Thank you for the invitation to judge Pointers at this famous Championship Show.

A few points to watch. Head types and shapes are now numerous, but variations do not necessarily mean correct. Down-sloping foreface and wide flat sloped off back skulls are worrying trends. Breeders should always be aiming to breed the classic pointer head and expression according to the UK KC Breed Standard.

Tails and tail carriage really need to be watched. There are far too many long, badly shaped tails and often carried too high. There is nothing worse than a high tail on a Pointer as it ruins the whole look.
