DOGS

Judge MR BRYN WILLIAMS

It has been nearly 12 years since I last judged the breed. I was given the task of judging Dogs. I accept that this entry was only a small example of the breed. However, I found myself to be disappointed in some of the quality of exhibits and even more disappointed in the movement of the majority of exhibits. There was also a variance in fronts, some rather wide, some narrow. I found front movement in the majority to 'Pin In'. This could be easily seen even when viewed from behind. Some lost their top line on the move; some lacked any drive from behind.

Front pasterns were a worry too. I did in some classes, find hard it difficult to place dogs, leading to just fault judging and placing on the merit of the dog standing and what came closer to the breed standard.

It is the responsibility of both judges, who in my opinion are the gate keepers and quality controllers of the breed to maintain the quality of the breed, and of course the breeders themselves to look after this beautiful breed. And to ensure that stock sold for the show ring are the best specimens. My comments are rather scant because I would rather not make any comment on the dogs that was so completely negative to their owners.

The venue was facilities were very good. I wasn't too keen on the floor covering. It did pose with tripping hazards, hence asking exhibitor be careful when moving their dogs. My thanks also go to the 2 stewards. They worked hard throughout the show and kept everything going smoothly.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (3)

Three very different puppies in type, make, shape and movement.

1st Walkling & Siddle's Wilchrimane Kinsphere with Kiswahili. Smaller of the 3, in this class, he did have better balance than 2 & 3. Knuckling over on his pasterns when standing, this is a development phase. In profile he moved a correct 1,2,3,4. which won this class.

2nd Collins' Collholme Baltharsar. Taller than winner, plainer in head. Good length of neck, deep brisket. Needs to body up and firm up.

3rd Critchley's Whipspan Waltz With Me.

PUPPY DOG (5)

1st Walkling & Siddle's Wichrimane Kinsphere with Kiswahili.

2nd Philo's Tenshilling Its My Party for Salmonmist. Balanced head, nice length of neck, brisket deep, well ribbed. Needs to settle in front movement.

3rd Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked

JUNIOR DOG (2)

1st Matthews' Sonham Black Eyed Pea. Heavier type, looks good standing, better balance of head than 2. Long neck, brisket let down, well ribbed and was stronger in hind quarters. High stepping in front movement and loose in pasterns.

2nd Astbury's Jilony Bobby Ball at Dorbury. Preferred head of winner. Nice sized dog.

YEARLING DOG (3)

1st Westron's Fowington Beware the Bear at Aurichalcum. Very nice young dog with good head type, good length of muzzle, lips fine and curved, deep stop, Good ear placement, long neck set in to well laid shoulders, brisket deep, good legs and feet. Good length of rib. Stifles turned, good tail and tail set. He did take some time to settle. He needs more experience in the ring. Unfortunately, he didn't settle on the move when in the challenge.

2nd Reynolds' Wilchrimane Cadenza for Sananselmo. Preferred the overall quality, type and movement of winner.

MAIDEN DOG (2)

1st Philo's Tenshilling Its My Party for Salmonmist 2nd Matthews' Sonham Black Eyed Pea.

NOVICE DOG (3)

1st Weaver's Dappleline Chance for Anniezu. Nice head and eye, long neck, good front. Brisket deep. Stifles turned he needs to settle in movement and some weight off him will benefit him.

2nd Philo's Tenshilling Its My Party for Salmonmist.

GRADUATE DOG (6)

1st Siddle's Wilchrimane Vivaze. Nice head and expression, good length of neck, good shoulder. He is a little too wide in front for me. Brisket let down to level of elbow, well coupled, good turn of stifle. Flowed better than 2. Another that looks good in profile moving.

2nd Bowen-Brooks' Tenshilling Here I go Again. Finer than 1. long neck set into good shoulder, deep body, stifle turned. Preferred movement of 1.

3rd Weaver's Dappleline Chance for Anniezu.

POST GRADUATE DOG (7)

1st Bowen-Brooks' Tenshilling Blowin Smoke. Won this class because he flowed better than others in this. Nice head, good reach of neck, good shoulders. Brisket let down to level of the elbow. Short coupled, stifles turned.

2nd Blair's Twinhoe Vittorio Heavier in type than 1., this made him look unbalanced. Preferred the front standing and how 1 flowed more.

3rd Wilcox's Pipeaway Dreams Afyre in Merynjen

MID LIMIT DOG (6, 2 absent, 1 withdrawn)

1st Bowen-Brooks' Tenshilling Blowin Smoke

2nd O'Neill's Tenshilling Biscuits nice head, good neck and shoulders, deep body and well ribbed.

3rd Newberry's Manchela Make My Day for Guilia

LIMIT DOG (6, 1 absent)

1st Philo's. Fydal Caprio at Salmonmist. Nice type, good head, kind eye and expression, long neck set into well placed shoulders, deep body and well coupled. Stifles turned positive hind movement. RCC 2nd Walkling's Wilchrimane Tambuti with Kiswahili. Preferred the head and following lines of 1. 3rd Welch's Pytchley Chasing The Dream for Hookwood.

Balanced head, kind expression. Long neck set into well laid shoulders, good legs and feet. Deep brisket, short coupled. Stifles turned, hock low set, good tail. He was the best moving dog today. When challenging for B.O.B my co judge and I could not agree. We both respectfully agreed to call on Mrs Cherry the referee. Her decision was B.O.B (B.I.S) to the dog. Very well handled by his young handler.

2nd Martin's Sunhouse Chips Ahoy. Just preferred the overall make and shape of winner. 3rd O'Neill's Sh Ch Tenshilling Home Alone

VETERAN DOG (5, 2 absent)

1st Crawte's Leascliff Luis. 9 ½ years old, has kept his flowing lines and shape, moved well 2nd Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Sh Ch Freebreeze Over The Top at Spinray. I really liked this dog for quality and type. Just lacked muscular condition today.
