Excellent head and expression. strong neck into well laid back shoulders, good depth of rib, slightly sloping topline, good bone and strong quarters finished off with well set on tail.

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Wilchrimane Seasalt. Mature boy, well grown, best of heads, strong neck into well laid back shoulders, excellent depth, good boned legs and slight slope to pasterns, powerful quarters, powered round the ring. Best PD.

 $2^{nd}$  Gordon's Hawkfleld Call My Bluff. Orange. Most attractive dog, looked a picture standing and moved out with style keeping his topline and using his tail. Gorgeous head with keen eye.

## **JUNIOR DOG** (13, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Philo's Tenshilling It's My Party for Salmonmist JW. O/W. Took my eye in this quality class. Best of heads, well arched neck and strong shoulders, well boned. Good depth of chest, good short loin, well turned stifle, moved soundly.

2<sup>nd</sup> Martin's Sunhouse Banged To Rights. B/W. Lovely boy, short coupled and nice size, not overdone, looked a picture stacked, ribs well let down. well muscled quarters, hocks well let down. Full of himself on the move.

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle's Rey Alegrias Thobi at Wilchrimane. B/W. Dished face, well chiselled, long neck and deep forechest, short compact body, well muscled rear, moved soundly. Hocks well let down.

2<sup>nd</sup> Guy & Tuthill's Cumbrian Night King at Carofel (Imp USA). B/W. Such an elegant heavily marked boy, long neck, shoulders well laid back, short in loin. Bee sting tail. moved steadily. 3<sup>rd</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Pemberley.

#### **POST GRADUATE DOG** (13, 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Wheldon & Earl's Caithpoint Kai. B/W. Heavily marked, in top form, appealing head, best of shoulders and compact body, well muscled rear and tail well set on, move soundly. Presented a lovely picture on the stack, spanking condition.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stoke's Moenfair Dances The Moon into Guanabara JW. B/W. Close up, splitting hairs between these two. Typical head, nice eye and expression, strong neck and good depth of chest, good slope to pastern, another sound boy in tip top condition.

3<sup>rd</sup> Barker's Ragus Let's Get Moving at Flinthill.

#### MID LIMIT DOG (10)

1<sup>st</sup> Adams & Scales' Fisherbloom Re'encountered JW. B/W. Smart boy. Classic head, nothing overdone, good neck and shoulder placement, compact body, well muscled, good depth of rib, moved well driving from his rear.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bond's Joneva Just My Style. B/W. Flashy dog. loved his head, best of shoulders and depth of ribs, good short loin and well set on tail, moved soundly for his owner.
