DOGS.

Many thanks to the committee and membership for the invitation to judge males at the 61st Pointer Club Championship Show. I'm sure every breed specialist cherishes the opportunity to judge at their breed show. My thanks to the exhibitors, stewards and committee for a very enjoyable day. On the day the weather was perfect dog showing weather which enabled us to make good use of the large grass rings.

Unfortunately, there was loud music blaring out from one of the other events at the showground which some dogs had trouble coping with. I was very pleased with the overall quality of the entry although I did find some bad mouths sadly which had to pay the price.

VETERAN DOG (7, 1)

1st Wall's Meadowpoint Spirit of Fire. A lovely class to start the day with. There is no getting away from the power, fitness, and honesty of this boy. Balanced head with good length of foreface, strong crested neck leading to firm topline. Good bone and well shaped feet. Nicely ribbed back and deep through. Moved out well with assured, powerful stride topped off with wagging tail. Best male veteran but just pipped to the post at the end of the day for Best Veteran in Show by the bitch who was on her A game.

2nd Tibbs' Fydal Beeswing at Raigmore. A boy of similar age and again carrying his years lightly. Love the 'pointeriness' of this boy with his classic head and neat ears leading to a compact, fit body. Good firm topline and balanced angles. Well ribbed back and nicely busy on the move.

3rd O'Neill's Sh Ch Tenshilling Home Alone JW ShCM.

MINOR PUPPY DOG (4, 0)

1st Anthony's Jilony Luther. Gorgeous little baby of such quality. Loved his clean cut, flowing lines. Sweet head leading into long neck and on into balanced angles. Good, well shaped bone. Obviously immature at this age but lots to like and look forward to. So light and happy on the move. Lovely waggy tail which was appreciated. Will watch his career with interest.

2nd Hawkes and Robinson's Codnorhawk Brucie Bonus. A very different type to 1. Six month baby who is very raw and needs to settle into his angles. Well boned although pasterns need to tighten. Very much at the start of his career, it will be interesting to see how he develops when he learns to focus and cooperate with his handler.

3rd Welch's Hookwood Starman.

PUPPY DOG (6,1)

1st Sarrou and Hall's Gartarry New Kid in Town. 9month quality o/w boy. Super head with deep stop, neat ears and well shaped muzzle. Expressive eyes and pronounced occiput. Nice length of clean neck into good shoulder. Good quality oval bone with resilient, slightly sloping pasterns. Shapely topline and enough depth for age. Well set on tail and good quarters. Moved out well. Best Puppy Dog and delighted, on referee's decision, to see him awarded Best Puppy in Show.

2nd Westaway's Teisgol Keep on Going. 9 month lem/w. Very nice puppy with balance all through from his head to his tail. Similar comments apply as to 1st. Super head with plenty of work, deep stop and lovely length of foreface. Nicely shaped topline, well ribbed back with nice depth. Well boned puppy in lovely condition. Unfortunately, one that was disturbed by the other events music so didn't give his best.

3rd Stilgoe's Glenariff Mojito over Teisgol.

JUNIOR DOG. (7, 0)

1st Preece and Gilding's Harvestslade Light Of Peace. 12 month o/w boy with a clean cut classic head with deep stop and nice flews. Dark, kind eye. Clean neck leading into super front with good return of upper arm. Great depth to chest with well boned front legs and sloping pasterns. Shapely topline leading into matching angled hind quarters. Good width of stifle and second thigh. Well muscled and fit allowing him to move well on a good length of stride.

2nd Marsh's Lithespirit Hope And Glory for Ratchda. 15 month liv/w dog with a lovely head just right for his age. Clean, long neck into good front and well boned. Enough depth for age and sweeping stifles into low set hocks. Nice shape to his tail. Found his croup to be a tad steep but saying that he moved well and was in great condition.

3rd License's Tequesta Buster Keaton.

