## MINOR PUPPY DOG (4, 1A)

1<sup>st</sup> SIDDLE'S WILCHRIMANE SEA SALT NAF. O/W of good overall balance and clean in outline, quite mature for his age with plenty of bone. His head has skull to muzzle proportions, gentle expression and well set ears. Clean neck leading into good lay of shoulder and return of upper arm, deep chest, well ribbed back. Well made hindquarters with good width of second thigh. He moved with good action and was most together today to win this class and BPIB.

2<sup>nd</sup> GORDON'S HAWKFIELD CALL MY BLUFF. Solid orange who is very raw at the moment, taller than winner and finer in bone, and his head needs to develop, he is typical outline and needs time to develop into his frame, but he has plenty of time on his side. On the move he was a little untidy in front but I caught glimpses of pleasing movement which won him his place.

3<sup>rd</sup> MENNEN & SWEENEY'S LUNDGARTH WILD YARROW

#### **PUPPY DOG** (3, 1A)

1<sup>st</sup> MARSH'S LITHESPIRIT HOPE AND GLORY FOR RATCHDA. L/W mature up to size youngster, he is of lovely make and shape, pleasing head of correct proportions, correct eye shape and well placed ears. Straight forelegs with correct amount of oval bone and well laid back shoulder, deep enough for age, excellent muscled rear, good length of stride on the move with lashing tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> WALKLING & SIDDLE'S WILCHRIMANE KINSPHERE WITH KISWAHILI TAF. O/W who is handled and presented well, pleasing overall balance, he has a pleasing head, good angulation fore and aft, good tail set and carriage, preferred the front movement of winner.

## JUNIOR DOG (5)

1<sup>st</sup> MARTIN'S SUNHOUSE BANGED TO RIGHTS. Medium size B/W youngster who really caught my eye in this class, he is totally balanced in outline. Lovely well proportioned head with chiselling around the eyes and super expression. Balanced forequarters with good depth of chest, excellent body proportions, muscled hindquarters with good length and width of thigh. Presented in fabulous condition and moved well once settled, with sound ground covering movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> GUY & TUTHILL'S CUMBRIAN NIGHT KING AT CAROFEL (IMP USA). Another quality B/W youngster, longer cast than winner, masculine balance head with pleasing expression, big open nose, balanced forequarters, strong oval bone, correct topline and correct tailset, good width to muscled hindquarters, Super profile movement.

# YEARLING DOG (3)

1<sup>st</sup> WILSON'S MILLPOINT SHOW ME THE WAY TO DJANKAY. O/W young dog who is nicely balanced and typical in outline, lovely head of correct proportion and soft expression, clean well arched neck, good bone and tight feet, very good body proportions, good topline, well muscled quarters used to advantage on the move. Just tended to carry his tail high.

2<sup>nd</sup> WEAVER'S DAPPELINE CHANCE FOR ANNIEZU. Another O/W with lots to like about him, pleasant head dark eye, good ear set and lovely expression, good neck and forequarters, strong oval bone, presented well, just preferred the head and movement of winner.

3rd ASTBURY'S JILONY BOBBY BALL AT DORBURY.

# **NOVICE DOG** (2)

1<sup>st</sup> BOOTH'S LUNDGARTH FINCH. O/w dog with masculine head and good shape dark eye, long clean neck, good forequarters, deep chest and well sprung ribs. Good body proportions, needs to settle on the move. 2<sup>nd</sup> ASTBURY'S JILONY BOBBY BALL AT DORBURY. B/W dog who has good overall balance with masculine head and good expression, deep chest and maturing nicely for his young age, another one who needs to settle on the move.

#### **GRADUATE DOG** (6, 1A)

1<sup>st</sup> MARTIN'S SUNHOUSE YOU'RE NICKED. O/W dog of good size, make and shape, he is balanced in outline, really liked his head and expression, slightly arched neck leading into well laid shoulder with equal length of upper arm. Flowing topline, correct tailset, strong well angled hindquarters. On the move he has excellent reach and drive, with a super side gait. Noticed he is litter brother to my Junior winner, shortlisted in my final 4 for top honours.

