MINOR PUPPY DOG (5,0)

1st Webster's Joneva Just Goes to Show at Errytar. At just 6 months this puppy is so well balanced throughout and a good size for his age. Lovely head and eye, clean over his neck and shoulder with a straight front, good depth. Correct topline and tail set. Excellent width of second thigh. Such a sound and positive mover.

2nd Hazeltine, Razzell & Cassey's Corotine Prince Charming. Different stamp and style to the winner but still lots to like. Pleasing head and eye. Good reach of neck onto well placed shoulders. Lovely spring of rib good depth and plenty of substance throughout. Moved out well fore and aft.

3rd Anthony's Jilony Zuess.

PUPPY DOG (5,0)

1st Watkins' Lakewinds Benchmark (Imp Aus). Very well balanced throughout and built on flowing lines. Good head with a soft kind expression. Pleasing neck and shoulder excellent depth of chest for his age along with well developed hindquarters. Sound positive mover covering the ground on a free and easy stride. BPIB and pleased to see him take PG4.

2nd Norbury's Heartbury Matador. Another quality dog of good size, make and shape. Balanced head with a good eye and expression. Well developed body with a good spring of rib, short coupled, nicely rounded quarters with a good bend of stifle. Moved on a good stride.

3rd Hazeltine, Razzell & Cassey's Corotine Prince Charming.

JUNIOR DOG (11,2)

1st Tibbs' Raigmore Keep The Faith. This young dog is so beautifully balanced throughout. At just 12 months I could not deny him the Res CC today in a quality line up. Masculine head with correct eye shape. Strong muscular neck onto well placed shoulders and a straight front with plenty of heart room. Well sprung ribs along with good depth and body. Firm topline and well developed quarters. He moved with lovely reach and drive, Res CC.

2nd Lewis' Kanix Snapdragon at Fallowfield. Very well made throughout and has a super masculine head with correct eye shape and the best of expressions. Straight front standing on good legs and feet. He has a good lay of shoulder, lovely depth for his age and well sprung ribs. Best of hindquarters. Sound positive mover.

3rd Hill, Hill & Hill's Kanix Sourdough with Calaquendi.

YEARLING DOG (5,0)

1st Van Genechten & Akkermans Saregresi Ready To Rumble. Slightly rangier type of dog who still needs to develop in body to complete the picture but at that youthful stage of his career. Presents a very good shape and outline, both stacked and on the move. Balanced head and the softest of expression. Good reach of neck set into well placed shoulders, pleasing topline and well developed hindquarters with a good bend of stifle. A very stylish sound mover who covered the ground on a free and easy stride. The best is still to come.

2nd Mennen & Sweeney's Joneva Just Imagine JW. Very well made dog of good type. Balanced head with a good eye shape and a pleasing expression. Lovely reach of neck onto well placed shoulders. Good front. deep chest with plenty of heart room and good width of quarters. Sound mover fore and aft.

3rd Webb's Tenshilling Jimmie Mack JW.

POST GRADUATE DOG (7,2)

- 1st Weaver's Dapline Chance for Anniezu. Lovely type of O/W built on flowing lines and of a good size. Pleasing head and eye. Strong muscular neck, good layback of shoulder and correct bone with fine sloping pasterns. Well developed chest with good depth and strong muscular quarters. Moved with super reach and drive and used his tail to his advantage.
- 2 Allen's Dondaig Wooden Heart. B/W of different stamp and style to the winner but a very well made dog of excellent conformation throughout. Balanced head with a kind eye. Strong neck onto nicely laid shoulders, very good front assembly, short deep body, pleasing hindquarters with a good bend of stifle. Once he got into his stride moved soundly on a good stride.
- 3rd Trueman's Bradleypoint's Floki.

MID LIMIT DOG (3,0)

- 1st Adams' Carofel Wings Of Hope JW Ww23 Swiss Jr Ch. He has a head of correct proportions with a pleasing outlook and a soft expression. Clean over his neck and shoulders, stands on good legs and feet, lovely depth and substance with a good spring of rib. He has a firm topline that he holds on the move along with well developed quarters. Happy, sound and positive mover.
- 2nd Wilkinson's Stocksfell Saros. Such a quality boy who pushed the winner close. Has a good head, eye and expression. Lovely lay back of shoulder and return of upper arm. Quality bone throughout. pleasing depth, strong muscular hindquarters and excellent topline and tailset. Moved well on a free and easy stride.
- 3rd Mennen & Sweeney's Lundgarth Wild Yarrow.

