Thank you to the exhibitors for entering and taking my decisions so sportingly. The condition, temperaments and overall presentation of the dogs was excellent!

VETERAN DOG OR BITCH (Ents 5, Abs 1)

1st Medogold Tartini with Sonham OSW JW ShCM ShCEx (Mrs A Matthews). This eight-year-old black & white bitch just defies age! Super head with soft expression. Long muscular neck, super top line and tail set, beautifully constructed front and rear allowing her to move freely around the ring, covering lots of ground with her long stride, using her tail. Shown in excellent condition. Pleased to award her BVIB.

2nd Sharnphilly Toggi with Hookwood JW (Mrs S, Misses L & C Welch, Maber & Hazeltine). Seven-year-old black & white bitch, another who had everything I was looking for, loved her dark eyes and sweet expression, well constructed and moved very well, lashing tail.

3rd Harvestslade Cullinan (Mrs D & Mr N Preece & Gilding)

4th Symitry Iced Ginger (Mrs C Isherwood)

MINOR PUPPY DOG (Ents 2, Abs 0)

1st Lundgarth Fly The Flag (Mrs S & Mrs S Booth & Oddie). Eight months old orange & white. Lovely head, lots of chiselling and dark eyes. Raw baby, chest yet to deepen, moved out soundly.

2nd Wilchrimane Cereal Killer (Mrs A & Miss A & Miss D Siddle & Siddle & Mazzeo). 7 months black & white, nice head and long neck, happy puppy, enjoying his day out, gave handler a hard time. Not together on the move at the moment.

PUPPY DOG (Ents 6, Abs 0)

1st Sonham Just over The Moon at Oramiss (ai) (Mrs L Clinton). 10-month-old black and white. My notes say Wow. Caught my eye as he entered the ring. Gorgeous head, dark eyes and melting expression, super chiselling, just the right amount of dish. Long neck set into well laid shoulders, matching return of upper arm. Deep chest, viewed from front and side. Well oval boned legs sloping pasterns, top line and tail set excellent, rear quarters strong and angles matching front assembly. Moved with drive on a free stride, confident happy puppy lashing his tail. Will watch his future with interest. My BPIB

2nd Quinnersy Swinderby by Lypal (Mr Pk & Mrs La & Ms S Smith & Smith & Welch). 9 Month orange and white. Everything I was looking for, lovely head and dark eye. Well constructed. Moved very well. In time will trouble the best. Unlucky to meet one on such top form today. Lovely puppy.

3rd Sonham Just The Ticket (ai) (Mrs A Matthews)

JUNIOR DOG (Ents 8, Abs 1)

1st Sonham Just Over The Moon at Oramiss (ai) (Mrs L Clinton).

2nd Ladyhawke Desert Orchid (Mrs W Pearson). An absolutely gorgeous head on this stunning lemon & White. He is beautifully constructed, he has the most wonderful forehand, deep chest with fill to front. Long muscular neck, well ribbed back and short coupled. Great top line and tail set. Matching angles fore and aft enabling him to move effortlessly around the huge ring. Sound from any angle. Shown in super condition. A little unsettled today, but definitely one to watch.

YEARLING DOG (Ent 4, Abs 0)

1st Meadowpoint Jack O'lantern at Pointmoor (Mrs J Walton). Orange & white. Loved his head and eye, thin leathers. Lovely neck and shoulder, well ribbed back & short coupled. Super feet and sloping pasterns. Moved very well and happy.

2nd Joneva Just Goes To Show at Errytar (Miss R Webster). Another lovely orange & white, and similar comments apply, just preferred the shorter coupling on my winner.

3rd Hawkfield Happy Feet at Oramiss JW (Mrs L Clinton)

4th Hookwood Hawker (Mrs E K & Mr R Green)

POST GRADUATE DOG (Ent 5, Abs 0)

1st De Las Navazuelas Stormcloud at Ridanflight (Imp Esp) (Mr S Rose). Loved this black and white dogs ring presence. Well made elegant dog, nice head, dark eye, fine leathers. Super oval feet and sloping pasterns. Excellent top line and tail set. Moved really well, covering the ground. Expertly handled.

2nd Alozia Zealandia for Ratchda JW (Mrs G Marsh). Smaller made liver and white, everything in the right place, nice head, plenty of chiselling, good body proportions. Very well muscled and shown in gleaming condition. Unlucky to meet one today.

