## **VETERAN DOG** (Ent 2, Abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Hazeltine, Welch & Goddard Sh Ch Just Wilbert by Hookwood. B/w who at 8 years of age still moves out well and enthusiastically and definitely enjoys his days out. He is a shapely, well balanced boy with good angulation fore and aft. Nicely shaped, proportional head showing an alert expression. Super, lashing tail. 2<sup>nd</sup> Henshaw Penbro Under Pressure with Peteshe. 7 year old o/w with a pretty head and expression, starting to show his age a little. Would benefit from more muscle tone.

## MINOR PUPPY DOG (Ent 2, Abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Watkins & Miles Cupids Halo. B/w showing a smart outline across the ring. He has a good head, dark eyes giving a soft expression. Excellent oval bone and feet. Moving steadily and soundly for one so young. One to watch....

2<sup>nd</sup> Sillince Davigdor Flanders Field. O/w, not as together as 1 but nonetheless a beautifully headed boy with the most lovely expression. Well balanced angulation, correct topline and tail. Just needs to curb his enthusiasm on the move, will watch his progress with interest.

1<sup>st</sup> Oddie Chesterhope One Way Ticket AI (Imp NZ). Smart 10 mth b/w boy. Well developed head, dark eye, long nicely arched neck flowing into well placed shoulders. Moves out well, showing reach and drive holding his topline. Good tail and coat. Shown in excellent muscular condition. BPD 2<sup>nd</sup> Sillince Davigdor Flanders Field

## JUNIOR DOG (Ent 4, Abs 0)

1 Sarrou & Hall Gartarry New Kid in Town. Smart o/w boy presenting an attractive outline and shown in excellent muscular condition. Pretty head with dark expressive eyes, long neck, well balanced angulation and once settled moved out well and soundly. Good tail.

2<sup>nd</sup> Stilgoe Glenariff Mojito over Teisgol. I like this b/w boy who in my notes I describe as a 'good, honest sort'. He is a medium sized dog and has everything in the right place, correct oval bone and good feet, head still needs to break but he has time on his side. He is sound coming and going, good muscle tone.
