MINOR PUPPY DOG (5,1)

1st Smith's Sniperay Valencia at Tzaziki, very mature in body & head for age, pleasing shape & balance. Deep well ribbed body with good feet. Moved soundly just hope he doesn't grow on much more;

2nd Radcliffe's Sniperay Jhambiri, litter brother & very similar in type & qualities just not as forward as 1; 3rd Gordon & Petherick's Hawkfield Strider.

1st Macara, Jamieson & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Legend at Cromasaig, mature orange dog of good size & proportions. Masculine head, deep well ribbed body with good bone & substance. Strong well angulated & muscled hindquarters. Presented a pleasing outline. Moved with great drive from behind covering the ground well. RCC;

2nd Radcliffe's Sniperay Jhambiri;

3rd Batchelor's Wilchrimane Clickety Click to Kielderpoint.

1st Smith's Sniperay Valencia at Tzaziki.

POST GRADUATE DOG (6,1a)

1st Rose's Ridanflight Roller Blade, pleasing headed dog with dark eye, balanced body with plenty bone & substance. Presented a good outline standing & on the move covering the ground with reach & drive. Needs to drop & fill out in front but is a good size & very typical in outline;

2nd Tregaskis's Moenfair Spicewood Summer, pleasing overall type & construction, a little up to size but scored in movement covering the ground soundly with drive;

3rd Scholes' Pipeaway Antonio Mancini.

LIMIT DOG (12,2)

1st Abbott & Wilberg's Larchwold Star Chaser at Kanix, balanced well made dog excelling in construction & movement, presenting a good outline he has great presence especially on the move which he does soundly with great reach & drive. Would just prefer a shade less of him all over;

2nd Hazeltine & Upton's Hookwood By George, masculine headed dog with good bone & substance, pleasing for size & balance, just preferred the movement on 1;

3rd Walkling, Grantham & Moss' Aspyre Follow Your Dreams to Kiswahili.

OPEN DOG (6) Difficult class very varied in type.

1st Martin's Sunhouse Anything Goes, on first impressions this dog didn't stand out, however on handling I found him typical unexaggerated & moderate in all departments. He is well constructed & refined, with a balanced body & sound positive movement covering the ground with ease. Shown & presented in lovely condition. CC;

2nd Welch's Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood, pleasing overall for type & balance, well proportioned body with plenty bone & substance. Moved well;

3rd Siddle, Crocker, Medieros & O'Neill's Am/Can Sh Ch Seasyde Chesterhope Bingo.

- 1st Cooper's Keepersfield Mama Mia, nice headed bitch with good eye & expression, balanced outline with good angulation both ends. Sound mover & in good condition for age;
- 2nd Stangroom's Lappakia Dune Song, pleasing type & construction good outline just preferred size & head of 1, good condition moved well.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4,1)

- 1st Rankine's Gempoint Catch A Dream for Fyldefair, pretty headed bitch with dark eye, balanced well made body with plenty bone & substance. Good quarters & rear angulation. Moved soundly;
- 2nd Disley's Ridanflight Rum Truffle, good overall outline & construction just needing to mature & develop with age, moved well;
- 3rd Gordon's Hawkfield Saunter.

PUPPY BITCH (3,1)

- 1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Allure, mature bitch with many of her famous mothers qualities, pleasing head, deep body with lovely legs & feet. Well angulated quarters which she uses on the move covering the ground soundly with style, shown in lovely condition. BP & pleased to hear BPIS;
- 2nd Onions' Wilchrimane Tapestry, litter sister & similar in type & construction, head needs to develop & preferred shoulders on 1, moved well.

JUNIOR BITCH (5,2)

- 1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges, quality young bitch with a lovely head with plenty work in it & a dark eye. Good front assembly scoring in for chest which so many lacked. Balanced well made body with good outline. Moved soundly with style just needs a little more maturity;
- 2nd Hinton & Knowles' Fleurfield Finlandia, another quality bitch just needing to develop in head a little more. Balanced body with flowing lines & sound positive mover;
- 3rd Burke's Alcazar Amorous Liaison.

NOVICE BITCH (3)

- 1st Evans & Pavey's Joneva Mrs Bridges;

POST GRADUATE BITCH (14,3)