YEARLING DOG (3, 1)

1st Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked. 19 month o/w who oozes quality. Super shaped masculine head with well set and shaped ears. Deep stop and well developed flews. Super pigment and kind expression. Lovely long cresty clean neck leading into good front assembly built on well shaped bone, sloping pasterns and neat feet. Good depth to brisket, well ribbed, carried well back, strong loin into shapely quarters and well shaped tail. Powerful, ground covering mover who showed me enough today to win the class despite giving his handler a hard time. Once he settles he will trouble the best.

2nd Philo's Tenshilling It's My Party for Salmonmist JW. 18 month old o/w boy just out of junior with plenty to like. Clean cut dog with nice flowing lines. Masculine head with good turn of lip and deep stop, kind expression. Cresty neck into decent front assembly. Well boned with sloping pasterns. Good depth and well ribbed back. Shapely quarters with good width of stifle and low set hocks. In super condition just preferred the feet and tail carriage of 1.

MAIDEN DOG (4, 0)

1st Ram's Jilony Brown Velvet. 17 month old liv/w of good stamp. Good head with correct length of foreface, would prefer slightly more turn of lip. Clean, long neck leading into decent front. Good oval bone with slight sloping pasterns. Enough depth for age and well ribbed back. Firm topline with powerful, well muscled hindquarters. Would prefer a shorter tail but used well on the move with his ground covering action.

2nd Elrington's Tequesta Harold Lloyd. 15 month b/w boy. More compact with modest but balanced angles. Nicely balanced head with good stop and foreface with well developed lip. Nicely set and shaped ears, clean neck into well boned front with resilient pasterns. Nice bend to stifles with low set hocks. Would like to see him relax into his topline and cover more ground.

3rd Anthony's Jilony Luther.

NOVICE DOG (6, 0)

1st Westaway's Teisgol Keep On Going. Second in Puppy dog class. He was far more relaxed in this class to show me his good ground covering movement.

2nd Ram's Jilony Brown Velvet.

3rd Stilgoe's Glenariff Mojito over Teisgol.

DEBUTANT DOG (2, 1)

1st Stilgoe's Glenariff Mojito over Teisgol. 9 month b/w boy. Neat dog who was unlucky to meet others in previous classes. Sweet head with kind expression. Tidy dog all through with good balanced angles, good depth and stifle. He moved well although I would love to see him enjoying himself more with more animation.

GRADUATE DOG (4, 1)

1st Guy and Tuthill's Cumbrian Knight King at Carofel (Imp USA.) Smart blanket black 22 months of age. Quality stamp in great condition. Balanced head who scores in length of foreface and well developed flews. Nice deep stop, kind dark eyes. Clean cresty neck into well angulated front with good length of upper arm. Good bone and pasterns. Shapely topline, good depth to brisket, ribs carried well back into strong loin. Well shaped quarters with good bend of stifle. Neat well used tail. Moved out well, coping well with a new runner. His muscle tone and condition are a credit to his owner.

2nd Martin's Sunhouse Banged to Rights. Another nice dog from this kennel. B/W 19 months old. Nicely made all through. Balanced head with deep stop and well developed foreface. Neat ears. Lengthy clean strong neck leading into good front with nice return of upper arm. Well boned with slightly sloping pasterns and well cushioned feet. Shapely, strong topline, nice arch over loin. Good depth of brisket. Nice underline with ribs carried well back. Flows into his quarters with nice turn of stifle. Neat, well shaped tail. Needs to learn to relax and balance himself on the move to see the best of him.

3rd Booth's Lundgarth Teal.

POST GRADUATE DOG (9, 1)

1st. Wheldon and Earl's Caithpoint Kai. 2.5 year old b/w in excellent order, brimming with fitness from this kennel. Another nice class where I was splitting hairs. This boy is a nice stamp and well made all through. Attractive male head with expressive eyes. Quality bone, resilient pasterns and well knitted feet. Good depth with heartroom. Well ribbed back with firm shapely topline and underline. Well shaped quarters with well set on tail. Moved with effortless style, his best is yet to come. Smart dog.

