MINOR PUPPY DOG (2)

1st Walkling's Wilchrimane Kinsphere with Kiswahili. Balanced, with everything in the right place at this age. More mature than 2 and moved well.

2nd Collins' Collholme Baltharsar. Rather overwhelmed by the occasion so not standing or moving well, but showing promise and should do well when settled.

PUPPY DOG (5,1)

1st Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked. Eye catching o/w Well worked head with thin leathers, reachy neck, good shoulder placement. Moved soundly with reach and drive. An exciting prospect. BPIS

2nd Walkling's Wilchrimane Kinsphere with Kiswahili

3rd Philo's Tenshilling Its My Party for Salmonmist

JUNIOR DOG (2,1)

1st Oliver and Stilgoe's Teisgol Love is in the Air. This boy's immaculate front, sweep of stifle and super hard condition enabled him to move so soundly. Just a bit heavy in head and eyes need to tighten.

YEARLING DOG (3)

1st Oliver and Stilgoe's Teisgol Love is in the Air

2nd Ganney's Fisherbloom Hey Diddle Diddle at Heartbury. Tall rangy B/W with good shoulder, lovely long neck and neat feet. Would prefer a darker eye.

3rd Wheldon and Earl's Caithpoint Kai

1st Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked

NOVICE DOG (4,1)

1st Oliver and Stilgoe's Teisgol Love is in the Air

2nd Osman's Fleurfield Hidden Depths. Rangy boy with nice lines, but needs to strengthen all through to give more power on the move

3rd Reynolds' Wilchrimane Cadenza for Sananelmo

GRADUATE DOG (6,2)

1st Bowen-Brooks' Tenshilling Here I Go Again. B/W with good lines and strong quarters enabling him to drive well. Rather heavy in head and proud of his tail.

2nd Booth's Lundgarth Finch. O/W with pleasing head and gentle expression. Good topline but a bit upright in shoulder.

3rd Osman's Fleurfield Hidden Depths

POST GRADUATE DOG (7, 1)

1st Blair's Twinhoe Vittorio. Eye catching typy O/W that flowed from nose to tail. Super head with really dark eyes. Masculine, but in no way coarse. Moved with reach and drive. In the challenge he moved up a gear and gained a well deserved RCC.

2nd Wilcox's Pipeaway Dreams Afyre in Merynjen JW. So unlucky to meet 1 as very similar in type. Another beautiful head, deep brisket, excellent topline. Feet need to tighten.

3rd Lowe's Lowsmoor Crazy For You

MID LIMIT DOG (3,2)

1st Tregaskis' Moenfair Sanguineum JW. L/W with dished head, long neck, deep brisket and tight feet. Just a bit proud of his tail on the move.

LIMIT DOG (9,1)

1st Welch and Hazeltine's Pytchley Chasing The Dream for Hookwood JW ShCM. B/W with pleasing profile, correct shoulder placement, strong quarters and tight feet. Out moved all the other boys in this good class.

2nd Philo's Fydal Caprio at Salmonmist JW ShCM. Tall handsome O/W in excellent condition close up to 1. Flowing lines with reachy neck and correct topline. Feet rather flat and tail carried a bit high on the move.

3rd Martin'd Sunhouse Chips Ahoy

OPEN DOG (3, 1w)

1st Hazeltine and Welch's Just Wilburt by Hookwood JW ShCM. Compact B/W presenting an excellent outline with no exaggerations, everything just flowed. In super sound condition enabling him to sweep round the ring with great reach and drive. Well deserved DCC but just lost out to two lovely bitches for top honours. BOS.

2nd Tibbs' Fydal Beeswing at Raigmore. O/W with a beautifully worked head and melting expression. Moved with grace and power and the best tail-wagger of the entry! Ran 1 Close, just missing out on width of thigh.

VETERAN DOG (3)

1st Welch's Sh Ch, Ir Sh Ch Moolou Minstrel at Hookwood JW ShCEx. Hard to believe this B/W is nearly 11. Still retains his elegance and moved with such power and enthusiasm. I see he is the sire of DCC and Limit Dog winners. His owner must be so proud of him. BVIS.

