Some exhibits were carrying too much weight, weight is not condition, a Pointer outline should be a series of graceful curves, with well developed muscles.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (7,4)

 1^{st} Philo's Fydal Caprio At Salmonmist. 7 month old o/w who is well constructed with a good length of neck into clean shoulder. He has a lovely outline with well developed quarters with an excellent topline and tail set. Tended to be a little erratic on the move due to his exuberance but he is only a baby. Best Puppy dog. 2^{nd} Ram's Dacon Sharp Spear. Different type to 1 and slightly more together on the move, overall a bigger dog even though he is the same age. He is well constructed with excellent bone and plenty of condition. Good tail and set.

3rd Gerrard's Carmandine Count On Me.

PUPPY DOG (8,4)

1st Philo's Fydal Caprio At Salmonmist.

2nd Ram's Dacon Sharp Spear.

3rd Saunders' Phlynnies Prince of Thieves.

JUNIOR DOG (9,5)

1st Best's Bestina Balbenach. Loved him for his type, he has a beautiful head and expression with dark eyes, stands on good legs and feet, well balanced outline, needs to be gone over to be appreciated. Moves out well on an even stride. He could benefit from carrying a bit more weight but he is still a young dog, I was pleased to award him the RCC.

2nd Bedson's Caithpoint Extreme Faith. Another nice type who is well constructed all through. Not as nice in expression as the winner and needs to settle on the move.

3rd Booth's Lundgarth Teal.

YEARLING DOG (2)

1st O'Neill's Sh Ch Chesterhope Thrill of T Chase (Imp) -Mature young dog (who I have met on numerous occasions) he has a typical outline, stands on good legs and feet and is a series of graceful curves. His head is lovely in profile with correct proportions, sloping neck into well placed shoulders, slightly sloping topline with good tail and set. Moved out well on an even stride at one with his handler, pleased to award him the CC and BOB. Delighted he made the cut in the group.

2nd Booth's Lundgarth Teal. Not the construction of the winner, he is rather upright in shoulder and short in upper arm, pleasant enough head and needs more angulation all through.

POST GRADUATE DOG (5,2)

1st Adams' Millpoint Simply Smashing JW. Won this class with ease. Clean outline, too much slope on his topline for me, but he stands on good legs and feet and everything flows through, shown in good coat and condition, moved out well.

2nd Tannahill's Wynbury Walter Jack JW. Another well constructed dog, better shoulder than 3. He has good bone, looks well in profile, moved well.

3rd Saunders' Teisgol Double Trigger.

LIMIT DOG (9,6)

1st Rayner & Spinks' Freebreeze Over The Top At Spinray. L/w dog with a pleasant outline he has a good neck and shoulders correct topline, would like to see a better bend of stifle, moved okay.

2nd Tregaskis' Moenfair Spicewood Summer. Heavier build than winner, good bone, legs and feet correct topline, nice quarters.

3rd Adams' Ansona Peter Pan JW ShCM.

VETERAN DOG (5,3)

1st Best's Shadesett Keep On Believin For Bestina. Lovely type with a beautiful head and expression, well constructed shoulders, straight front, excellent profile, sound quarters, moved on a long stride with good tail action. Best Veteran.

2nd Roberts' Kanix Dantes Inferno. Heavier in head than winner and short in muzzle giving him an unbalanced profile. He has a good lay of shoulder but is short in the upper arm, good width of thigh.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (10,6)

1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Pirouette. A pretty well put together orange. She has a lovely balanced head and dark eye with correct outline although she does tend to get over stretched a little. Comes together well on the move. Best Puppy In Breed.

2nd Rayner & Spinks' Gartarry All That Jazz At Spinray. Good bone and nice outline, balanced in profile, moves close behind.

3rd Rankin's Fyldefair Apricot Fudge.

PUPPY BITCH (4,3)

1st Rayner & Spinks' Gartarry High Society At Spinray. Nice in profile, slightly sloping topline, pleasant enough, good legs and feet, moved okay.

JUNIOR BITCH (4,3)

1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Frankel (Ai). Well known very mature orange, nice head and expression, good front with a deep brisket, excellent toplinewell muscled quarters. Moved with drive.

YEARLING BITCH (3,2)

1st Matthews' Millpoint Simply Bootifull With Sonham. Good outline with a lovely head and expression. Stands on good legs and feet, good topline, carrying far too much weight and needs more muscletone.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (14,11)

1st Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee JW. One I have done well for in the past, she has matured in to a lovely young lady. Well balanced with good depth, super outline, shown in good condition delighted to award her the RCC.

2nd Gerrard's Carmandine Call My Bluff. Balanced in profile with good neck and shoulders. Slightly sloping topline, a bit wide in front and rear on the move.

3rd Booth's Crookrise Wren.

LIMIT BITCH (12,9)

1st Elrington's Ansona Cinderella JW. Today was her day. B/w who has a cracking head and expression, clean outline with excellent bone, legs and feet. Balanced all through, shown in superb coat and condition. Moved really well to take the CC her 3rd. Congratulations.

2nd Vaughn's Teisgol I Am What I Am At Phlynnies - Longer cast than my winner. Balanced head with good expression, straight front, good in profile.

3rd Tregaskis' Moenfair Tinpenny Tod Tails.

VETERAN BITCH (2,1)

1st Booth's Galema Iona. Good neck and shoulders, correct topline, Needs more muscletone and moves close behind.
