What was sad to see was the loss of the tail action in the majority of the exhibits, "in movement, tail should lash from side to side" from the breed standard. Lets hope this trait returns in force in the near future.

Class Winner: Layton's Joneva Born To Thrill

1st Layton's - Joneva Born To Thrill — An impressive youngster, just 8 months old and very steady, this O&W boy has a typey head with good stop and correct length of muzzle, with well placed ears. Good length of neck in to well laid back shoulders, good length of upper arm, and enough bone for his size. Nice clean topline, and enough croup, good expanse of fist and second thigh. Steady on the move for a youngster. BPIB.

2nd *Smith's* – **Lypal Well I Never** – not as together as the winner at this moment in time, but maturing nicely. Kind eye and expression, clean neck, good forechest, correct bone, clean topline, short coupled.

Class Winner: Stokes' Moenfair Dances The Moon into Guanabara

1st Stokes' – Moenfair Dances The Moon into Guanabara – 10 month old B&W with a pleasing head, kind eye and expression, good length of neck, nice amount of fore chest with good depth to chest and spring of rib, good clean topline, adequate rear angulation. Not always together on the move which can be forgiven at this age.

2nd *Lowe's* – **Lowsmoor Crazy For You** – this ones head caught my attention straight away, just the right amount of dish and length of muzzle, good stop, kind eye and expression and correct shape, size and placement of ears, good length and strength of neck, good lay of shoulder, and a good topline, nice shape to forechest and depth to brisket. When 1st place had his act together, he had more range to his stride. **3**rd *Ovel's* – **Jimaura Bandido** – 11 month old B&W

JUNIOR DOG: (7)



Class Winner: Siddle & Siddle's Wilchrimane Niffler

1st Siddle & Siddle's – Wilchrimane Niffler – Completely balanced picture on the stack, masculine head, good length of muzzle and nice turn of lip, great length to neck, plenty of fore chest with great depth too. Shoulders are well placed with good return of upper arm. Good amount of bone of correct shape, just the right amount of slope to pasterns and nice feet. Clean smooth topline, and adequate rear angulation. He moved with ease and was light on his feet, had the desirable head carriage giving the elegance and aristocratic characteristics. RDCC.

2nd *Wilcox's* – **Pipeaway Dreams Afyre in Merynjen** – beautiful O&W dog, oozed breed type, super head and expression, just enough dish and stop, lovely ears that were of correct shape and well placed, correct length and shape to neck. Good shoulders, nice shape to fore chest, good spring of rib, enough turn of stifle. 1 had the edge on the move today.

3rd Horn's – Droveborough's Smooth Mover – 12 month old O&W, lovely balanced outline.

Long neck with nice amount of arch, sat cleanly in well laid back shoulders, good length of upper arm. Nicely filled fore chest and good depth of brisket. Clean topline and a well set tail. Adequate turn of stifle. Moved well. Pushed hard for the RCC.

2nd Gordon's – Hawkfield Audacity JW (AI) – Strong masculine dog, very typical type for this kennel, presents an outline of graceful curves. Pleasing head with good stop and a kind eye, well placed ears. Good amount of fore chest and depth to brisket. Well turned stifles and plenty of expanse of thigh.

3rd Horn's – Droveborough's Smooth Mover – 12 month old O&W, lovely balanced outline.

GRADUATE DOG: (3)



Class Winner: Macmanus' Luneville Divas Diamond

1st *Macmanus'* – **Luneville Divas Diamond** – Typey head of good proportions, nice length of muzzle and correct turn of lip, well paced ears of correct shape, size and thickness. Clean long neck with nice arch, and well placed shoulders. Nice straight front and correct bone. Plenty of depth to brisket, well ribbed and short coupled with adequate rear angulation. Has super head carriage on the move.

