## MINOR PUPPY DOG (Ent 3, Abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Watkins' Lakewinds Benchmark (Imp AUS). 9-month super quality youngster with the most appealing head shape and dish, correct eye colour, super front assembly bone and feet, deep through the chest for his age. Strong quarters with correct top line and movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bush & Bush's Piasharn Rocka Rolla. B/W raw puppy came to life on the move. Very positive front action, pleasing head shape, good bone and feet, would prefer more weight. For me pleasing topline. 3<sup>rd</sup> Lewis' Jilony Zorro at Fallowfield.

#### PUPPY DOG (Ent 5, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Tibbs & Tibbs' Raigmore Keep The Faith. B/w 10 months old and so balanced, pleasing head of correct size and proportions, clean over the neck leading to well placed shoulders and front assembly, with bone and good feet, well ribbed for his age, super body proportions and length of loin, moved in a positive action, one to watch for the future. BP.

2<sup>nd</sup> Black & Black's Raigmore Defender Of Faith. Another of pleasing type. Pleasing head and shoulders, deep chest leading to correct depth of chest and front movement. Well bodied with correct length of loin, just being a fidget here today.

3<sup>rd</sup> Sardu's Radussini Biondo Tevere.

#### JUNIOR DOG (Ent 4, Abs 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Gerrard & Bells Carmandine Oh C'mon Then. 12-month o/w with the most appealing head shape length of muzzle and dish to enhance his expression, well arched neck and correct shoulder placement super bone and feet, his chest needs to drop, well bodied with good length to loin, correct rear angulation and moved true.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bowley's Sedgekirk Ever The Fool. O/w with pleasing head, neck and shoulders, well bodied but would have preferred longer length to loin. Moved a little close behind and when settled, looked well.

#### GRADUATE DOG (Ent 1, Abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Morrison's Raigmore Greatest Day. B/w with pleasing head, masculine but not overdone, correct front assembly, clean neck and shoulders, deep chest, well bodied with correct topline, super quarters, movement ok.

#### POST GRADUATE DOG (Ent 2, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Collins & Collins' Collholme Balthasar. Another with a pleasing head and ear set, correct front and shoulder placement, well bodied but falls away over croup for me, moved well and shown in good hard condition.

#### LIMIT DOG (Ent 3, Abs 1) 2 dogs of different type in this class, both b/w.

1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Stocksfell Saros. Male with super expression, dish and length of muzzle, correct length of neck leading to well placed shoulders, bone and feet, deep through his chest. Well bodied with correct length of loin, super angles, topline and movement. Res CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wybergh's Stocksfell Chase The Ace. Liked this boy's head and expression, if ultra-critical it could have been a little more masculine, nice reach of neck and correct. shoulder placement, deep through the chest well bodied and moved well.

# OPEN DOG (Ent 6, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Jamieson & Macara & Macara's. Sh Ch Karix Peri Peri with Glenfinnan. O/w, upstanding male presented a balanced picture, pleasing head with correct dish and length of muzzle. Excellent lay of shoulder, deep chest with elbows level with brisket, well ribbed back and correct length of loin, strong hindquarters with well let down hocks, correct oval bone and super feet. Strong positive driving movement finished the picture for me. CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW. B/w smaller dog, correct head shape and masculine expression, not so clean through the neck as the winner, good forechest, bone and feet, deep brisket and well laced shoulder, well bodied and correct length of loin, shown and moved well. 3<sup>rd</sup> Layton's Sh Ch Joneva Born To Thrill.

# **SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG** (Ent 2, Abs 0)

1st Collins & Collins' Collholme Balthasar. 2<sup>nd</sup> Bowley's Sedgekirk Ever The Fool.

## MINOR PUPPY BITCH (Ent 5, Abs 2)

1<sup>st</sup> Fairbairn's Carmelfair Easy To Spot. B/w 7 months, pleasing head and flowing neck leading to well placed shoulders, well bodied with a good depth to her chest for her age, well bodied and moved as you would expect from a young pup.

2<sup>nd</sup> Fairbairn's Carmelfair Spotcheck. B/w litter sister to winner, another with feminine expression, correct neck and shoulders, well bodied preferred topline and movement on the winner. 3<sup>rd</sup> Bush & Bush's Piasharn Breaking The Law.

## PUPPY BITCH (Ent 3, Abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Tibbs & Tibbs' Raigmore Faith In The Future. B/w promising puppy. Feminine head and expression with correct length of muzzle, lean neck and shoulders, well boned and correct front angulation, clean through the body with positive rear movement, well let down hocks.