2nd Weaver's Dappleline Chance for Anniezu. 2 year old o/w. Unlucky to meet 1 today who just out moved him although it was a close decision. Handsome, masculine head which scores in stop, foreface and muzzle. Well shaped skull with pronounced occiput bone. Clean, long neck into well angulated front. Good bone, pasterns and feet. Nice shape to firm topline and underline. Sweeping stifles with low set hocks and neat tail. He was on his best behaviour today portraying smooth, ground covering action. Coming to his best.

3rd O'Neill and Timothy's Tenshilling I Got the Fever.

MID LIMIT DOG (2, 0)

1st Saunders' Phlynnies Prince of Thieves JW. 5 year old b/w. Nice headed dog with good stop and correct length of foreface and good turn of lip. Good length of clean neck, balanced angles fore and aft with deep body with ribs carried well back. A dog who is best seen on the move as he tends to relax and shows himself to advantage.

2nd Sarrou and Hall's Fowington's Sir Dancealot into Gartarry. 2 year old o/w. Nice type of dog who would benefit from carrying more weight. Pleasing head and expression, neat well set on ears. Long neck leading to balanced matching angles fore and aft. Ribs carried well back leading to well muscled quarters and neat tail. A little proud of his tail on the move today and moved a tad close behind.

LIMIT DOG (9, 1)

My class of the day. What a headache in a good way.

1st Preece and Gilding's Harvestslade Cullinan. 4 year old o/w dog who had to bring his A game to top this class and that he did. While stood he is a no-nonsense honest Pointer, plenty of quality with nothing overdone. Well balanced head with good stop and good length of foreface. Kind expressive eyes, neat well set ears of good shape. Clean long cresty neck. Good front with nice return of upper arm allowing his well boned front to sit nicely under him. Nice long resilient pasterns and well knitted feet. Firm well shaped topline, good depth and ribbing into shapely hindquarters with low set hocks. Neat well shaped tail. He out moved all in this today with style and ground covering effortless action that could have gone on all day. Nice wagging tail topped off the picture. Pleased to award him the reserve CC in good company.

2nd Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Obi at Stargang. I love this neat compact 5 year old o/w dog. From his gorgeous well moulded head, with great pigment and expressive warm eyes through his long neck, super front, firm topline, shapely underline, deep brisket and well ribbed back body, good bone, shapely well turned stifles to his neat tail. Unfortunately, not quite putting it all in today. Truly splitting hairs in this very hot class.

3rd Jamieson, McCara and Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Peri Peri with Glenfinnan.

OPEN DOG (1, 0)

1st Oddie's Sh Sh Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW. 3 year old b/w male who I awarded the reserve CC to from junior last time I judged, he is now at full maturity. He scores in true balance, quality and type. Nicely shaped balanced masculine head with kind dark eyes presenting a melting expression. Neat well shaped thin leathers well set on. Long cresty neck into super front with good length of upper arm. Good oval bone with resilient pasterns and well knitted and shaped feet. Excellent depth and heartroom. Well ribbed back into nice shot strong loin. Firm topline into neat, well set on and shaped tail. Hindquarters score in width and turn of stifle and second thigh. All in all, a handy sized quality Pointer who moves with power and precision topped off with a wagging tail giving an impression of verve and interest. Delighted to award him the CC and on referee's decision Best Opposite Sex in Show and Reserve Best in Show.

SPECIAL WORKING GUNDOG DOG (2, 1)

1st Marsh's Ch Ratchda's Rock Thrush SGWC. 6 year old liv/w male of good make and shape. Classic head with good stop and length of foreface. Well developed muzzle. Good clean neck into well angulated front. Well boned, long, slightly sloping pasterns into well knitted feet of good shape. Strong topline. Nice depth and heartroom. Neat well shaped tail. Well turned stifles of good width providing strong quarters to drive from. Nice smooth mover covering plenty of ground with an active tail. In good fit condition. A worthy champion.