2<sup>nd</sup> GORDON'S HAWKFIELD PEMBERLEY. B/W and another quality youngster with a super classic outline, masculine head which you have to examine closely to appreciate the correctness, kind expression, and slight dish appearance when viewed in profile. Long arched neck into correct shoulders, well developed forequarters, brisket well let down with good spring of rib, strong rear quarters moved with drive, I just preferred the front movement of winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> SIDDLE & SIDDLE'S WILCHRIMANE VIVAZE.

#### **POST GRADUATE DOG (3)**

1st NORBURY, GANNEY & ADAMS' FISHERBLOOM HEY DIDDLE DIDDLE AT HEARTBURY TAF. Impressive B/W dog who is of excellent make and shape, he has a pleasing well proportioned head with dark correct shaped eye and kind expression. Strong arched neck into well laid shoulders, straight forelegs with good oval bone, slightly sloping pasterns and correct feet, Good angulation fore and aft, good body proportions, well muscled hindquarters, really strode out well lashing his tail as he went. Pushed hard for top honours. 2nd LOWE'S LOWSMOOR CRAZY FOR YOU JW. O/W mature sound honest dog, clean outline, pleasing head, kind expression and good pigmentation, strong muscular neck, deep brisket and well sprung ribs, strong loin, strong bone and good feet, well muscled hindquarters, moved out well. 3rd COOPER & PEARSON'S KEEPERSFIELD CHEVALIER.

# **LIMIT DOG** (6, 2A)

1<sup>st</sup> BLAIR'S TWINHOE VITTORIO. Really liked this O/W young dog he is totally balanced throughout with flowing lines. Super head of correct proportions, dark eye with the best of expressions, correct ear set, lovely arched neck into well laid shoulders and correct return of upper arm. Well developed body proportions with strong hindquarters. His handler moves him on a gentle stride which displays his excellent reach and drive, superb head carriage and lashing tail displaying his confident outgoing temperament. I was pleased to award him the CC his second I believe.

2<sup>nd</sup> SAUNDERS' PHLYNNIES PRINCE OF THIEVES JW. B/W mature dog built on a larger frame than winner, pleasing head and expression, clean neck and shoulders, short coupled with a strong loin and good spring of rib. Used his tail on the move where he displayed a smooth easy action with some drive from the rear. 3<sup>rd</sup> GORDON & HOWARTH'S HAWKFIELD JOLLY.

## **OPEN DOG (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> PHILO'S FYDAL CAPRIO AT SALMONMIST JW SHCM. Lovely mature O/W, pleasing head and expression, strong arched neck into good forequarters, straight forelegs with good oval bone and good feet. Excellent muscle tone throughout and presented in fabulous condition. He is just a little longer in loin, very well made hindquarters. He is very true on the move and covers the ground with plenty of reach and drive. 2<sup>nd</sup> ADAMS' MILLPOINT SIMPLY SMASHING JW SHCM. B/W dog who is presented in outstanding muscle tone and condition, he has a balanced outline, pleasing head, strong neck into well laid shoulders, good forequarters, and depth of chest. Correct oval bone on well arched feet. Good width of thigh and well developed 2<sup>nd</sup> thigh, moved sound and steady.

# **FIELD TRIAL DOG OR BITCH (1)**

1<sup>st</sup> ANDERSON-ROWELL'S LITTLE OWL SCANDIACA FOR DALEDANCER (IMP SLO). 7 year old B/W bitch built on finer lines, she was in super condition and muscle tone she certainly belies her age, very feminine head, dark eye with kind expression, ears set fairly high. Straight forelegs, slightly sloping pasterns and tidy oval feet, moved well.

# **SPECIAL WORKING GUNDOG DOG/BITCH (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> MARSH'S CH RATCHDA'S ROCK THRUSH SGWC. 6 year old fully mature L/W what a well made dog this is; he is definitely fit for function. Typical in outline, balanced quarters fore and aft, pleasing head and expression, well boned, neat feet, straight forelegs, deep in brisket. Excellent muscle tone throughout, Moved with plenty of reach and drive RCC.

