### PUPPY DOG (3)

1<sup>st</sup> Oddie's Sharnphilly Boondoggle, black and white of 9 months very balanced outline, just flows, good angles to front and rear, pleasing head, good neck, ribs had spring depth and length, moved out well on good legs and feet, good use of tail on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Corrian & Henry's Penwest Peroni. Black/white coming up 1 year, most pleasing head, good angles to front and rear, ribs had good depth and length, good topline, moved out soundly on good legs and feet.

3<sup>rd</sup> Barker's Ragus Let's Get Moving At Flinthill.

#### **JUNIOR DOG** (7, 3)

1<sup>st</sup> Adam & Scales' Fisherbloom Re'encountered. Black & white of 16 months, excellent balanced outline, flows from head to tail, pleasing head, good teeth, excellent nose, set on clean neck let into well made forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, strong loin, good topline, well set and carried tail low hocks, good legs and feet, sound mover, good use of tail, sheen to coat.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilkinson's Stockwell Humdinger. Black & white of 15 months, another pleasing balanced outline, good masculine head, clean neck set into well made forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, loin strong, good topline tailset and carriage, well muscled rear end, sound mover on good legs and feet, fraction heavier all over than first.

3<sup>rd</sup> Booth's Lungarth Finch.

## **POST GRADUATE DOG (9, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Mackay's Fleurfield Steals The Dream ShCM. Orange & white of four and a half years, very balanced outline, pleasing masculine head, good nose, well angulated forehand ribs had spring depth and length, loin strong, good topline, tailset and carriage, good use of tail on the move, excellent stifle, with good first and second thigh, well bone legs, tight feet, a sound mover, great sheen to coat.

2<sup>nd</sup> Gerrard & Galloway's Sharnphilly Santorelli with Carmandine JW. Black & white of 2 years, beautiful head, good nose and eye, clean balanced outline, good depth to chest, well sprung ribs strong loin, good topline, tailset and carriage, well muscled rear end with good first and second thigh, low hocks, soundly moving on good legs and feet.

3<sup>rd</sup> Tobin & Moss' Davigdor Corn Master.

#### LIMIT DOG (4)

1<sup>st</sup> Adam's Millpoint Simply Smashing JW ShCM. Black & white of nearly 3 years, superb outline, balanced all through, excellent head, good neck set into well made forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, loin strong, topline and tailset all good, made good use of tail on the move, well turned stifle, good first and second thighs, low hocks, moving out soundly on good legs and feet, My Reserve Dog CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hall's Gartarry You Shook Me. Black & white of 3 years, pleasing balanced outline, a little stronger than first, good head planes, nice eye and nose, well made forequarters, first's slightly better, excellent ribs, with spring depth and length, strong loin, good topline and tailset, well muscled rear end first's slightly better, moving out soundly on good legs and feet.

#### **OPEN DOG** (4, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> O'Neill's Sh Ch Chesterhope Thrill Of T Chase (Imp NZ). Orange & white dog of 3 years, super balanced outline, nothing exaggerated but all correct and so good to go over, correct masculine head, gentle eye, excellent nose, clean neck set into well made forequarters, ribs had the spring depth and length I was looking for, loin short and strong, well muscled rear with good first and second thigh and low hocks, a very sound mover on good legs and feet, good sheen to coat, made good use of his tail on the move. Dog CC & Best of Breed and took Group1, I heard later in the day, Well done.

2<sup>nd</sup> Tibbs' Fydal Beeswing at Raigmore. Orange & white of 4 years, small neat size, not so masculine as first, excellent head piece, clean flowing lines, well angulated forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, perhaps a fraction wide in chest, excellent short loin, good topline, tailset and carriage, well muscled rear end, sound mover on good legs and feet, nice sheen to coat.

3<sup>rd</sup> Hazeltine & Welch's Just Wilburt by Hookwood JW ShCM.

## **VETERAN DOG** (2, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Welch's Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood. Black & white dog of nearly nine years, in super condition, good balanced outline, pleasing masculine head with super nose, well made forehand, ribs had spring depth and length, strong short loin, good topline, tailset and carriage, well muscled rear end a really sound mover on good legs and feet, made very good use of his tail on the move. In consideration for the Reserve CC.

### **SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG** (1)

1<sup>st</sup> Maclean's Bradleypoint Toffee Bon Bon. Brown & white of nearly 3 years, kind head and expression, I would like a little more angulation to the forequarters, he had excellent ribs, loin, topline and tailset, good muscle to the rear end moving out well on good legs and feet.