LIMIT DOG (5,0)

- 1st Martin & Martin's Sunhouse You're Nicked. What a sound and honest dog who is so well made throughout and presents a clean and balanced outlook. Masculine head with a correct eye shape. Good reach of neck onto well laid shoulders, lovely depth of chest, good spring of rib and a firm topline. Well angulated hindquarters which he used to advantage on the move. Soundest of movers with such reach and drive.
- 2nd Walkling, Siddle & Siddle's Wilchrimane Kinsphere with Kiswahill. Loved the head on this dog so typical with the best of expressions. So well developed throughout and is not exaggerated in anyway. He has a strong muscular neck with well laid shoulders. Lovely depth and body and he has a good front with plenty of heart room. Strong firm topline and well rounded quarters. A very sound mover.
- 3rd Adams & Adams' Fisherbloom Re'encountered JW.

OPEN DOG (8,0)

- 1st Oddie's Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW. This dog is so impressive and takes your eye as soon as he enters the ring. Best of heads with a lovely eye and the kindest of expressions. So clean over his neck and shoulders with a super front assembly and the best of legs and feet. Close fitting elbows and has excellent depth and body and great strength of loin. Strong topline and well developed quarters. He covers the ground on such a free and easy stride. CC & BOB. Delighted to see him shortlisted in a quality Gundog Group.
- 2nd Layton's Sh Ch Joneva Born To Thrill. Did him well the last time I judged the breed and is still a real favourite of mine. Quality dog who is so impressive both stacked and on the move. Super head and eye. Excellent reach of neck with well laid shoulders. lovely front assembly, good depth, bone and substance. Muscular well rounded quarters and a correct tailset and carriage. Positive sound mover.
- 3rd Martin & Martin's Sh Ch Sunhouse Banged To Rights.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG (3,0)

1st Trueman's Bradleypoint Floki. Nicely balanced dog, good size with a pleasing head, reach of neck and lay of shoulders. Well sprung ribs and good body with depth. Pleasing hindquarters. Moved soundly.

2nd Astbury's Raigmore Leap Of Faith to Dorbury. Lovely type with a good head, eye and expression.

Pleasing neck and shoulders, straight front, good bone, firm body and a well set tail. Well made quarters. Moved well.

3rd Collins & Collins' Collholme Balthasar.

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (11,2)

1st Adams' Joneva Just One Wish. She headed a lovely class of promising babies all of which were at different stages of their development. She has a balanced feminine head and kindest of expression. Clean over her neck and shoulders with a good straight front and tight elbows. Excellent depth for her age, well sprung ribs with correct bone. Well developed quarters with a lovely bend of stifle. Such a positive and sound mover for her age.

2nd Oddie's Sharnphilly Solitaire for Riowood. Another quality puppy who has a super head, kind eye and soft expression. Good reach of neck on to well placed shoulders. Best of fronts with super body and depth for one so young. Firm topline that she held on the move. Well rounded quarters. Sound mover both fore and aft. I am sure these two will change places on many occasions through their puppy careers.

3rd Hazeltine & Razzell's Corotine Queen Bea.

PUPPY BITCH (8,0)

1st Brigden's Braithwaite Quora. This bitch has such a lovely balanced head and the best of expressions. So well made throughout and so together for her age both stacked and on the move. Good layback of shoulder with super depth and substance. Excellent front assembly, quality bone and good feet. Firm topline and a pleasing tailset and carriage. Has excellent width of second thigh and a good bend of stifle. Sound mover who really covers the ground, BPB.

2nd Adams & Adams' Joneva Just One Wish.

3rd Hazeltine, Razzell & Cassy's Corotine Queen Bea.

JUNIOR BITCH (8,2)

1st Macara & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Sooty at Stargang. Built on clean lines and is so well balanced throughout. She has such a lovely balanced head with a good eye and expression. Well placed shoulders with a strong firm body and good depth of brisket, well sprung ribs and strong muscular quarters. Moved with reach and drive.

2nd Tibbs' Raigmore Faith In The Future. Another quality youngster who was unlucky to meet the winner on such form on the day. Lovely head with a soft expression. Clean over her neck and shoulders. Good straight front, lovely depth and well ribbed back. Excellent width of second thigh. Sound steady mover.

3rd Lewis' Riowood Blackberry at Farrowfield.

YEARLING BITCH (3,0)

1st Fewster & Rossiter's Joneva Just A Kiss JW. Super type who is so feminine throughout but has the required strength and substance to complete the picture. She is built on graceful flowing lines with a super balanced head and kind eye and soft expression. Lovely length of neck which is arched and set onto well placed shoulders. Excellent front assembly, correct bone with lovely depth and substance. Firm topline and correct tailset, best of quarters of which she uses to advantage on the move holding her topline and using her tail well. So sound on the move, CC.

