, good eye & expression, a balanced body & loved her lashing tail as she covered the ground, good coat & condition; 2nd Yeo's Wilchrimane Desert Rose at Trexon, also a good specimen of the breed with lots of breed type, good bone & feet & in good condition holds good topline & good expression; 3rd Stangroom's Medogold Wannabeposh for Lappakia.