1<sup>st</sup> Mackay's Fleurfield Steals The Dream ShCM. I do apologise my notes have gone missing.

## **PUPPY BITCH (7)**

1<sup>st</sup> Harrison's Millpoint Sound Wave, 9 months, orange & white, mature pup, great outline, pleasing feminine head, excellent angles to front and rear quarters, her ribs had spring depth and length, loin short and strong, topline the tailset correct excellent rear end with good first and second thigh, low hocks, a sound mover on good legs and feet. Best Puppy In Breed.

2<sup>nd</sup> Whitehead's Joneva Esmeralda of Stridview. Just 7 months, beautiful head, great outline, nice angles to front and rear, ribs had good depth and length, loin strong, topline flows into well set tail, well angulated rear end good first and second thigh, good low hocks, very sound mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> Dyer & Oddie's Sharnphilly Serendipity.

#### **JUNIOR BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Stocksfell Seldom Seen. 15 month orange & white, very good balanced outline, excellent feminine head, good neck set into well made forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, loin strong, with good tailset, well muscled rear end, excellent legs and feet, played up a little on moving then settled.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hill's Wilchrimane China Tea at Somerled. 15 month orange & white, graceful feminine bitch with balanced outline, pleasing in head, decent angles to front and rear quarters, excellent ribs, moved soundly on good legs and feet, tail tucked in on standing, correct on the move.

## **POST GRADUATE BITCH (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Petunia at Stargang. Orange/white of just 1 year, big but feminine bitch, good balanced outline, loved her head, neck sweeps into well made forequarters, ribs had spring depth and length, strong loin, good topline and tailset, used her tail well on the move, well turned stifle, good first and second thigh, low hocks, good legs and feet the soundest of movers.

2<sup>nd</sup> Harrison's Millpoint Simply Scrumptus JW. Brown & white of 3 years, another beautiful outline, just preferred had of first, clean neck sweeping into well made forehand, ribs had good spring depth and length, loin strong and topline and tailset good. Well muscled rear end, good low hocks, a very sound mover on good legs and feet.

3<sup>rd</sup> Stuckey's Pendan Vashti.

## LIMIT BITCH (9, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Matthews' Medogold Tartini with Sonham JW ShCM. Black & white of 22 months, just preferred her head to litter sister below, both had superb outlines, good neck set into well made forequarters, excellent through the ribs, loin strong, topline, tailset and carriage good, well muscled rear end with good first and second thigh, soundest of movers on good legs and feet, made good use of tail on the move.

2<sup>nd</sup> Norbury & Adam's Medogold Bamalam at Heartbury JW ShCM. Litter sister to above, 22 months brown & white, pleasing balanced outline, again super neck set into well constructed forehand, excellent through the ribs, short loin and good topline, well set and carried tail, good muscle to rear end, good low hocks another sound mover.

3<sup>rd</sup> Tibbs' Sharnphilly Escada at Raigmore JW.

# **OPEN BITCH** (7, 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Evans & Pavey's Sh Ch Joneva Mrs Bridges JW. One I have liked and judged before, 4 year old black & white, loved her outline, kind gentle feminine head, excellent angles to front and rear, well made through the ribs, loin, topline tailset and carriage, good muscled rear end, moved out well on good legs and feet, nice sheen to coat. My Bitch CC, and Reserve BOB, in the challenge with the dog, she favoured one shoulder.

2<sup>nd</sup> Norbury & Adams' Medogold Milkshake at Heartbury JW ShCM. 3 year old black & white, sweet feminine bitch, pleasing head, very good neck set into well made forequarters, excellent ribs, loin, topline, well muscled rear end with good first and second thigh, low hocks, a sound mover on good legs and feet. Reserve Bitch CC. 3<sup>rd</sup> Stuckey's Sh Ch Medogold Coralie of Pendan JW ShCM.

## **VETERAN BITCH (2, 1)**

1<sup>st</sup> Fairbairn & Madigan's Misperros Jumanji of Carmelfair. Nine and a half year old black & white, excellent balanced outline, pleasing feminine head, neck sweeps into well made forehand, good through the ribs, short strong loin, well muscled rear, sound mover on good legs and feet. Best Veteran In Breed.

2<sup>nd</sup> Hewitt's Sunhouse As You Like It. 7 year old black & white, balanced outline, good headpiece, clean neck set into well made forequarters, excellent through the ribs, short loin, good topline, sweeping into lashing tail, well made rear quarters, moving soundly on good legs and feet, a tendency to stand a little cow hocked.

3<sup>rd</sup> Mason's Sh Ch Freebreeze As You Like It ShCM. 11 years old.
