2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe, Stilgoe & Harrison's Enzo Del Almojon, another nice young dog, not as advanced as 1, but a tidy shape & decent movement;

3<sup>rd</sup> Wilcox's Objet D'Art Du Morcaro at Merynjen.

## YEARLING DOG (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Abbott & Wilberg's Larchwold Star Chaser at Kanix, heavier style than I normally prefer, but a very pleasing dog all through, moved soundly, used tail;