2nd Crawte's Leascliffe Luis. Nine-year-old B/W in super condition and unlucky to meet 1. Such a happy boy and a credit to his owners.

BITCHES

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4)

1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Piri Piri. An Attractive puppy with nice head and kind expression. Correct thin ears well set on. Lovely lines and good bone. A positive happy mover.

2nd Cooper's Keepersfield Giselle. Very feminine and compact. Just needs to mature and a little erratic on the move which should come with confidence.

PUPPY BITCH (11, 4a)

1st Norbury & Adams' Heartbury Northern Lights. A striking puppy with good substance and depth. Good front with ribs carried well back. Strong over loin. Nice width of thigh. Alert and athletic. Covered the ground well.

2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Candlelight. Very stylish with nice and outline. Shown in hard condition with good hindquarters and muscle tone.

JUNIOR BITCH (2, 1a)

1st Gordon's Hawkfield Black Swan. Stood alone but deserved her place. Very elegant and feminine. Pretty head and good body proportions. Nice feet and legs. Moved with verve and purpose.

YEARLING BITCH (6, 1a)

1st Crawte's Sharnphilly Spiced Ginger at Leascliffe. Compact and balanced and not overdone in any department. Good head, neck and shoulders. Nice width of thigh. Handled and presented well Sound and honest with lots to like.

2nd Harrison's Hannia Del Almojon of Millpoint (Imp ESP). Nicely constructed. Strong all through. Has substance and depth. Good muscled hind quarters. Fluent mover.

MAIDEN BITCH (7)

1st Crawte's Sharnphilly Spiced Ginger at Leascliffe.

2nd Anderson-Rowell's Raigmore Limelight at Daledancer. Pleasant head and expression, well set thin ears, Neat feminine with nice lines. Good rib cage and strong over loin. Covered the ground well.

NOVICE BITCH (3)

1st Crawte's Sharnphilly Spiced Ginger at Leascliffe.

2nd Flint's Day Lilly Dawn. Heavier type, nicely constructed with plenty of heart room and depth. Good width of thigh. Strong hindquarters. Would just like a little more animation on the move.

GRADUATE BITCH (9, 3a)

1st Drake's Fleurfield Moonflower with Clamerkin. Stylish with lots of scope. Good front top line and strong over loin. Nice turn of stifle. Alert happy mover.

2nd Anderson-Rowell's Daledancer Rita Owla (Imp Svk). Neat feminine with nice head and eye. Good muscle tone, strong hindquarters. Shown in hard condition.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (8, 4a)

1st Gordon's Hawkfield Happy. Nicely balanced with good body proportions. Has class and all the essentials. Good front head neck and shoulders. Compact and not over done. Nice tall set that she used on the move.
2nd Razzell & Hazeltine's Hookwood Blondie. Pleasant head with nice thin well-set ears. Good top line. Ribs set well back. Has type and character. Alert on the move.

MID LIMIT BITCH (4, 1a)

1st Tibbs' Raigmore Worth the Wait. Pleasing on the eye, I liked her a lot. Very feminine with pretty head and expression. Lovely flowing lines. Good feet and legs. Well coupled and balanced. Happy positive mover. Res CC / Res BIS.
2nd Preece's Harvestslade Lesedi La Roma. Pleasant head, good lay of shoulder, strong over loin. Nice character. Would just prefer better feet.

LIMIT BITCH (13, 4a)

1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Pirouette. Appealing head with nice eye and expression. Good overall construction and good bone. Nice strong hindquarters. Alert stylish mover.
2nd Hinton's Fleurfield Morning Glory. Good make and shape with lots to like. Lighter make than 1 but has all the attributes. Good muscle tone. Covered the ground well.

OPEN BITCH (6, 2a)

1st Hazeltine, Razzell, Spey, Oldfield and Lopes' Am Ch Bookstore Fabello Kinky Boots. (Imp USA). Classic head. Lovely lines. Good depth and body proportions. Teeming with confidence, well presented with lots of ring presence and enthusiasm. CC, BOB & BIS.
2nd Martin's Sh Ch Sunhouse Cheerio. Pleasant head, good neck and shoulders. Nice Width of thigh. Strong hindquarters. Attractive and outgoing. Athletic agile mover