2<sup>nd</sup> WESTRON'S FOWINGTON BEWARE THE BEAR AT AURICHALCUM. 2 year old O/W male who is typical of the breed and so well balanced throughout, lovely head of correct proportions, dark eye and soft expression. Strong arched neck, correct topline, strong loin and well muscled hindquarters with well developed 2<sup>nd</sup> thigh. He was just not as positive on the move as winner.

3<sup>rd</sup> ANDERSON-ROWELL'S DALEDANCER RITA OWLA SGWC.

#### **VETERAN BITCH (6, 1A)**

1<sup>st</sup> LOWE'S LOWSMOOR SHIRALEE JW. Two lovely bitches here my winner was a 7 year O/W bitch she has a beautiful feminine head with lovely kind eye. She is so balanced in outline, clean arched neck and good shoulder lay, well sprung ribs and strong loin. Super muscle tone throughout. On the move she is very sound and true and used her tail well.

2<sup>nd</sup> VAUGHN'S TEISGOL I AM WHAT I AM AT PHYLYNNIES SHCM. 8 year old B/W bitch and one I have always liked, lovely feminine head with a kind expression, super balanced forequarters, good oval bone, sloping pasterns and neat feet, strong topline well muscled hindquarters, well set tail, carried correctly. Moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> DUNN'S MEADOWPOINT SPIRIT OF LOVE JW SHCM.

# **MINOR PUPPY BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> RAYNER, SPINKS AND PRINGLE'S SPINRAY SONGBIRD. 2 very different bitches stood here, my winner was an 8 month old B/W puppy, very feminine throughout with graceful curves, so clean in outline, lovely head of correct proportions with kind alert expression, slightly arched and muscular neck into well placed shoulders, super topline and tailset, maturing nicely for her age, well muscled hindquarters with developed 2<sup>nd</sup> thigh. Moved confidently and very sound using her tail. Shortlisted to the last 4 for consideration. BPB 2<sup>nd</sup> DUNN MS J MILLPOINT HEART AND SOUL. B/W baby who was very uncertain of her surroundings, lovely head, dark eye, lovely make and shape and well off for bone and substance, she is carrying some puppy fat which reflected in her movement, overall a very nice puppy and once she gains her confidence I am sure she will put on a better performance.

# **PUPPY BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> BANNISTER'S WILCHRIMANE TRINKET AT JANERYL NAF. Again 2 very different types here at different stages of development, my winner was O/W and is very outgoing, confident and well schooled, Elegant and clean in outline, lovely head, dark eye, defined stop and good ear set. firm in topline, good oval bone, needs to drop in brisket but plenty of time on her side.

2<sup>nd</sup> WILKINSON'S STOCKSFELL SHOWDOWN. Lovely O/W who is so beautifully put together everything just flows through. Clean in outline, good head, arched neck, leading into excellent forequarters, straight forelegs, neat feet with sloping pasterns. Good angulation fore and aft and was presented in super condition. She is further on in development than winner but unfortunately she was just not performing her best today and was very unhappy on the move and did not get her tail up as something had spooked her at the side of the ring.

## **JUNIOR BITCH (9, 1A)**

1st THIRLWELL & MALIK'S SHARNPHILLY SANTA ROSA. This was a lovely class with some very promising youngsters, my winner was a O/W bitch who is so sound and exudes quality and breed type just loved everything about her. She has a typical outline and is sound in construction. Most feminine of heads, with a kind and gentle expression. Her strong clean neck flowing seamlessly into a firm and well held topline and displaying a correct tail set. Excellent body proportions and is well muscled yet retains her femininity. She has a super outgoing temperament. Her movement is eye catching and so correct, with excellent reach and drive. She must have an exciting future ahead. Could not deny her the CC her 1st, BOB, and pleased to watch her win RBIS.

2<sup>nd</sup> MARTIN & WATKINS' SUNHOUSE PARTNES IN CRIME. Super B/W feminine youngster who is litter sister to my Junior and Graduate dog winners. Lovely balanced outline, a little longer cast than winner, feminine head and soft expression, defined stop, ears set high, muscular and slightly arched neck leading into well placed shoulders. Strong topline and well muscled hindquarters with developed second thigh. On the move she has excellent reach and drive another one who must have an exciting future.