FIELD TRIAL DOG No entries.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (4, 1, 1 w/d)

1st Booth's Lundgarth Finch. 4 year old o/w who is a nice type although somewhat 'shelly'. Decent head with good foreface and neat well shaped ears. Front angulation a tad straighter than his rear angulation which becomes apparent on the move when he lifts his front to get out of the way of his hind action. In good fit condition.

2nd Astbury's Jilony Bobby Ball at Dorbury. 17 month b/w boy who is a nice shape on the stack. Good masculine head leading into long neck and powerful balanced forequarters. Well boned with deep body, firm topline and shapely underline. Good width and bend of stifle. Not particularly happy today and on the move he appeared to fall apart somewhat unfortunately.

VETERAN BITCH (13, 3)

1st Welch's Ir Sh Ch Oxfordacres Trinity by Hookwood JW ShCM - 8 ½ year old, B/W. Shown in excellent condition. Balanced head, with deep flews, dark eyes, soft expression. Lengthy neck, into well laid shoulders, good return of upper arm, elbows neat to brisket. Ribs carried well back. Strong quarters, good amount of first and second thigh. Moved with drive, lashing tail as she went. BVIS.

2nd Lowe's Lowsmoor Shiralee JW - 7 1/2 years, orange and white bitch. In very good condition, balanced head, good amount of lip, dark eyes giving soft expression. Clean throat, lengthy neck into good shoulders. Ribs carried well back, shorter cast than winner. Strong quarters and thighs. Short tail, moved out well.

3rd Vaughan's Teisgol I Am What I Am at Phlynnies ShCM – 8 years, black and white. Balanced head, dark eye, soft expression. Good length of neck, into well placed shoulders. Well sprung ribs, carried well back. Strong quarters, good thighs. Moved out nicely, using tail well.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (4, 0)

1st Milford's Haramander Stop N Stare - 7 ½ months, orange and white bitch. Very much a Pointer. Balanced classic head, Good pronounced occiput, ears well set on her head. Dark eye and nose pigment, giving a lovely soft expression. Clean lengthy neck, into her shoulders. Ribs carried well back, strong loin. Good amount of quarters and thigh, moved out well whilst lashing her tail. BPB.

2nd Dodd's Raigmore She's The One for Lycarda – 6 months, black and white, smaller type than 1st. Dark eye, ears well set. Long neck, sufficient heart room. Oval bone, correct shaped feet. Shorter through ribs, strong loin, with slight rise. Good strong quarters and thighs. Moved out well.

3rd Perren & Welch's Evaluna Chasing Rainbows with Hookwood. 8 months, black/white. Strongly built, balanced head, lighter eye. Good straight front, clean neck, into well placed shoulders. Correct return of upper arm. Brisket well let down. Ribs carried back nicely. Movement could be a little smoother.

PUPPY BITCH (7, 0)

1st Booth's Lundgarth Everest - 9 months, orange and white. Such a pretty girl, balanced head, with dark and nose pigment, soft, kind depression. Pronounced occiput. Thin leathers, with slightly pointed tips. Muscular neck, well laid shoulders. Correct oval bone, well sprung ribs, carried well back. Nice strong quarters, good expanse of first and second thigh. Moved out well, pushed MP hard in challenge for BPB.

2nd Stilgoe & Fox's Teisgol Snow Queen - 9 months orange and white. Balanced head, dark pigment, giving soft expression. Long neck, well placed shoulders, Good oval bone, arched toes. Ribs carried well back, strong loin, quarters and thighs. Moved out well, lashing her short tail.

3rd Oddie's Sharnphilly Queens Gambit or Riowood – 11 months, orange and white. Balanced head, good occiput, leathers fine, set on fairly high. Lengthy neck. Good chest, straight front. Ribs well sprung. Not as strong over quarters as the first 2. Moved out positively.