3rd Wilchrimane Let's Be Frank (Mrs C Isherwood)

4th Riowood Orange Twist (Mr & Mrs L Millett)

5th Alcazar Excalibur (Mrs L Dunnett)

LIMIT DOG (Ent 5, Abs 0)

1st Dondaig Wooden Heart (Mrs Allen). My notes say Outstanding. Beautiful black and white that I have admired ringside for a while. All male, yet still refined and elegant. He had the best of heads, wide nostrils, lovely chiselling, correct stop and occiput, the right amount of dish, foreface and width of skull, dark kind eyes. Long muscular neck, well laid shoulder and matching return of upper arm, fill to front of chest, depth when viewed from the side. Lovely oval well boned legs with oval feet and sloping pasterns. He was well ribbed back and short in loin. Powerful well angulated quarters, but not overdone, correct first and second thigh with short hocks. He quite simply took my breath away when he moved with his reach and drive, at one with his handler, covering this huge ring easily on his long free low stride holding his top line and lashing his tail. Sound from any angle. He just screamed look at me, and I did! Pleased to award him his first CC and BOB. Hope the other two follow quickly.

2nd Fisherbloom Hey Didle Didle at Heartbury (Mrs V, Miss S, Miss G & Mr K Norbury, Ganney, Adams & Adams). Another lovely dog that I have admired ringside, and he didn't disappoint. He reminds me of a male version of a Champion that I bred a few decades ago. Beautiful, elegant dog, lovely head with kind eyes. Good construction and moved really well. Well handled.

3rd 556 - Droveborough's The Gambit at Vinepoint (Mrs A Bird)

OPEN DOG (Ent 6, Abs 2)

1st Sh Ch Sharnphilly Boondoggle JW (Miss Oddie). Black & white who I have long admired. Lovely head and kindest eye, long powerful neck and beautiful construction. Matching angulation fore and aft. Not overdone anywhere. He just flowed from to nose to tail. Flawless movement and completely at one with his excellent handler. Pleased to award him the RCC.

2nd Carofel Wings Of Hope JW Ww23 Swiss JCh (Mrs L Adams). Orange and white with lots to like, he has a super head and kind dark eye. Presented a pleasing picture when stacked and moved very soundly. Would prefer a little more angulation fore and aft. Very well handled.

3rd Kanix Sourdough with Calaquendi JW Bel Jch (Mrs A & Miss V & Miss L Hill)

4th Lypal Well I Never (Mr P & Mrs L Smith)

SPECIAL BEGINNERS DOG OR BITCH (Ents 10, Abs 2)

1st Keepersfield Simone (Mrs Parkin). This black and white four-year-old bitch and her young handler caught my eye as soon as they entered the ring. Pretty headed bitch with kind expression. Loved her overall body proportions and matching angulations fore and aft. Well handled. Looked super on the stack and moving were a dream together. Best Special Beginner.

2nd Wilchrimane Pretzel (Miss H & Miss M & Mr W Sheedy & Hand & Siddle). 13-month orange and white male. Nicely made dog, lovely head. Happy and confident on the move, well handled.

3rd Hawkfield Happy Feet at Oramiss JW (Mrs L Clinton)

4th Codnorhawk Scott Andrew (Mrs H Tate)

5th Sniperay Secret Service (Mrs E & Mrs A & Mr S Pressley & Large & Large)

MINOR PUPPY BITCH (Ent 5, Abs 0)

1st Droveborough Black Magic (Miss S Kennedy). 7 months black & white. Liked her a lot. Pretty head and dark eye. Super make and shape all through, so together for her young age. Moved really soundly. One to watch for the future.

2nd Sniperay Secret Affair (Mrs J Radcliffe). Another super youngster and similar comments apply, could change places on another day.

PUPPY BITCH (Ents 6, Abs 1)

1st Sonham Just A Pretty Belle (ai) (Mrs A Matthews). 11 months liver and white, aptly named and isn't she just! gorgeous head with chiselling and thin ear leathers, long arched neck set into well laid shoulders and lovely return of upper arm, well ribbed back and short coupled. Depth to chest from front and side. Lovely quarters with width to second thigh. Presented a super outline when stacked and moved out really well, holding her top line, she gave handler a hard time on the move, but when settled, boy could she reach and drive. BPB

JUNIOR BITCH (Ents 4, Abs 0)

1st Sonham Just Good Friends (ai) (Mrs A Matthews). 11 Months liver and white, similar comments apply to my puppy bitch winner, who is incidentally her litter sister. I later realised they are also from the same litter as my puppy dog winner...what a cracking litter! All should have a very bright future.

