MINOR PUPPY DOG (4)

1st Matthews & Adams' Carofel Wings Of Hope. Pleasing in overall outline and well balanced for age, lovely bone and substance, masculine head just needing to develop. Well angulated front and rear. Moved well just a little un co-ordinated as expected at this age.

2nd Hazeltine & Razzell's Clamerkin Jubilee Fly Past for Corotine. Another pleasing puppy overall, with a lovely head and eye, balanced body with good bone, just needing to tighten in front a little.

3rd Baker's Mattiboo Bohemian Rhapsody.

PUPPY DOG (6)

1st Webb's Tenshilling Jimmy Mack. Well made puppy still needing to mature and develop in head, which is masculine yet still refined. Pleasing overall construction with good bone well ribbed body and plenty of angulation front and rear. Moved steadily. BPD

2nd Lewis' Braithwaite Pole Position in Fallowfield. Mature puppy with lovely bone and substance, masculine head with dark eye. Well developed body with good angulation and muscle tone. On the move he was a bit over enthusiastic and erratic at times.

3rd Mennen & Sweeney's Joneva Just Imagine.

JUNIOR DOG (2)

1st Oddie & Oddie's Chesterhope One Way Ticket Al (Imp NZ) NAF. Lovely headed dog with plenty of work in it and dark expressive eyes. Presented a balanced outline with good proportions and well developed hindquarters. Moved soundly.

2 Sillince's Davigdor Flanders Field. Another quality dog of good overall construction and balance, just needing a little more maturity. Moved soundly.

YEARLING DOG (3)

1st Westaway's Teisgol Keep On Going via Penwest JW. Pleasing overall for type size and substance. Masculine head with pleasing eye, well constructed front with depth. balanced body, strong well angulated moderate hindquarters. Presented a good outline standing and on the move, which he did well with good side gait.

2nd Preece & Gilding's Harvestslade Light Of Peace. Lovely overall type and construction, slightly bigger frame and still needing to mature into it. Presented a lovely outline and moved soundly with style.

3rd Salt's Riowood Costello at Gastal.

POST GRADUATE DOG (4)

1st Martin & Martin's Sunhouse Banged To Rights. Mature black & white with a masculine head, lovely bone and substance, deep well ribbed body with plenty of angulation and well made quarters. Moved soundly.

2nd Gordon's Hawkfield Auspicious. Good headed dog with plenty of work in it, pleasing overall construction and balance, just needs to carry a lot more weight. Moved with good side gait.

3rd Allen's Dondaig Wooden Heart.

MID LIMIT DOG (5)

1st Guy & Tuthill's Cumbrian Night King at Carofel (Imp USA). Pleasing overall construction, he is balanced of pleasing size with a masculine head, dark eye, good bone, well angulated front and rear. Could carry a little extra weight to advantage, however won on his good ground covering movement.

2nd Oliver & Stilgoe's Teisgol Love Is In The Air. Nice headed dog with pleasing eye and expression, presents a balanced outline with lovely bone and substance. Mature well made body with good hindquarters.

Moved with drive.

3rd Martin & Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked.

LIMIT DOG (8)

1st Henshaw & Goodchild's Sharnphilly Vice Versa with Peteshe SGWS. Smart impressive dog, he has a lovely head masculine yet refined, good overall balance with well constructed front, deep body and strong hindquarters. Presents a pleasing outline of flowing curves. Moved well in the challenge was just a little over enthusiastic on the move.

2nd Gerrard's Carmandine Count On Me. Another nicely made dog who is correctly made throughout with pleasing balance and type who moved soundly with good reach and drive.

3rd Wybergh's Stocksfell Chase The Ace.

OPEN DOG (5, 1)

1st Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW. Quality dog, who I've placed highly in a group and my opinion of him hasn't changed. He is totally balanced and flows from head to tail, with a mature well developed body, good front and rear construction. He is un-exaggerated and moderate throughout, of good size and substance. When asked to move he covers the ground soundly with minimum effort, holding a strong topline showing a series of graceful curves. CC & BOB

2nd Layton's Sh Ch Joneva Born To Thrill - Another quality dog worthy of his title, he is balanced and mature with lovely bone and substance. Pleasing overall in construction and balance. Moved soundly with style and drive. Res CC

3rd Preece & Gilding's Harvestslade Cullinan.

VETERAN DOG (5, 1)

1st O'Neill's Sh Ch Tenshilling Home Alone JW ShCM. Masculine headed dog. who presents a picture of a balanced outline, with well ribbed compact body, strong well angulated rear. Moved well and in good condition.

2nd Rayner & Spinks & Pringle's Sh Ch Freebreeze Over The Top at Spinray. Pleasing overall type, he flows in outline and is well made and balanced throughout, just preferred depth and movement on I.

