 2^{nd} Adams' Fisherbloom Re'encountered. Another very nice puppy. Different in type to 1. Lovely head. Good neck and shoulders. Good body shape. Moved well. Not the outline of 1. 3^{rd} Hazeltine & Welch's Hookwood Lennox.

PUPPY DOG (5, 2 abs)

1st Hazeltine & Welch's Hookwood Lennox. 8 month old O/w. 3rd in Minor Puppy. Well up to size. Not the head of the Minor Puppies but worthy of this class. Moved well.

2nd Preece & Gilding's Harvestslade Cullinan. Again well up to size. Strong head. Good body shape but could not match movement of 1.

JUNIOR DOG (6, 3 abs)

1st Gordon's Hawkfield Audacity (AI). O/w. Lovely size. Masculine head. Good neck and shoulders. Deep body. Lovely tail set, strong quarters which he used well on the move.

2nd Osman's Fleurfield Fire Thorne at Marissolo. B/w. Lovely head, nice neck and shoulders. Good body shape. Nice rear end. Tends to roach at times when stacked, front needs to tighten but a nice dog. 3rd O'Neill's Tenshilling Biscuits.

1st Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Obi of Stargang. O/w. Super young dog with everything in the right place. Not a big boy, very typy, moved extremely well. Lovely masculine head without coarseness. Lovely flowing lines. Delighted to award him the RCC.

1st Watkins & Davies' Ansona Aladdin. Upstanding b/w. Lovely head. Long neck into well laid shoulders. Good spring of rib, lovely hindquarters, lovely outline, moved well, liked him a lot. 2nd Collins' Collholme John Paul. B/w. Similar remarks apply. Needs more confidence but moved well. 3rd Bradley's Dappledown Jack Flash.

MID LIMIT DOG (8)

1st Jamieson, Macara & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix News Flash at Glenfawnan. L/w. Super upstanding dog. Lovely head. Lovely outline, very impressive on the move with great style and animation. 2nd Tibbs' Fydal Beeswing at Raigmore. Very smart o/w. Lovely outline in hard condition. Happy temperament. Gives handler a bit of a hard time on the move but when settled moved well. Best of fronts.