2nd Blackburn-Bennett & Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Skyfall. Very good make and shape throughout. Balanced head with a very feminine outlook. Strong neck and has a good layback of shoulder. Excellent depth and substance. Quality bone, good body shape with well made hindquarters. Moved well on a free and easy stride.

3rd Booth's Lundgarth Jubilee.

POST GRADUATE BITCH (13,4)

1st Wilkinson's Stocksfell Shockwaves. Top class bitch. She is so well made throughout and just oozes breed type. Best of heads with a lovely kind expression. Strong neck onto well laid shoulders, excellent bone, straight front with plenty of heart room and stands on good legs and feet. Well angulated quarters with lovely width of second thigh. She has great reach and drive on the move with that lashing tail action which is such a trait of the breed. Res CC.

2nd Martin & Martin's Sunhouse Partners In Crime. Well balanced bitch with a pleasing outlook. Good head and eye. lovely depth and substance, straight front and has a good layback of shoulder. Strong firm topline which she holds on the move. Well rounded quarters with a pleasing bend of stifle. Sound mover.

3rd Hinton, Luke & Leman's Fleurfield Black Caviar.

MID LIMIT BITCH (4,1)

1st Blackburn-Bennett's Kanix Smoochie at Stargang. Bitch who has excellent conformation throughout and is built on clean lines. Best of heads. strong neck onto well laid shoulders, lovely front assembly and good depth of chest with plenty of heart room. Well rounded hindquarters and moved with lovely reach and drive on the best of strides.

2nd Burke's Alcazar Eternal Liaison. Typey and presents a pleasing outline both stacked and on the move. She has a feminine head and a lovely eye and soft expression. Well laid shoulders with a good reach of neck. Straight front, good legs and feet. Excellent depth throughout and well angulated quarters. Moved well fore and aft.

3rd Brooksmith's Nightgold Pipkin.

LIMIT BITCH (6,1)

1st Jamieson & Jamison's Carmelfair Bellissima with Glenfinnan. Bitch of a pleasing size with lovely bone and substance. Sweet feminine head with a kind eye and best of expressions. Strong muscular neck onto well laid shoulders, straight front standing on good legs and feet. Firm topline, well rounded quarters and lovely width of second thigh. Moved with good reach and dive.

2nd Gordon's Hawkfield Happy. So well made and of a pleasing type. Balanced head and kind eye. She has plenty of body and is not exaggerated in anyway whatsoever. Pleasing over her neck and shoulders, straight in front. Good bone, strong topline and muscular hindquarters. Sound and steady mover.

3rd Booth's Sharnphilly Ginger Fizz at Lundgarth.

OPEN BITCH (6,1)

1st Bond's Joneva Azelia Banks JW. Headed a lovely class of Open bitches. So well balanced with a super head and eye. She has an excellent constructed front assembly. Clean over her neck and shoulders, excellent depth of chest lovely and well sprung ribs. Quality bone throughout with well developed hindquarters and good bend of stifle. Moved out on a free and easy stride.

2nd Tibbs & Tibbs' Raigmore Worth The Wait. She is feminine throughout but has the required strength and substance to complete the picture. Pretty head, well balanced and correct eye shape and pleasing expression. Strong muscular neck set in well placed shoulders. Firm body, good strength of loin and well rounded quarters. Sound on the move fore and aft.

3rd Webb's Sh Ch Tenshilling The Wanderer.

VETERAN BITCH (4,0)

1st MacKay's Sh Ch Federic Fanfare at Woodglade. Quality bitch from all angles. She has kept a lovely shape both stacked and on the move. Best of heads with such a typical outlook. So clean over her neck and shoulders. Excellent front assembly with a good topline and correct tailset and carriage. Well constructed quarters. Exuberant on the move today really enjoying her day, BV. A credit to her owner.

2nd Brooksmith's Nightgold Blackavar VW. This bitch really belies her age, so well balanced and has kept her clean lines. Pleasing head, eye and expression. Strong muscular neck, good lay back of shoulders, best of legs and feet, bone along with muscular well rounded hindquarters. Moved well.

3rd Barham's Kenwardgold Minnie Me VW.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS BITCH (9,3)

1st Colins & Collins's Collholme Angelique. Of good make and shape with a lovely head, eye and kind expression. Clean over her neck and shoulders with a pleasing body and good depth. Well angulated quarters. Moved with good reach and drive. BSB and pleased to see her placed 4th in the Special Beginners Group later in the day.

2nd Klaiber's Sharnphilly Gingerbread. Lovely type of bitch, balanced head with a soft expression. Good front. pleasing depth of body and well rounded quarters. Sound on the move covering the ground on a good stride.