3rd Critchley, London & Heaton's Shadybrook J Hoover at Whipsan (Imp USA)

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (4)

1st Mennen & Sweeney's Lundgarth Wild Yarrow. Lovely overall type and balance, young and still needing to mature, however has good balance, nice head, well made body with good quarters. Moved soundly with plenty of reach and drive. BSp & pleased to see him, win Special Beginners Group.

2nd Allen's Dondaig Wooden Heart. Masculine head, pleasing overall outline just a little big and rangy. Presented a good outline with well angulated hindquarters. Moved well.

3rd Collins & Collins' Collholme Balthasar.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (14,3) Lovely class with some promising puppies.

1st Hinton's Fleurfield Black Caviar. A raw baby but one I would take home, she is just right for age. With a feminine head, lovely well made and balanced body with plenty of bone and substance. She flows in outline standing and on the move which she does soundly for one so young. I will watch her progress with interest.

2nd Welch, Drake & Hazeltine's Clamerkin Jubilee Surprise at Hookwood. Another pleasing pup of good overall type and balance, she has a good outline and moved well.

3rd Earl, Wheldon & Jones' Flinthill Some Like It Hot TAF.

PUPPY BITCH (8)

1st Bond's Jeneva Azelia Banks. Quality mature puppy with a beautiful head and dark expressive eyes. She flows through clean well made front, deep balanced body to strong powerful quarters. Strong topline and lovely tail. Moved soundly with good reach and drive just needs a little more maturity. Res CC & BP

2nd Fewster & Rossiter's Jeneva Just A Kiss. Litter sister and very similar in construction and overall quality I'm sure these 2 will change places regularly just needing to develop a little more in head. Sound positive mover with great side gait.

3rd Burke's Alcazar Eternal Liasion.

JUNIOR BITCH (4, 1)

1st Oddie's Sharnphilly Sugarplum. Pleasing overall from head to tail, she is deep in body with good bone and plenty of angles front and rear. Moved with good ground covering stride.

2nd Earl, Wheldon & Jones' Hawkfield Frivolous NAF TAF. Similar overall balance and qualities. Only 10 months and needing to mature, presented a pleasing outline and moved well.

3rd Burke's Alcazar Eternal Love.

YEARLING BITCH (3, 1)

1st Booth's Lundgarth Everest JW. Pretty headed bitch of pleasing type, well made body with plenty of bone and balanced outline. A little unsettled while being handled, but happy and sound on the move covering the ground well.

2nd Rayner, Spinks & Pringle's Spinray Songbird. Pleasing outline and construction with deep body and flowing lines. Just preferred head and rear movement on 1.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (13, 5)

1st Klaiber's Hawkfield Scandalous. Lovely bitch with feminine head, balanced well made body. Compact with plenty angulation front and rear. Presented a flowing outline and moved soundly with drive.

2nd Clinton's Hawkfield Merry with Oramiss. Pleasing overall for type and balance, with plenty bone and substance. Preferred front construction on 1.

3rd Pearson's Millpoint Jolly Good Show at Ladyhawke.

MID LIMIT BITCH (11, 2)

1st Mason's Morgan Van Freebreeze (Imp Nld). Quality bitch of good type with flowing lines, feminine head with nice eye, deep well made body with plenty of angulation front and rear. Good legs and feet. lovely bone. Shown in good condition and muscle tone. Moved soundly with drive.

2nd Wilkinson's Stocksfell Shockwave. Another quality bitch of lovely overall type and construction, she too flows from a pleasing head to good tail and moved with good ground covering stride, just not quite the muscular condition of 1.

3rd Norbury, Norbury & Adam's Heartbury Northern Lights JW.

LIMIT BITCH (8,4)

1st Gordon's Hawkfield Happy. Pleasing overall for type and flowing lines, feminine head, good bone and substance, well ribbed compact body with strong well made quarters. Moved soundly with reach and drive.

2nd Wilkinson's Stocksfell Seldom Seen. Another lovely bitch with good head lovely bone and substance, well made body with flowing outline. Moved well.

3rd Matthews' Sonham Chasing Rainbows.

OPEN BITCH (4)

1st Gerrard & Bell's Sh Ch Chesterhope C'mon Over to Carmandine (Imp NZ). Quality bitch from a lovely head and eye, she is a series of graceful curves through a deep mature body with well angulated hindquarters. She presents a balanced outline and moved well with a good ground covering effortless stride. CC

2nd Webb's Sh Ch Tenshilling The Wanderer. Feminine headed bitch with a pleasing feminine head, balanced and overall well made body with plenty of bone and substance. Moved well.

3rd Hazeltine & Razzell's Am Ch Sh Ch Bookstor Fabello Kinky Boots (Imp USA).

VETERAN BITCH (1)

1st Brooksmith & Solomon's Nightgold Blackavar VW. Lovely condition for age and enjoying the day out, moved well.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (7,2)

1st Klaiber's Hawkfield Scandalous.
