1st Mason's Nosam Never Say Never Again At Kiswahili. Good overall balance, pleasing head, clean neck fitting into a well laid shoulder and good length of upperarm, well made quarters with defined second thigh. Moved on a long stride.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH

1st Wilkinson's Stocksfell Seldom Seen. Lovely baby, feminine balanced head, good in neck and topline, pleasing development in rib, good quarters and tail set.

2nd Watkins, Phillips & Gordon's Hawkfield Audacious. Lovely type and presents a balanced outline. She has femininity with substance, strong neck fitting into a well constructed front, good bend of stifle and well let down hocks. Needs to move on a more collected stride.

1st Mason's Nasam Kwatile. Third in PB. Pleased in head, neck and ribbing, shapely quarters. Not as positive in front movement as ideal.

POST GRADUATE BITCH