JUNIOR BITCH (12, 1)

1st Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's - Spinray Songbird - 14 months, black and white. Balanced head, with pronounced occiput. Good amount of lip. Good eye colour. Good amount of heart room, straight front, good oval bone. Clean neck into well laid shoulders, good return of upper arm, brisket well let down. Feet nicely arched. Ribs well sprung, carried well back, loin slightly arched. Strong quarters, allowing her to move on well.

2nd Collins' Collholme Angelique - 16 months orange and white. Pretty girl with balanced head. Dark pigment, soft expression. Clean, lengthy neck, good forechest. Lovely oval bone, sloping pastern and arched toes. Ribs carried well back, strong loin and quarters. Good amount of first and second thigh. Moved out well.

3rd Anthony's Jilony Beautiful Dream - 6 months, black and white. Another quality bitch from this long established kennel. Balanced head, ears set fairly high. Kind expression, good amount of lip. Lengthy, clean neck into well laid shoulders. Correct oval bone, gently sloping pastern. Ribs carried well back. Strong quarters, good amount of first and second thigh. Moved out nicely.

YEARLING BITCH (6,0)

1st Webb's Tenshilling The Wanderer – 18 months, orange and white. Balanced head, kind, soft expression, good developed soft lip. Clean, lengthy neck into well laid shoulders. Brisket well let down to elbow. Correct oval bone, gently sloping pastern, toes arched, well knit. Ribs carried well back, strong loin and quarters. Moved out positively.

2nd Anderson-Rowell's Raigmore Limelight at Daledancer - 18 months, orange and white. Balanced head, good soft lip, ears set fairly high, pronounced occiput, clean lengthy neck, into well placed shoulders. Good oval bone, well knitted feet. Well ribbed, strong loin and quarters. Moved out positively.

3rd Martin's Sunhouse Partners In Crime - 18 months, black and white. Good balanced head, Soft, well developed lip. Dark pigment, soft expression. Lengthy, clean neck, well placed shoulders and return of upper arm. Ribs carried well back, strong loin and quarters. Good amount of first and second thigh. Good oval bone, toes arched. Moved well. Another, typical of this kennel.

MAIDEN BITCH (4, 0)

1st Martin's Sunhouse No Comment - 18 months, orange and white. Good head, ears set fairly high. Soft lip. Long neck into well laid shoulders, good amount of heart room. Well ribbed, carried back. Strong over loin, good strong quarters, with a good amount of first and second thigh. Moved out well.

2nd Bush's Piasharn Demelza - 10 months, liver and white, beautiful head, good dark pigment, dark eye. Well set ears, Lengthy neck, well placed shoulders. Ribs carried well back, good in length. Strong quarters, tail a little long, moved out positively.

3rd Robson's Bradgate Until Dusk - 5 years, black and white. Pretty lady, bright eye, good occiput. Good oval bone, short in rib, moved out happily.

NOVICE BITCH (7,0)

1st Stilgoe & Fox's Teisgol Snow Queen - repeat entry.

2nd Bush's Piasharn Demelza - repeat entry.

3rd Robson's Codnorhawk Dinky Stta - 2 years, black and white. Balanced head, brighter eye, ears set a little low, good pronounced 'occiput. Well ribbed, strong loin and quarters, moved well, lashing her tail happily.

DEBUTANT BITCH (6, 0)

1st Stilgoe & Fox's Teisgol Snow Queen - repeat entry.

2nd Stilgoe & Oliver's Teisgol Heaven Sent - 9 months, black and white. Balanced all through. Soft lips, slightly bright eyes, ears set fairly high, good tips. Good heart room. Lengthy neck. Well placed shoulders and return of upper arm. Slightly sloping pasterns. Ribs carried well back, strong loin and quarters. Moved effortlessly lashing her tail.