2nd Teisgol Rose Champion (Mr P & Mrs D & Mrs L Stilgoe & Stilgoe & Fox). Pretty 13-month orange and white, another with beautiful construction, and close up to my winner. Super sound on the move.

3rd Droveborough's Hells Bells (Miss S Kennedy)

4th Laveto Tennessee Whiskey (Mr & Mrs L Millett)

YEARLING BITCH (Ent 3, Abs 0)

1st Teisgol Rose Champion (Mr P & Mrs D & Mrs L Stilgoe & Stilgoe & Fox)

2nd Droveborough's Hells Bells (Miss S Kennedy). Liver & white, nicely constructed, pretty head. Just preferred overall balance and movement of one today.

3rd Harvestslade Star Ruby (Mrs D & Mr N Preece & Gilding)

POST GRADUATE BITCH (Ents 10, Abs 1)

1st Kanix Smoochie at Stargang (Miss H Blackburn-Bennett). Orange & white caught my eye on the first lap around the large ring. She has a gorgeous head of correct proportions, beautiful dark expressive eyes, they just melt you, chiselling under eyes and fine ear leather. She had a lovely long arched neck, fitting into correct sloping shoulders, the best of forehands in the class. Straight forelegs, oval bone and beautiful feet and sloping pasterns. Well ribbed back and short coupled, powerful quarters with good expanse of first and second thigh, short strong hocks. Lovely top line and tail. Stacked she was a picture, and just beautiful on the move. She just flew around the ring, a joy to watch. Bond between dog and handler was lovely to see. Pleased to award her the CC!

2nd Flinthill Some Like It Hot at Caithpoint (Miss F, Mrs C & Mr B Earl, Wheldon & Jones). Black and white bitch pretty head, nicely constructed and moved out well. Later I considered for the RCC, but was unsettled at being rushed back into the ring today.

3rd Heartbury Tormenta over Nosam JW (Mrs S Mason)

5th Lundgarth Jubilee JW (Mrs S Booth)

LIMIT BITCH (Ents 11, Abs 0)

1st Kanix Skyfall (Mr & Mrs J Blackburn-Bennett). Liver and white with a lovely head, long neck and well laid shoulder, super return of upper arm, deep chest with fill to the front, well ribbed back and short loin. Loved her rear quarters, super expanse of first and second thigh. Another with a super outline stacked and a joy to watch on the move, powered around this large ring, holding top line, absolutely foot perfect. Shown in beautiful condition. Pleased to award her the RCC.

2nd Codnorhawk Starlight on Moreoldglen (Mrs A & Ms L Boulton). Another super liver and white, pretty head, lovely outline stacked and sound on the move. Unlucky to meet one today.

3rd Heartbury Northern Lights JW (Mrs V & Mr M, Mr K Norbury & Adams)

4th Hawkfield Frivolous for Caithpoint (Miss F, Mrs C & Mr B Earl, Wheldon & Jones)

5th Clamerkin Jubilee Surprise at Hookwood JW (Mrs S & Mrs J & Miss C Welch & Drake & Hazeltine)

OPEN BITCH (Ents 6, Abs 1)

1st Sh Ch Kanix Sooty at Stargang (Mr A & Mrs J Macara & Blackburn-Bennett). A stunning black and white headed this open class. Yet another beautiful bitch from this Kennel. Lovely head with kind dark eye, long neck and superb shoulders with lovely return of upper arm, she had depth of chest, well ribbed back and short coupling and super rear quarters enabling her to fly effortlessly around the large ring, foot perfect at any angle, reach and drive in abundance. Shown in hard fit condition. Later I learnt that my PG, L, and Open winners were all litter sisters!!

2nd Sh Ch Wilchrimane Frankly Darlin (Miss, Mrs & Mrs Siddle, Siddle & Medeiros). My notes say stunningly pretty bitch. And she is. Absolutely beautiful head on this orange and white, her eyes are like dark pools, wide flared nostrils, correct amount of dish, lovely chiselling and pronounced occiput. She has a long arched muscular neck and lovely shoulder, top line and tail set, depth of chest from front and side, lovely quarters. incredibly good handler who gets the very best from her charge. Today I just preferred the forward reach of my winner.
