JUNIOR DOG (1)

1st Oddie's Sharnphilly Boondoggle. CC and BOB. I make no secret on how much I like this young dog, for me he has great breed type, super head, eye and bite, so well constructed front, good bone and feet, excellent topline and quarters, good forechest and ribs, sound and stylish with good reach and drive, nice side profile, shown in tip top body and coat. Wish he was mine. Good luck.

POST GRADUATE DOG (1)

1st Gerrard's Carmandine Count On Me. Masculine black and white dog, nice head and eye, good neck and shoulders, nice bone and feet, good topline and quarters, nice length of tail, moved well with good reach and drive, in nice body and coat.

LIMIT DOG (1)

1st Hall's Gartarry You Shook Me. Quality black and white dog, nice head and eye, good bite, nice bone, ok feet, needs a little more forechest, good length of body, moved well with great side profile, moderate quarters, nice tail, in good coat, just needs more body to complete the picture.

PUPPY BITCH (3)

1st Gerrard's Chesterhope C'mon Over To Carmandine. RCC (Imp NZL). A quality orange pup, oozes breed type, super head and expression, correct bite, such a well constructed front, nice bone and feet, excellent ribs, topline and quarters, shown in super body and coat, moves well for her seven and a half months, shown in super body and coat, moves well for her seven and a half months. I'm sure with a bit of luck will have a great future.

2nd Hall's Gartarry Sweet Dreams. Another quality pup that put up a great performance today. Pleasing head and eye, good bite, nice neck and shoulders, super bone and feet, good length of ribs, strong topline and quarters, moved well with great style, in tip top body and coat. LIMIT BITCH (2)

1st Fewster, Rossiter & Mitchel's Sonstraal Only An Illusion JW ShCM ShCEx. Pleasing head and eye, nice reach of neck, well constructed front, nice forechest, length of rib, good strong topline, well muscled quarters, sound and stylish, in good body and coat, nice legs and feet.

2nd McKiernan's Glenariff Rock Rose via Bushbane. Quality black and white, nice head and eye, good bite, strong bone and feet, excellent ribs and quarters, nice topline and tail set, moved ok, in good body and coat, a bit like myself, could carry a bit less weight.

OPEN BITCH (1)

1st Fleming's Ir Sh Ch GLenariff Golden Moon. Super orange bitch, pleasing head and eye, good bite, strong bone, well made front, good ribs, nice topline and strong quarters, shown in tip top body and coat, moved well with great side profile, close to top awards.