3<sup>rd</sup> NORBURY & ADAMS' HEARTBURY NORTHERN LIGHTS.

#### **YEARLING BITCH (2, 1A)**

1<sup>st</sup> MASON'S DONDAIG LOVE ME TENDER AT NOSAM. B/W pretty feminine bitch of lovely type, a little finer all through, clean elegant outline, a little long in loin, pretty head and soft expression, good angulation fore and aft, well muscled hindquarters, good tail carriage and tail used well on the move, just tended to lift her front.

# **NOVICE BITCH (5, 1A)**

1<sup>st</sup> NORBURY & ADAMS' HEARTBURY BELACQUA. L/W feminine young lady with typical outline and full of breed characteristics, lovely feminine head and kind and alert expression, arched neck leading to long sloping shoulder blades, correct upper arm, good ribs, nice flow over loin & muscular hindquarters, good length to thigh, hocks well let down, moved out well with easy stride.

2<sup>nd</sup> COOPER & PEARSON'S KEEPERSFIELD GISELLE. B/W of ideal size slightly heavier build than winner, good bone and feet, lovely head and soft expression, presented in excellent condition, balanced quarters fore and aft. Moved soundly with reach and drive.

3<sup>rd</sup> MASON'S DONDAIG LOVE ME TENDER AT NOSAM.

## **GRADUATE BITCH (9)**

1<sup>st</sup> RADCLIFFE'S SNIPERAY EDGE OF GLORY. Pleasing O/W with clean balanced outline, lovely head of correct proportions and chiselling, good length of muscled arched neck, excellent forequarters, with good oval bone and neat feet. Good body proportions, well ribbed back, super topline and tailset, well muscled hindquarters. Best mover in the class with plenty of reach and drive.

2<sup>nd</sup> LOWE'S LOWSMOOR HALF A SIXPENCE JW. Lemon/W feminine bitch of lovely make and shape, pleasant head with defined stop and soft gentle expression, good pigmentation, elegant arched neck leading into well placed shoulders, good topline and tailset, deep chest and well ribbed back. Moved well. 3<sup>rd</sup> BOOTH'S SHARNPHILLY GINGER FIZZ AT LUNDGARTH

## **POST GRADUATE BITCH (6)**

1<sup>st</sup> BLOWERS' FOWINGTON LAR TI DAR AT DEADWAY. O/W feminine young lady of good breed type, she has a balanced outline with a series of curves and flows all through. lovely head, dark eye and gentle expression, good bone and feet, depth of brisket. Extremely well muscled and strongly built but retains her femininity, very sound on the move using her tail at all times.

2<sup>nd</sup> HINTON'S FLEURFIELD TRULY A SECRET JW. L/W feminine bitch built on finer lines, balanced outline good head with lovely dark eye and soft expression, well defined stop, clean long arched neck into well laid back shoulders, well muscled deep body with well sprung ribs. Moved out well with good ground coverage and plenty of reach and drive.

3<sup>rd</sup> MATTHEWS' SONHAM CHASING RAINBOWS.

## LIMIT BITCH (9, 1A)

1<sup>st</sup> ROSE (Handling for Mr M M Gomez) MADISON (ATC AY46294ESP). B/W appealing feminine bitch, clean balanced outline that flows all through, she is well constructed without being exaggerated. Lovely feminine head of correct proportions, gentle kind expression, good depth of chest and correct heartroom, well ribbed, strong topline and muscular quarters. Her handler moved her a little fast to begin with, but once she got into a steady pace she had excellent reach and drive, lashing her tail at all times. She pulled out all the stops in the challenge and I was delighted to award her Res CC and Res BOB.

2<sup>nd</sup> LAKES' WILD THYME. L/W mature bitch of good overall quality, good head and expression, muscular and slightly arched neck, well placed shoulders and corresponding return of upper arm. Short coupled, muscular hindquarters, hocks well let down. Smooth movement covering plenty of ground with driving hind action, which won her this place.