Typey head of good proportions, nice length of muzzle and correct turn of lip, well paced ears of correct shape, size and thickness. Clean neck of good length with nice arch, and good front assembly. Nice straight front and correct bone. Plenty of depth to brisket, well ribbed and short coupled. Would prefer a little more rear angulation. Has super head carriage on the move and kept his topline.

2nd Booth's – Lundgarth Teal – Pleasing head, excellent length of neck, good forechest, good shoulder angles, clean topline, elegant outline, would prefer a little more rear angulation. Moved well.

3rd Tobin & Moss' – Davigdor Corn Master – Balanced dog of good proportions.

LIMIT DOG: (8)



Class Winner: Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Obi at Stargang

1st Blackburn-Bennett's – Kanix Obi at Stargang – Another one possessing great static balance, stood over his ground well, no exaggeration to be seen, nice series of graceful curves, presented well. Quality head, masculine with a kind expression, good length of muzzle and correct turn of lip. Long and muscular neck, which sat in well laid back shoulders, with good length and return of upper arm, plenty of forechest, nice amount of bone. Clean and level topline, which he held perfectly on the move. Short coupled and strong muscular loin. Perfect amount of rear angulation, the right amount of turn of stifle, great expanse of first and second thigh, short hocks that are well let down. Then he moved and took command of the ring, didn't put a foot wrong, had the head carriage that excels breed type, good amount of reach in front and strong powerful hind movement, hard not to take your eye off him when he went around. Was delighted to award him his first **CC** with **BOB**, and pleasing to hear he was short listed in the group.

2nd *Philo's* – **Fydal Caprio at Salmonmist JW ShCM** – A quality dog of great breed type, very elegant, super head and expression, clean long neck, good front assembly, correct bone shape, well sprung ribs, super bee sting tail, moved well.

3rd Stilgoe's - Enzo Del Almojon through Teisgol – Lovely balanced dog, of good breed type, moved well.

2nd *Dunn's* – **Meadowpoint Look To The Star** – black and white dog with a kind eye and pleasing head shape. Clean neck of good length. Good spring of rib and depth of chest. Adequate rear angulation and good expanse of thigh. Moved with ease.

3rd *Perren's* – **Mistin Pure Mischief ShCM** – Similar to the winner in type, well balanced.

Class Winner: Horn's - Droveborough's Smooth Mover

1st Horn's – **Droveborough's Smooth Mover** – 12 month old O&W, lovely balanced outline, masculine head, strong neck of good length, well placed shoulders, good bone and straight front, well bodied and good turn of stifle, and lovely short hocks, well presented, come up against tough competition in his earlier classes.

Class Winner: Smith's - Sh Ch Fydal Ava

1st Smith's – Sh Ch Fydal Ava – Ultra feminine bitch, compact, balanced and symmetrical. Pretty head, with the correct depression under eyes, eyes bright and kind, ears thin and well set. Long elegant neck, laid back shoulders, good straight front, correct shape bone, just enough slope to pasterns, tidy feet, good width to chest and well let down brisket. Well sprung ribs, strong muscular and slightly arched loin, short coupled with just enough haunch bones showing, well set tail, adequate rear angulation and short hocks. Her elegance continued as she floated around the ring, with the correct head carriage. CC, RBOB and BV.

2nd Perkins' – Sh Ch Luneville Honey Moon at Brent ShCM – Well its been a few years since I last judged this bitch and gave her BIS at the club open show and she didn't look like she had aged one bit. What a delight to see her and judge her again. What a super head with all the right attributes, all in good proportions, those slightly rounder dark eyes draw you in to her very kind expression. Long clean elegant neck, nice straight front, correct bone and shape with visible back sinews, just the right amount of slope and length to pasterns, feet oval and well knit with good arch to toes. Great clean topline, adequate rear angulation. Another graceful mover, with the typical elegant head carriage. Very little between these two lovely bitches and was happy to award her the RBCC.

3rd Stangroom's – **Pipeaway Laura Louisa at Lappakia ShCM** – Beautiful typey bitch, pretty head, lots to like about her, up against some tough competition.
