### **MINOR PUPPY DOG (4, 1 abs)**

1<sup>st</sup> Matthews' Sonham Raising The Game. 6mths B/W. Good head and online. Exuberant on the move which is to be expected in a puppy, but movement showed reach and drive. Promising prospect.

2<sup>nd</sup> Lewis' Braithwaite Pole Position Fallowfield. O/W of 6mths. Lovely head and expression. Nice outline. Movement a bit erratic but can be forgiven at this age

3<sup>rd</sup> Mcdougall's Wynhead Charisma

### **PUPPY DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Oddie and Oddie's Chesterhope One Way Ticket (Ai imp NZ) JW. B/W of 11mths. Handled so well. Lovely head with pronounced occiput. Clean outline. Kept his top line on the move. Well angulated front and rear BPIB and Gundog Puppy Group 3.

2<sup>nd</sup> Watkins and Miles' Cupids Halo. 10mths B/W. Different type to first but another impressive puppy. Moved well fore and after. Nice expression and eye shape. Has a promising future.

3<sup>rd</sup> Sillince's Davigdor Flanders Field.

### **JUNIOR DOG (3, 1abs)**

1<sup>st</sup> Stilgoe's Glenariff Mojito over Teisgol. B/W aged 14mths. Handsome young boy. Moved and handled well. Good bend of stifle and tail set. Not overdone in any way

2<sup>nd</sup> Morrison's Raigmore Greatest Day. B/W of 12mths. Has a good head. Nice shape and placement of ears. Moved well. Just lacked maturity of 1st

### **YEARLING DOG (4)**

1<sup>st</sup> Philo's Tenshilling It's My Party for Salmonmist JW. O/W. Has a lovely outline when stacked. Good length of neck leading to well placed shoulders. Well let down hocks. Moved well

2<sup>nd</sup> Charlish's Farepoint Jeremy Fisher L/W of good type. Correct feet and patterns. Moved steadily

3<sup>rd</sup> Duncan's Lithespirit Karen's Comet

### **GRADUATE DOG (3)**

1<sup>st</sup> Gordon's Hawkfield Auspicious. Typey O/W who looks a picture when stacked. Lovely head with a melting expression. Well angulated front and rear. Moved well fore and aft

2<sup>nd</sup> Duncan's Lithespirit Karen's Comet. (3rd in previous class) L/W. Not as mature as first. Sympathetically handled. Moved okay. Needs time

3<sup>rd</sup> Rossiter and Mosedale's Kimifleur Black Hawk

**POST GRADUATE DOG (4, 1abs)**

1<sup>st</sup> Westron's Fowington Beware The Bear at Aurichalcum. Handsome O/W boy who moved with drive. Fabulous head and expression. Good length of neck leading into well placed shoulders. Good feet and pasterns. Truly fit for function. I'm sure his time will come.

2<sup>nd</sup> Martin & Martin's Sunhouse Banged to Rights. B/W unlucky to meet 1st who was on top form. Another who moves well and has a lovely outline when stacked. Nice head with correct ear placement. Good spring of rib.

3<sup>rd</sup> Charlish & Brigden's Braithwaite Love in the Air

**LIMIT DOG (4, 1 abs)** A lovely class.

1<sup>st</sup> Jamieson, Macara, Macara & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Peri Peri With Glenfinnan. O/W. This boy has now reached full maturity. Fabulous outline when stacked. Moved so well showing reach and drive. Handsome head, long neck onto good shoulders. Kept his topline on the move and used his tail correctly. Pleased to award him the DCC (his 2nd) and BOB. 2<sup>nd</sup> Gerrard's Carmandine Count On Me. B/W Another in lovely condition and form. Moved out well covering the ground. Well let down brisket and good spring of rib.

2<sup>nd</sup> Radcliffe's Sniperay Edge Of Glory JW. O/W. Another lovely girl. Unlucky to meet first in such fine form. Good head and eye. Correct front with good feet. Presents a series of graceful curves.

1<sup>st</sup> Gerrard, Bell & Galloway's Sh Ch Chesterhope C'Mon Over to Carmandine (imp NZ) JW. Well known O/W who has achieved so much in her career. Beautiful head and expression. Correct outline with the desired series of graceful curves. Moves so well fore and aft

2<sup>nd</sup> Dyer & Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Serendipity JW. Beautiful B/W who has also had a successful career from this kennel. Well balanced in profile. Expertly handled. Moved true fore and aft.

3<sup>rd</sup> Perkins' Sh Ch Brent Hothouse Flower.

**VETERAN BITCH (2)**

1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Sh Ch Fydal Bedazzle. O/W who has always been a favourite of mine. Fabulous head and has a melting expression. Good length of neck. Moved well keeping her topline.