GRADUATE BITCH (4, 0)

1st Radcliffe's Sniperay Edge Of Glory - 19 months, orange and white. Balanced head, well developed lip, pronounced occiput. Good amount of heart room. Lengthy, clean neck, well placed shoulders and good return of upper arm. Correct oval bone, slightly sloping pasterns, oval feet. Ribs carried well back, Strong loin and rear quarters, making her a very positive mover.

2nd Booth's - Sharnphilly Ginger Fizz at Lundgarth - 2 years, orange and white. Very pretty, exudes Pointer. Shoulders ok, brisket a bit high. Correct oval bone. Ribs carried back, strong loin, quarters and thighs. Tail flows off the back, moved a little conservatively.

3rd Collins' Saregresi Ventulus Lemon Drop at Collholme (IMP HUN) - 4 years, lemon and white. Very pretty lady, Ears set fairly high, with pointed tips. Shoulder, upper arm and depth of brisket could be a little better. Nice amount of quarters and thighs, would like to have seen her move out more positively.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (7, 1)

1st Whitham's Brent Ever Blazing at Sedgekirk - 2 ½ years, 'orange and white. Balanced all through, and in good condition. Maturing well. Balanced head, defined occiput, soft, kind expression good pigment. Leathers lying close to head, medium length, slightly tipped. Good forechest and heart room. Clean, lengthy neck, into well placed shoulders, good return of upper arm, brisket let down. Neat elbows, correct oval bone, gently sloping pasterns, oval feet, arched toes. Ribs carried well back, strong over loin, well developed strong quarters, and good amount of first and second thigh. Moved out easily, lashing her tail well.

2nd Dunn's Caithpoint Kora at Meadowpoint - 2 ½ years, black and white. Balanced head, pronounced occiput, good dark eyes, square lips, ears set fairly high. Clean, lengthy neck, good shoulder, and heart room. Correct oval bone. Ribs carried well back, strong over loin, good topline. Nice quarters. Moved well, lashing her tail.

3rd Barker's Caithpoint Mia at Flinthill – 2 ½ years, orange and white. Litter sister to 2nd. Balanced head, soft lips, ears laying close to head, with good tips. Clean, lengthy neck, good heart room, correct oval bone, arched toes, oval feet. Ribs carried well back. Longer thighs than sister, moved out nicely.

MID LIMIT BITCH (8, 3)

1st Blair's Twinhoe Crystal Vita - 3 years, black and white. Well made all through, elegant. Balanced head, square lips, defined 'occiput, dark pigment, kind expression. Ears lay close to head. Clean, lengthy neck, well placed shoulders, and return of upper arm. Brisket well let down. Good heart room. Nice oval bone. Ribs carried well back, strong over loin. Well developed quarters, good first and second thigh. Hocks well let down. Moved out well, lashing her tail.

2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Worth The Wait - 3 years, orange and white. Pretty young lady, with a balanced head, kind eyes, and well set ears, laying close to her head. Clean neck, good shoulders and return of upper arm, plenty of heart room. Good, oval bone, and feet, good sloping pasterns. Ribs carried well back. Moved well.

3rd Mason's Morgan Van Freebreeze (IMP NLD) - 3 years, orange and white. Lovely, pretty head. Good lip, well set ears and kind eyes. Strong, clean neck, good forechest. Well laid shoulders and return of upper arm. Good amount of oval bone, sloping pastern, oval feet, arched toes. Ribs carried well back. Strong over loin, well developed quarters, good thighs. Moved out well.

LIMIT BITCH (11, 0)

1st Perkins' Brent Cheap Thrills - 2 ½ years, orange and white. Very bitch, beautiful head. Kind expression, balanced head, good dark pigment. Square lip, ears laying close to her head. Clean neck, into her shoulders, good heart room and forechest. Brisket let down, ribs carried well back. Strong over loin, well developed quarters and thighs. Moved easily, using her tail to advantage.

