Thank you for the entry which I believe was the highest of the year apart from Crufts and to The Society for the invitation and hospitality and to my hard working stewards who had a long day.

Overall, I thought the breed is in a good state there were more than enough to warrant their placings in every class, with the Limit and Open Classes in both sexes being particularly strong and hotly contested with it all coming down to overall condition and performance on the day and the same with some promising puppies and youngsters coming behind all in various stages of development. Stafford Showground is never the best of places to start youngsters off and I did try to spend a little extra time to allow for this with the first few dog classes.

One or two things I noted on the day some lacked the long muscular slightly arched neck called for in the standard, this coupled with being a bit on the heavy side gives more of the impression required for a HPR breed rather than an air scenting breed.

A couple of other negative things far more easily rectified, having owned and shown a few breeds over the years a Pointer for me is one of the easiest to prepare for the ring, I was surprised at the amount of dirty teeth, long nails and the state of my hands throughout the day, even if you don't have time to bath a good rub down with a warm damp towel will suffice and lastly the lack of muscle tone this coupled with an unforgiving concrete floor will always affect the movement and with a few being overweight spoiling the overall picture.