2<sup>nd</sup> Lewis' Riowood Blackbird at Fallowfield. 10-month b/w lovely outline, super feminine expression. Clean neck and shoulders, enough bone and good feet, well bodied with correct length of loin, super hindquarters played up on the move in front action. Plenty to like about her. 3<sup>rd</sup> Bush & Bush's Piasharn Breaking The Law.

## JUNIOR BITCH (Ent 3, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Macara & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Sooty at Stargang. B/w lovely headed youngster, super type and balance, plenty of bone, correct front assembly with good shoulder placement, clean neck, well bodied and length of loin, super quarters and well let down hocks, would prefer less skirt, moved very well both ways. 2<sup>nd</sup> Booth's Lundgath Jubilee. O/w of pleasing type, head and expression was not what I was looking for today, enough bone and good shoulder placement, well bodied and strong hindquarters, moved very well.

## YEARLING BITCH (Ent 4, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Fewster & Rossiter's Joneva Just A Kiss JW. This o/w girl excelled in Pointer expression, super dish and length of muzzle, strong neck leading to well placed shoulders and super brisket, depth of chest, well bodied, standing on oval bone and tight feet, pleasing length of loin and strong hindquarters with correct angulation, moved well fore and aft.

2<sup>nd</sup> Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Smoochie at Stargang. O/w, not quite the expression I was looking for here today, nevertheless her other attributes made up for this, clean over the neck and shoulder; well bodied and moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Booth's Lundgarth Jubilee.

# GRADUATE BITCH (Ent 5, Abs 3)

1<sup>st</sup> Storey & Dyer's Kimifleur Gold Standard. O/w her head for me was a little strong, clean neck and shoulders, well boned with neat feet, shown and handled well moved true.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bush & Bush's Piasharn Demelza. Liver/w, she has a very prominent dish and expression, clean neck and well placed shoulders, well bodied, would prefer stronger hindquarters, moved ok.

### POST GRADUATE BITCH (Ent 6)

1<sup>st</sup> Wilkinson's Stocksfell Shockwave. Drawn to this b/w by her balance and breed type, pleasing head and expression, plenty of bone and neat feet, super forequarters and lay of shoulder, well bodied, held her topline on the move and standing, super quarters with correct rear angulation, moved well utilising her tail to advantage.

2<sup>nd</sup> Martin & Martin's Sunhouse Partners In Crime. Another b/w shown in hard condition. Pleasing head and expression, correct front assembly clean over the neck, well bodied and good hindquarters, moved very well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Anderson-Rowell's Raigmore Limelight at Daledancer.

## LIMIT BITCH (Ent 4, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Bond's Joneva Azelia Banks JW. O/w of super type and balance, so feminine with super head qualities and expression, clean neck leading to correct shoulder placement, well off for bone and super feet, correct forecast and depth of brisket well bodied with pleasing length of loin, well muscled hindquarters with well let down hocks, held her topline and correct tailset. Moved very nicely to finish the picture. 2<sup>nd</sup> Blackburn-Bennett & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Skyfall. What a show girl, pleasing head and expression. Excellent front, well bodied with strong quarters, moved well. 3<sup>rd</sup> Blowers' Fowington Lar Ti Dar at Deadaway.

#### **OPEN BITCH** (Ent 6, Abs 0)

1<sup>st</sup> Siddle & Siddle's Sh Ch Wilchrimane Frankel (ai). O/w well balanced all through, classic head with defined stop and pronounced occipital bone, clean neck leading to well placed shoulders and return of upper arm. Chest of correct width and depth, well sprung rib cage and length of loin, correct topline held on the move and standing, well muscled hindquarters which she used to her advantage with correct front movement as you would expect. CC & BOB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Thirwell & Malik's Sh Ch Sharphilly Santa Rosa. O/w another in this class from the top drawer, super feminine. Expression with correct dish, clean over the shoulder with good oval bone and feet, deep chest and super body. loin and rear quarters, moved well. RCC.

3<sup>rd</sup> Gerrard & Bell's Sh Ch Chesterhope C'mon Over to Carmandine (Imp NZ).

#### VETERAN BITCH (Ent 2, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Hewitt & Hewitt's Sh Ch Droveborough's Miss Marple. 8 years of age of pleasing type with correct expression, clean neck and shoulders, correct bone and neat feet, deep chest and well bodied, correct length of loin leading to strong quarters, moved very well. BVIB.

#### SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (Ent 4, Abs 1)

1<sup>st</sup> Collins & Collins' Collholme Angelique. See JB. BSB.

2<sup>nd</sup> Booth's Lundgarth Jubilee. O/w pleasing type with correct pigment and expression, clean throughout and moved very well handled well.