2nd Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Gartarry High Society at Spinray JW - 5 years, black and white. Balanced head, tipped up nose, soft lip, kind eye, ears laying close to head. Strong, lengthy neck, into well laid shoulders. Oval bone, sloping pasterns. Ribs carried well back, gently sloping topline. Well muscled, moved out nicely.

3rd Preece & Gilding's – Harvestlade Lesida La Rona - 4 years, orange and white. Balanced head. Dark nose pigment, pronounced occiput. Good heart room, clean, lengthy neck, brisket well let down, good oval bone. Ribs carried well back, good, gentle topline, strong quarters and thighs, moved on nicely.

OPEN BITCH (7, 3)

1st Perkins' Brent Hothouse Flower - 5 years, orange and white. I first judged her 4 years ago, awarding BPIB, and I was not disappointed today. Very pretty, typy bitch, matured well. Has the kindest expression, with good pigment, dark eyes, chiselled head, ears set fairly high, laying close to her head, slightly pointed at tips. Lengthy, clean neck, well placed shoulders, return of upper arm, deep in brisket, good heart room. Ribs carried well back, short, strong loin, strong powerful quarters, good expanse of first and second thigh. Moved out well, lashing her tail. Pleased to award her the CC. I later found out her third. Pleased that the referee, Ria Nelis, awarded her BIS.

2nd Hazeltine, Razzell, Spey, Oldfield & Lopes' - SH CH/ AM CH Bookstor Fabello Kinky Boots (IMP USA) - 4 years, orange and white. Another typy bitch. Balanced head, with good, soft lips. Ears are of good shape, with pointed tips. Tipped up nose, soft expression. Clean, lengthy neck, good forechest. Good oval bone, sloping pasterns. Ribs carried well back. Strong loin, well developed quarters and thighs. Moved well, lashing her tail. Presented in good condition.

3rd Huxley - Woodfleet Wild Is The Wind - 6 years, black and white. Smaller framed, feminine head. Good ear set, laying close to head. Long neck, good heart room, oval bone. Ribs carried up, and back, slightly arched over loin. Quarters strong, muscled, moved well, when she settled. Happy lady, lashing her tail.

SPECIAL WORKING GUNDOG BITCH (2, 0)

1st Anderson-Rowell's Daledancer Rita Owla SGWC - 3 years, orange and white. Such a typy girl, very much a working girl. Has a kind eye and expression. Well set ears, good forechest, heart room, and straight front. Long, clean neck, into her shoulders. Brisket let down. Ribs carried well back, strong over loin, good strong quarters and thighs. Moved out well, with lashing tail.

2nd Elrington's – CH Ansona Cinderella JW - 6 ½ years, black and white. So much already written about this lady, not much more I can add. Balanced head, dark eyes, workman-like, all through. Strong, clean neck, into her shoulders. Good heart room. Well sprung ribs, carried well back. Strong loin, quarters and thighs. Moved out well.

FIELD TRIAL BITCH (1, 0)

1st Anderson-Rowell's – Little Owl Scandiaca for Daledancer (IMP SVK) - 7 years old, black and white. Plainer head, balanced, eyes a little bright, good ear set, lay close to head, tipped at point. Clean strong neck, well placed shoulders, good oval bone, sloping pasterns, arched toes. Brisket well let down, ribs carried well back. Strong over loin, good expanse of quarters and thighs. lashing her tail on the move, which she did sweetly.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (6, 0)

1st Booth's Lundgarth Everest - repeat entry.

2nd Bush's Piasharn Demelza - repeat entry.

3rd Dunn's Millpoint Heart and Soul - 13 months, black and white. Balanced head, slightly bright eyes. Good ear's, set fairly high, and close to the head. Heart room still has time to develop. Clean, lengthy neck, nicely placed shoulders, oval bone, arched toes. Gently sloping topline, moved out nicely. Well done.
